Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of April 2, 2016, (N=71)

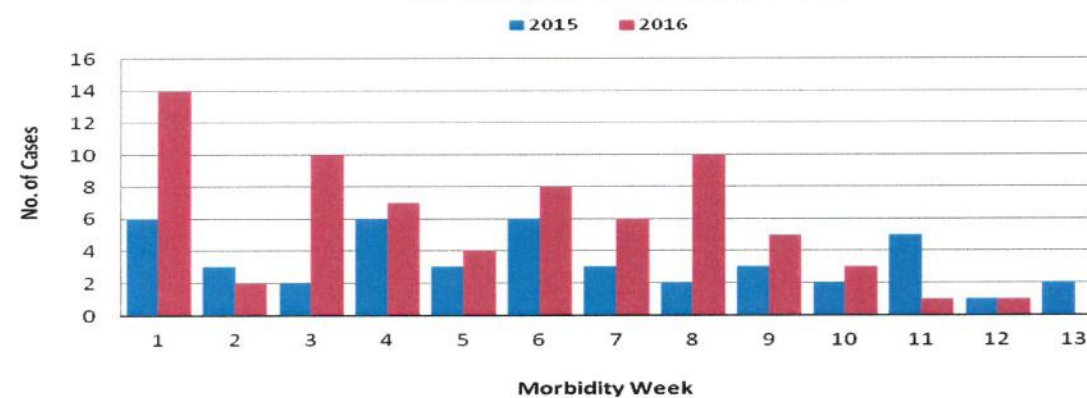


Fig. 2 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of April 2, 2016 (N=418)

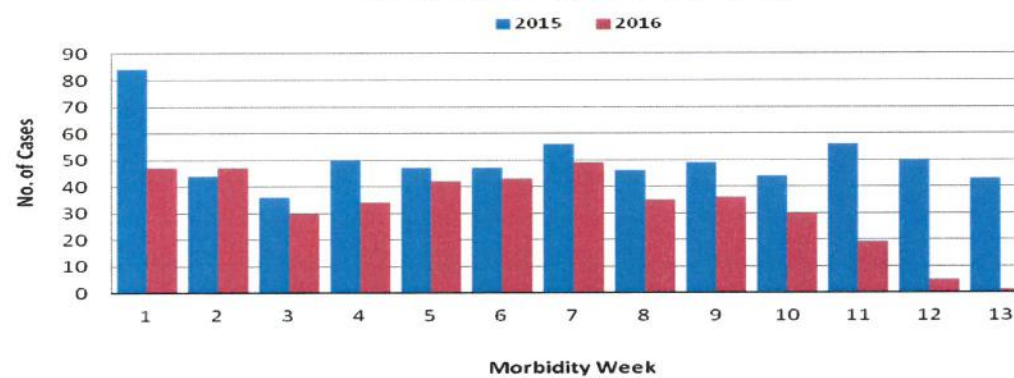
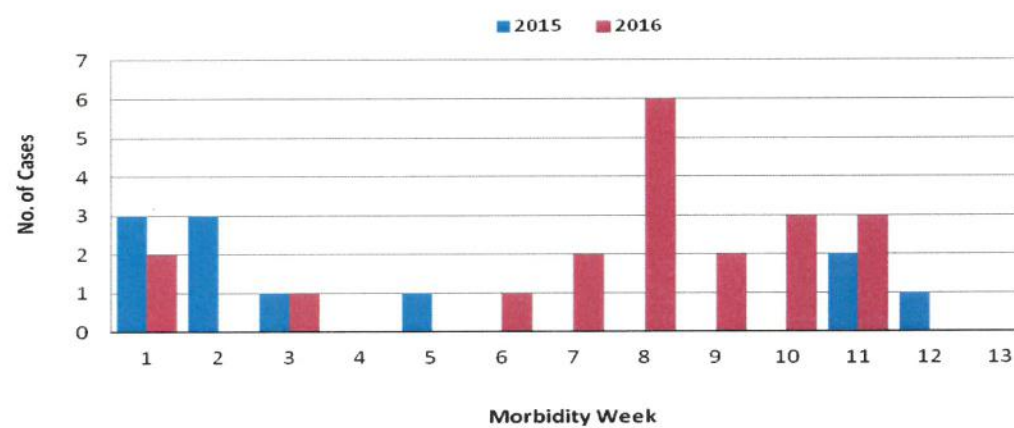


