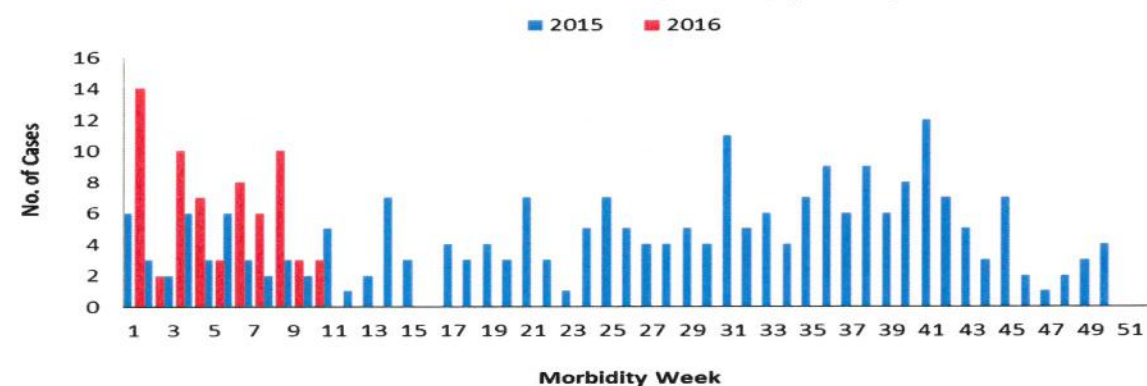

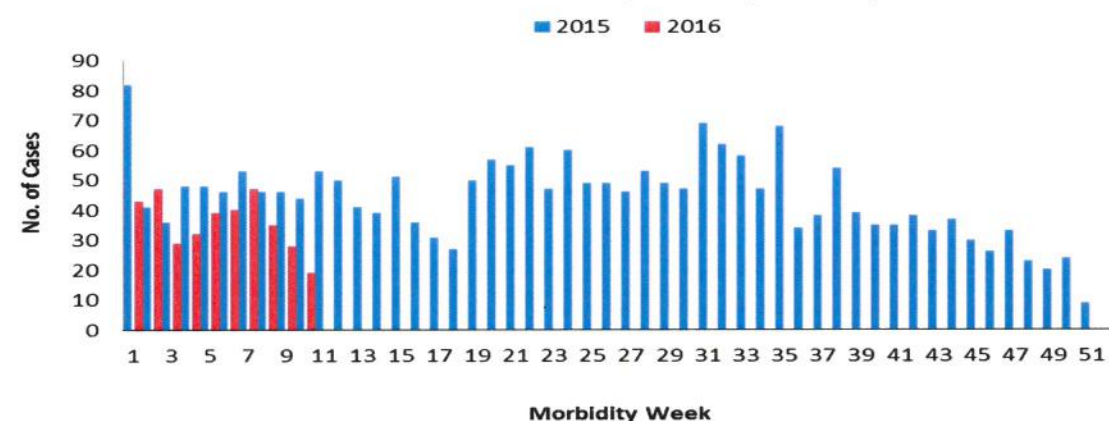

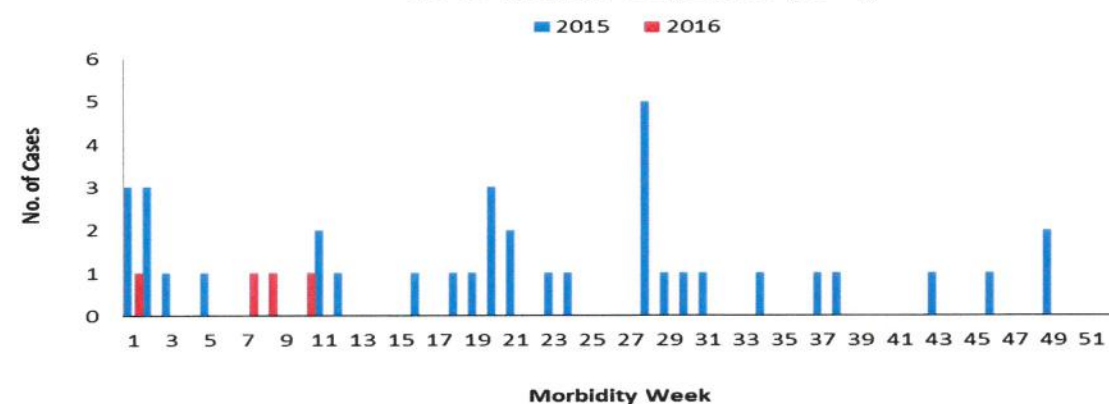
**Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of March 12, 2016, (N=66)**

**Fig. 3 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of March 12, 2016 (N=4)**



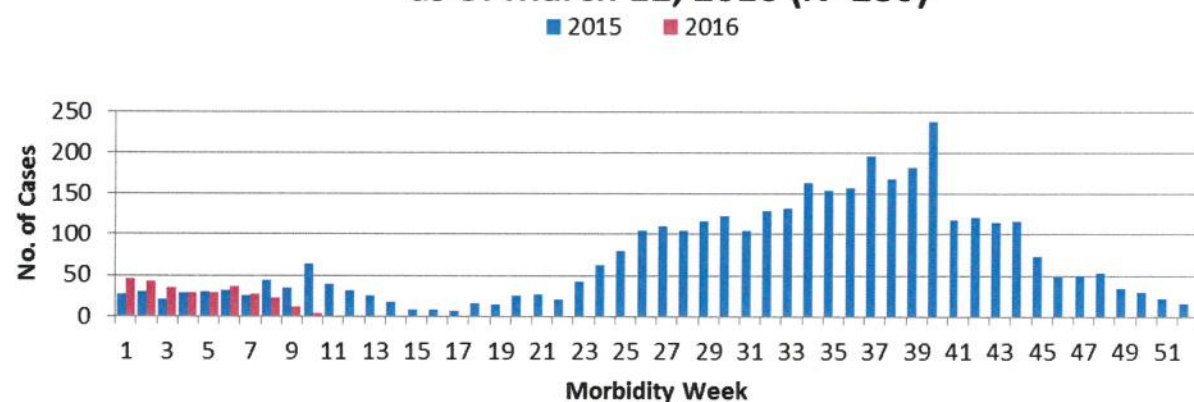




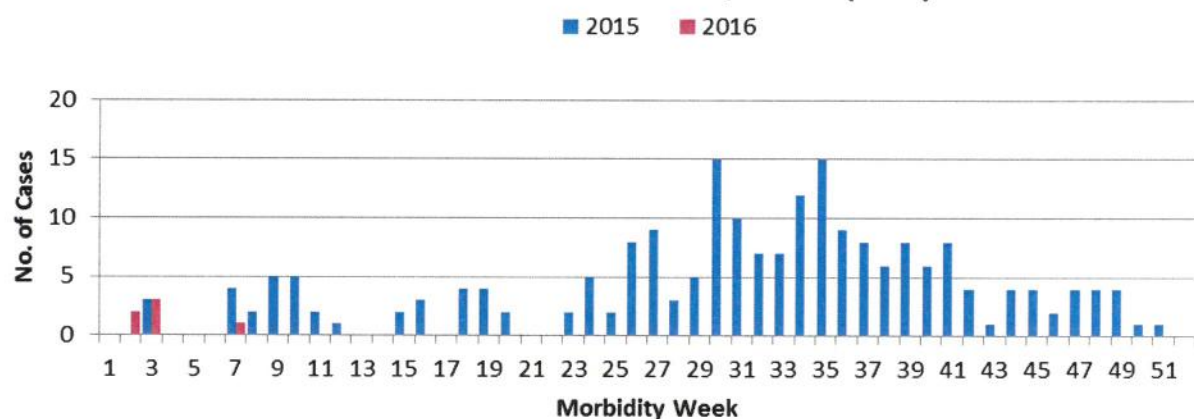

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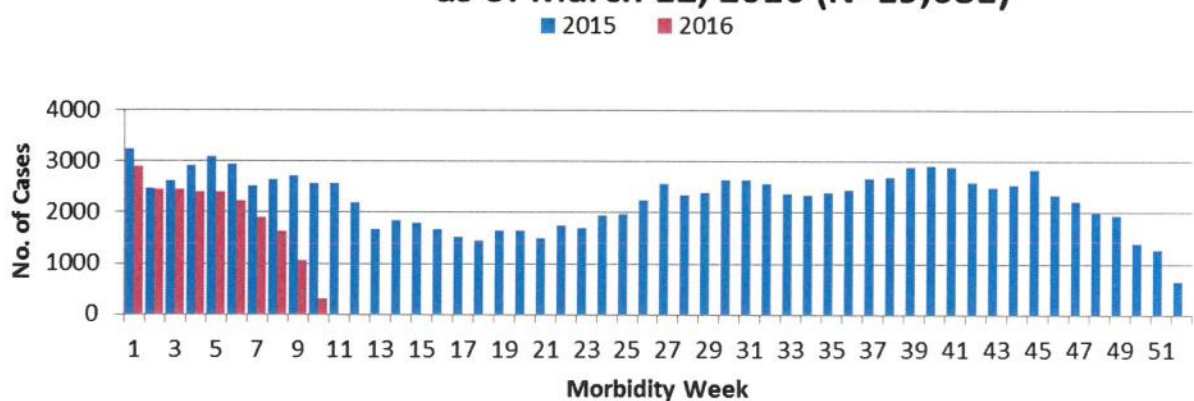
**Fig.4 Suspect Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease Cases