Fig. 3 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of April 2, 2016 (n=20)

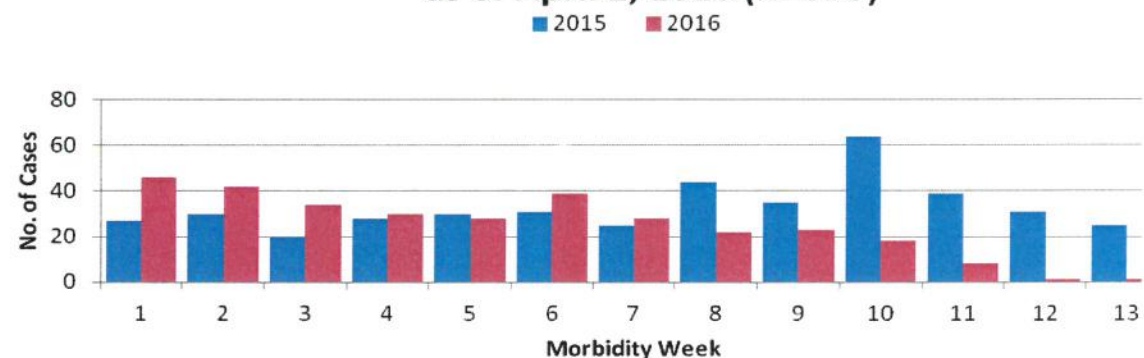




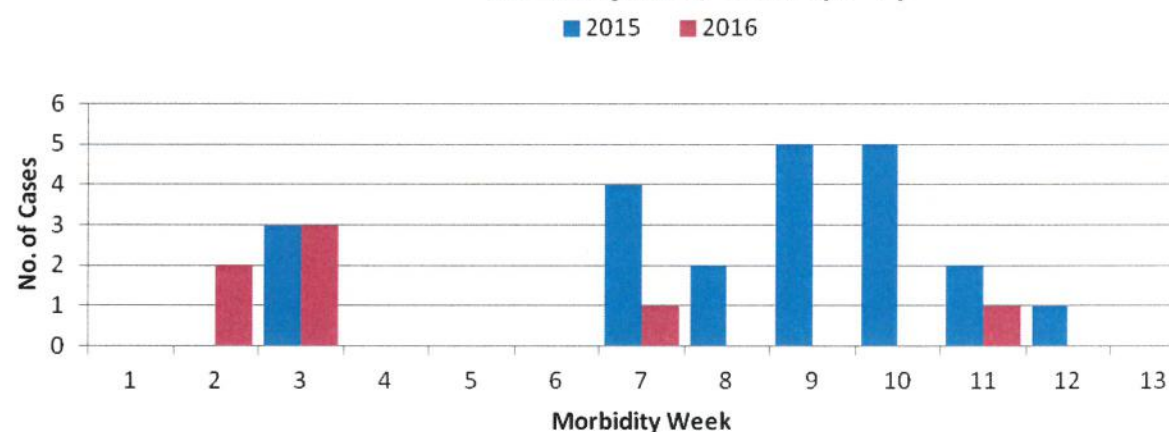
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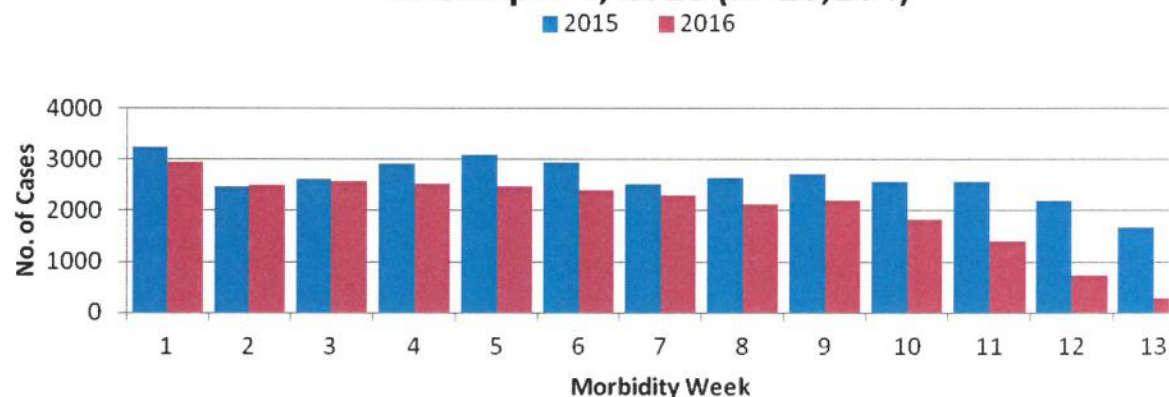
**Fig.4 Suspect Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease Cases