as of March 12, 2016 (N=19,681)**

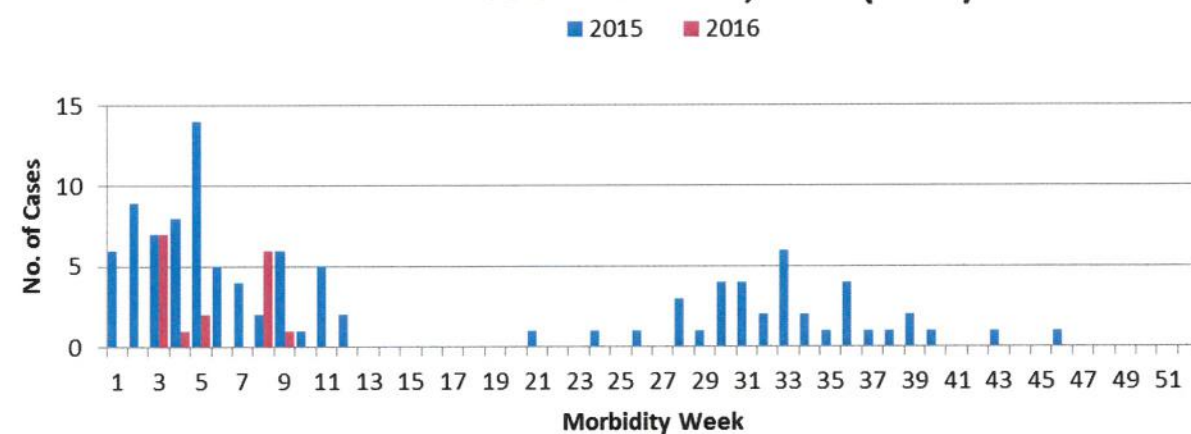




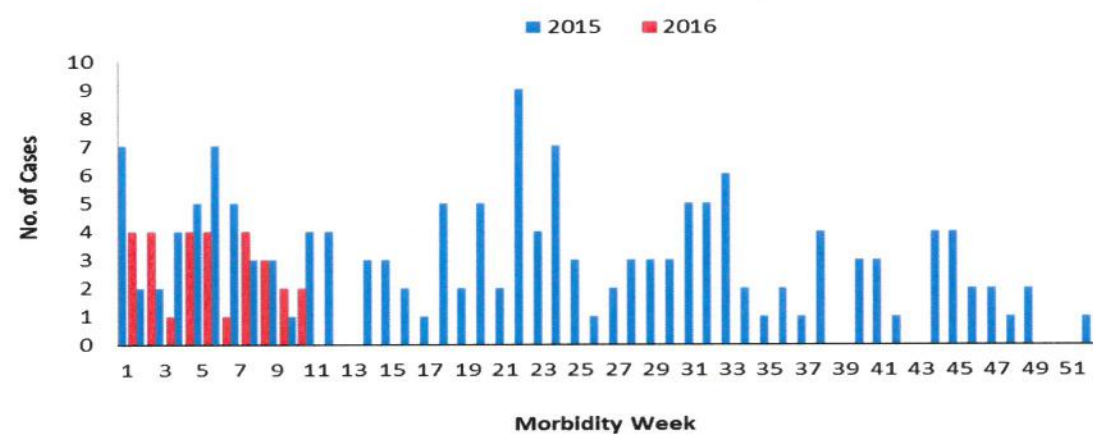

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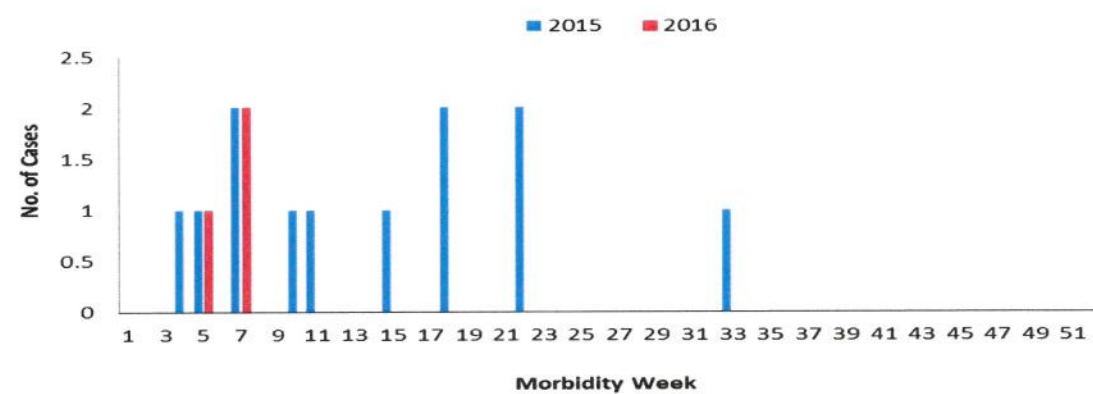
**Fig.7 Confirmed Influenza Cases

as of March 12, 2016 (N=3)**





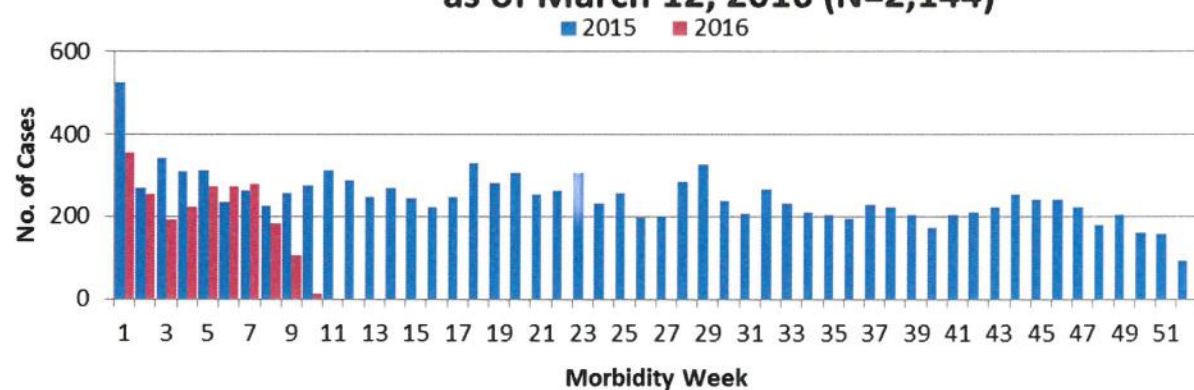

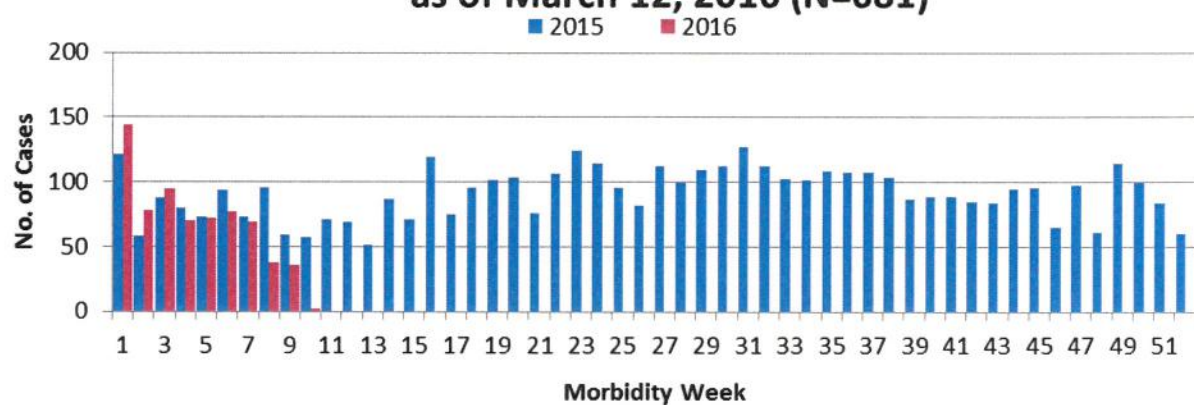

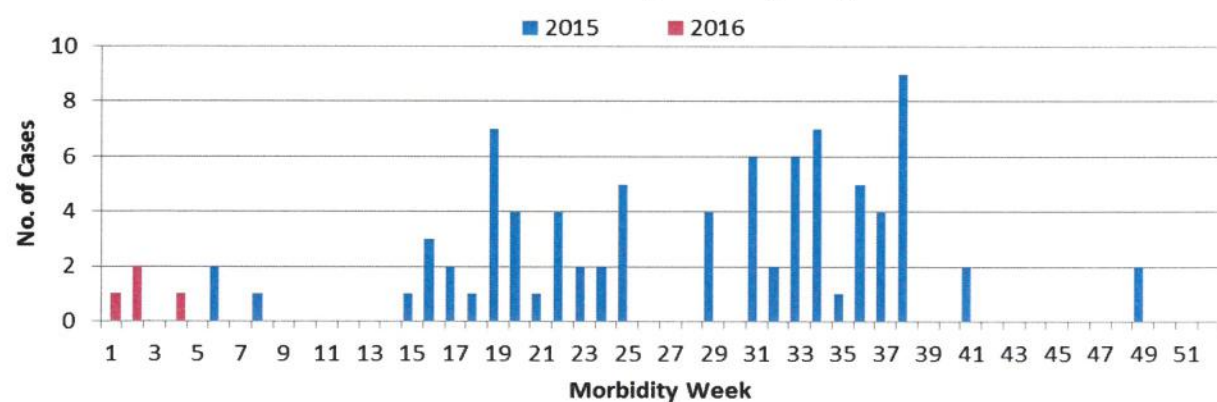
**Fig.10 Suspect Acute Bloody Diarrhea Cases

as of March 12, 2016 (n=4)**



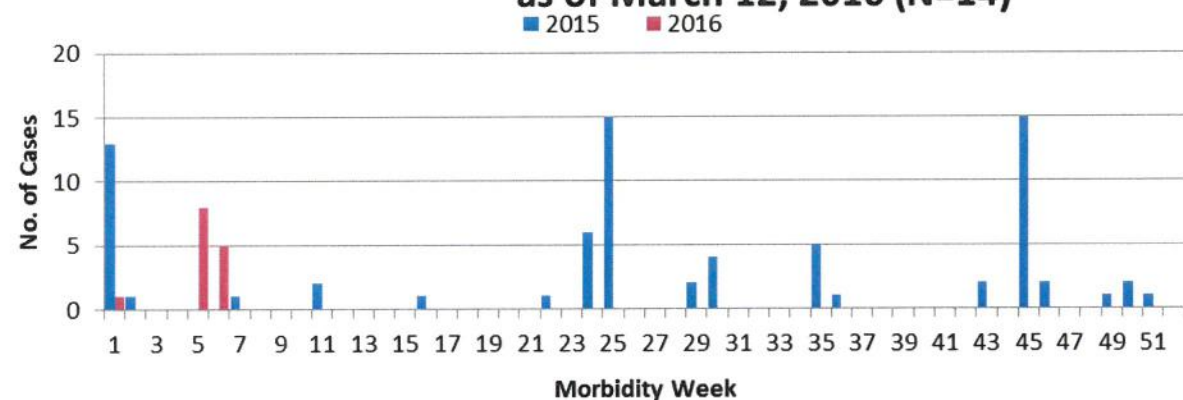




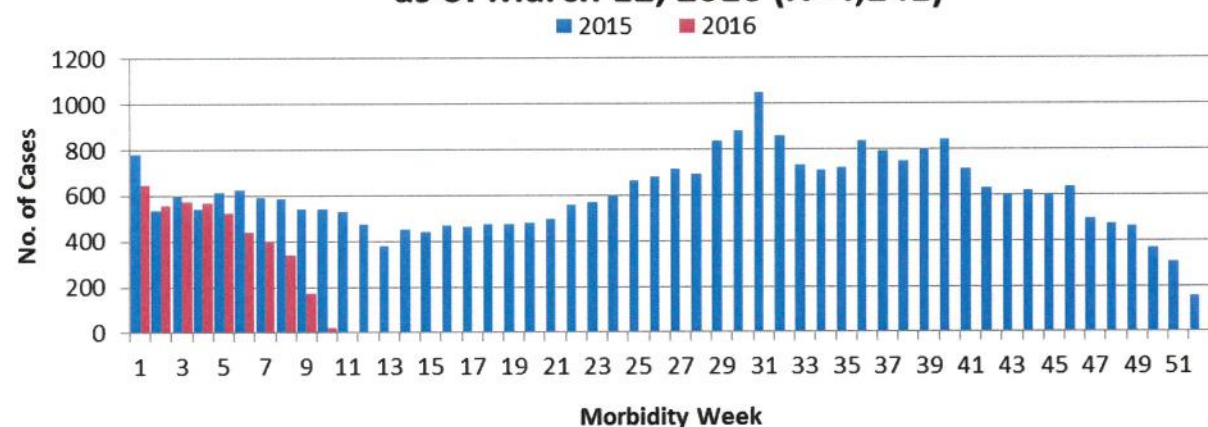

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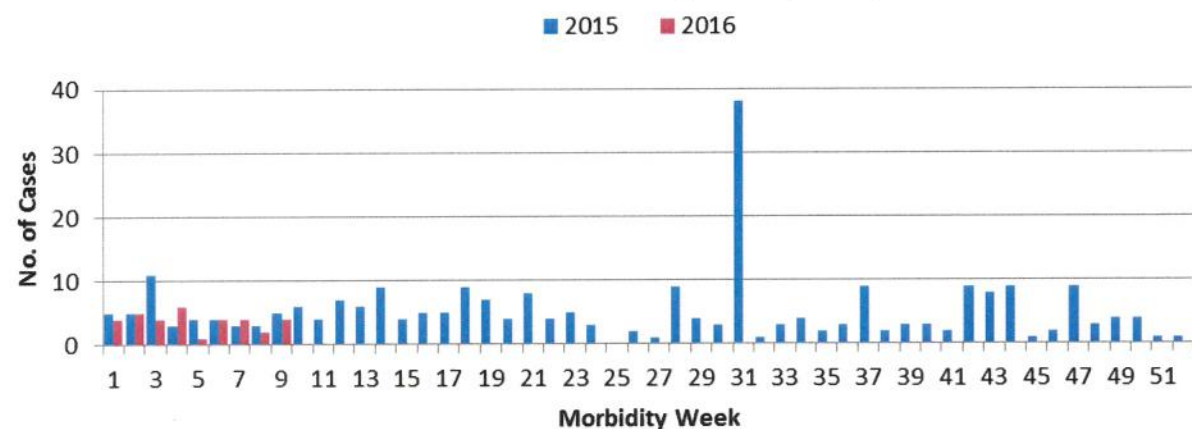
**Fig.13 Suspect Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning Cases

as of March 12, 2016 (n=34)**



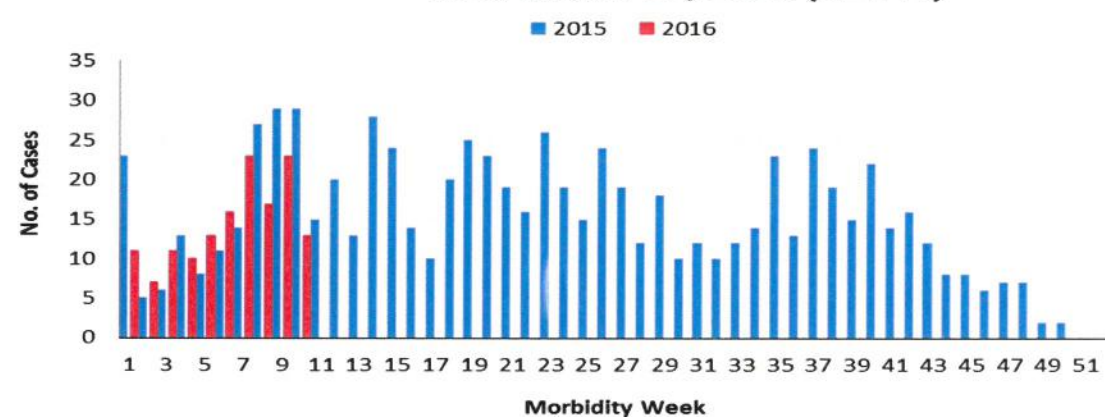

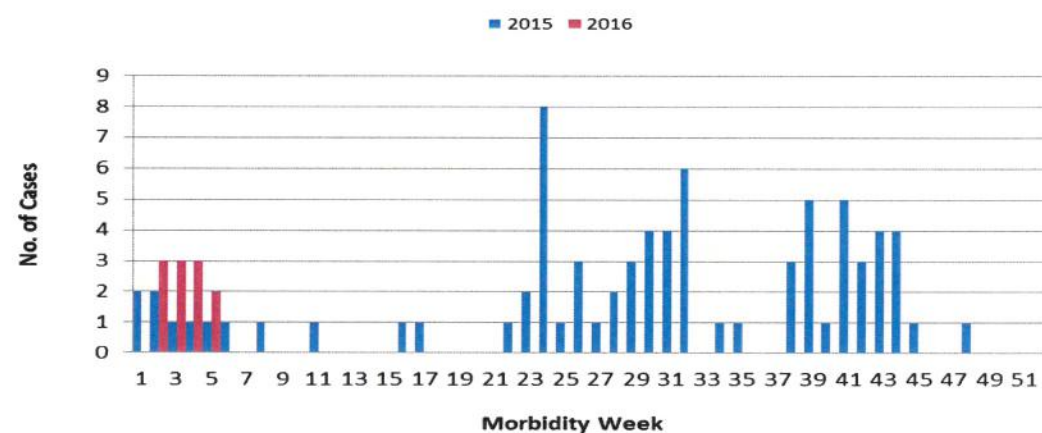
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**Fig. 16 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases  
as of March 12, 2016 (N=144)**

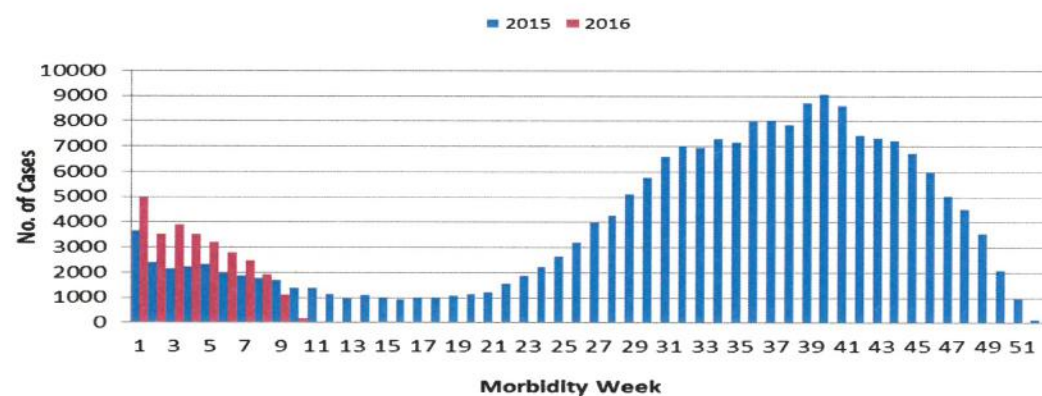

as of March 12, 2016 (N=27,446)**

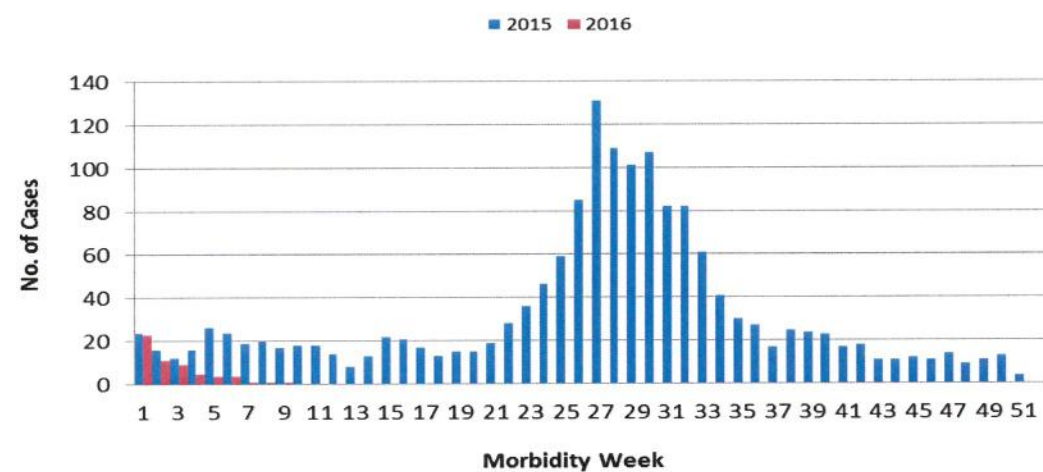




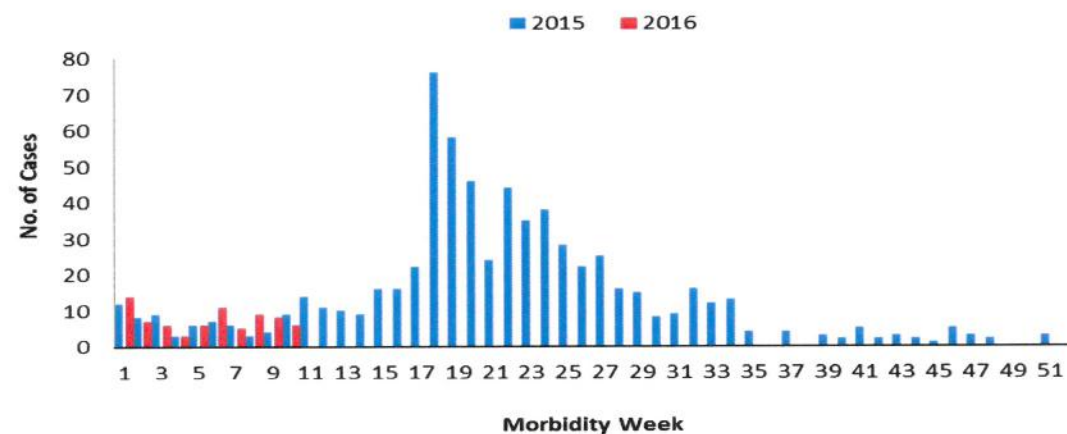

as of March 12, 2016 (n=59)**

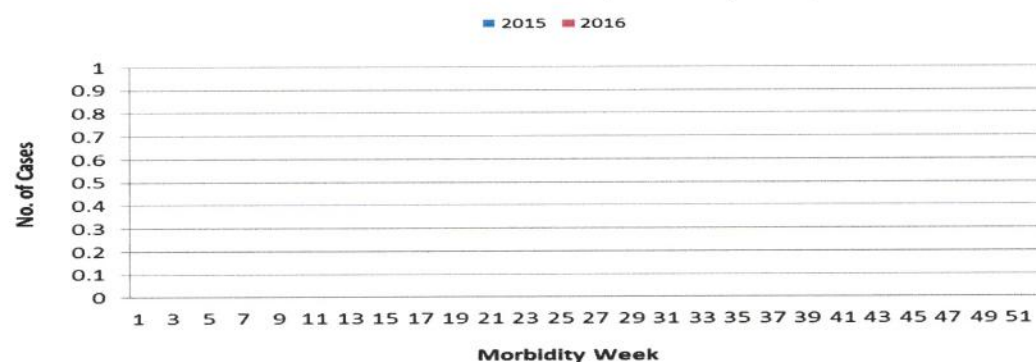


**Fig. 20 Suspect Malaria Cases

as of March 12, 2016 (N=0)**



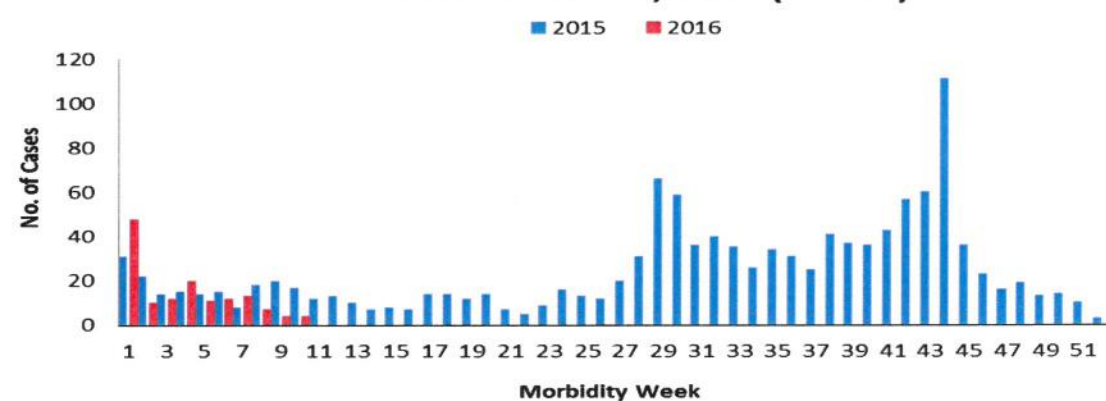




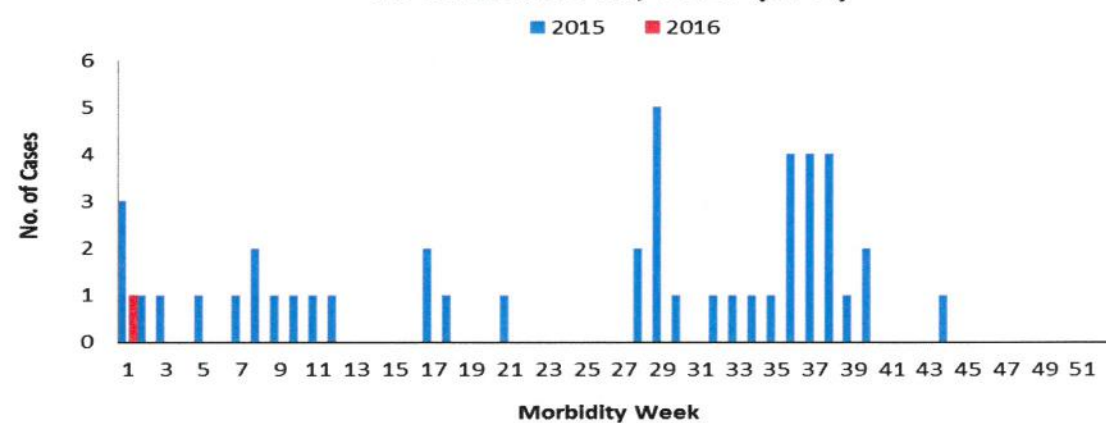
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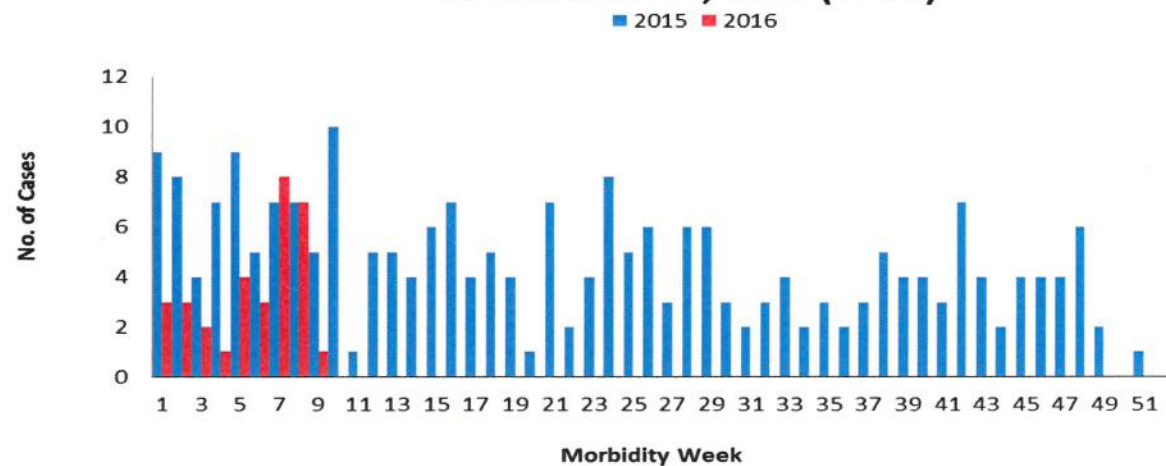
**Fig. 22 Suspect Leptospirosis Cases

as of March 12, 2016 (N=32)**





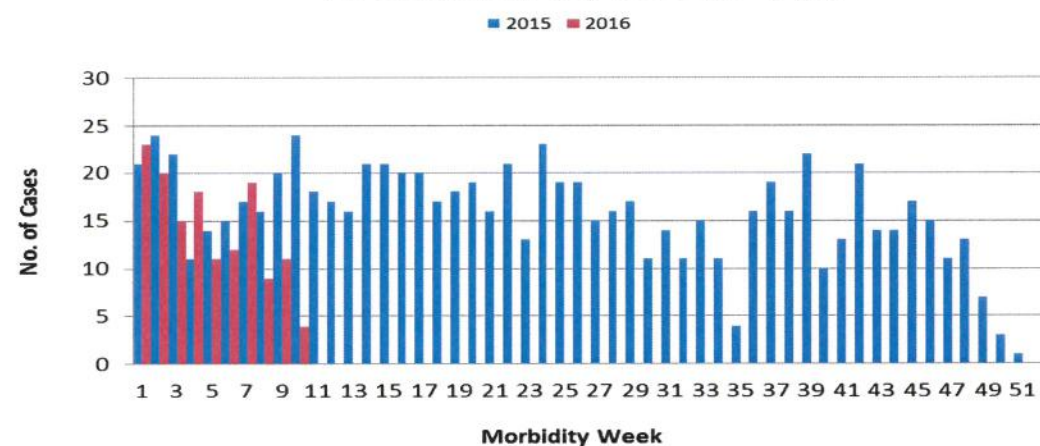

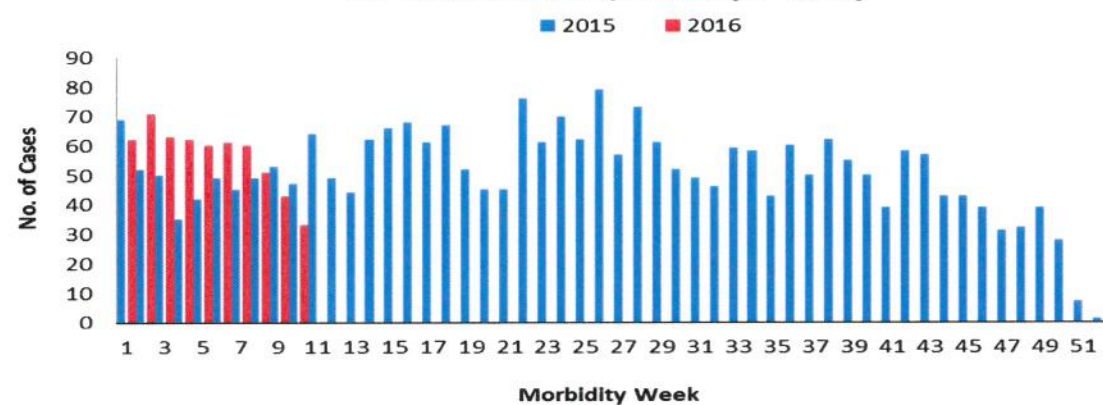

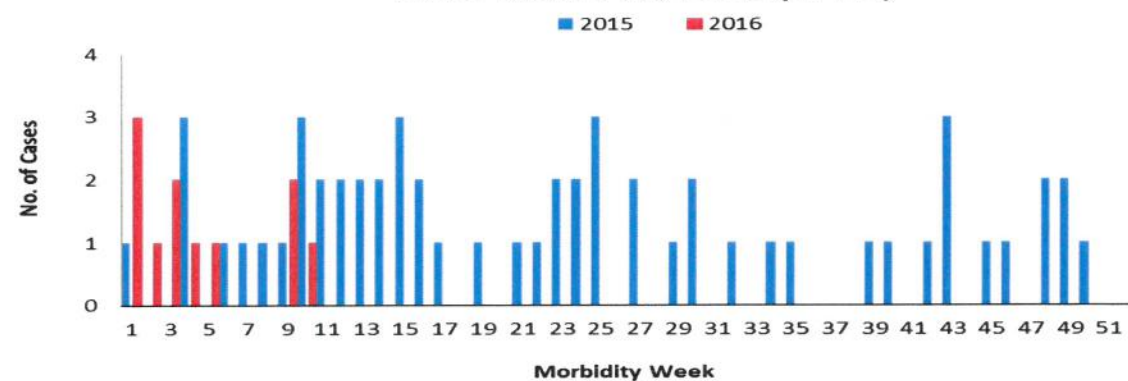
**Fig. 25 Confirmed Non-neonatal Tetanus Cases

as of March 12, 2016 (N=11)**








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
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