as of April 2, 2016 (n=7)**



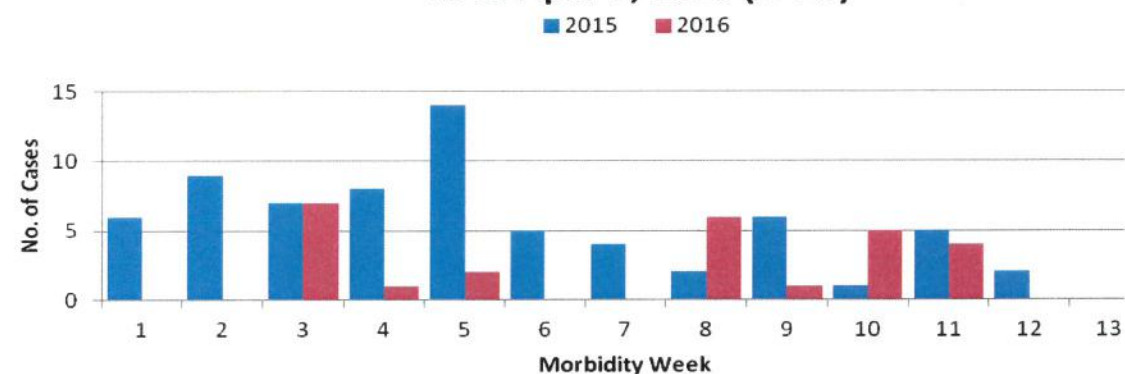
**Fig.6 Influenza-like Illness Cases
as of April 2, 2016 (N=26,204)**



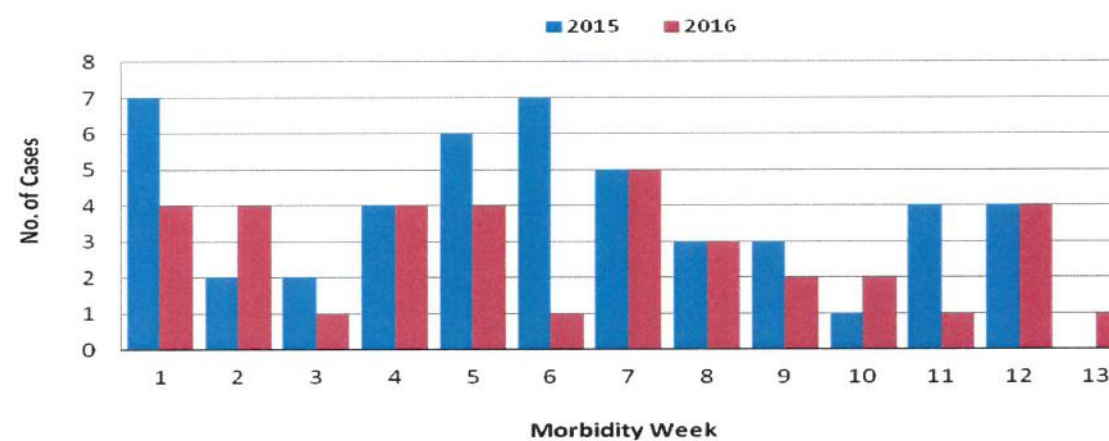
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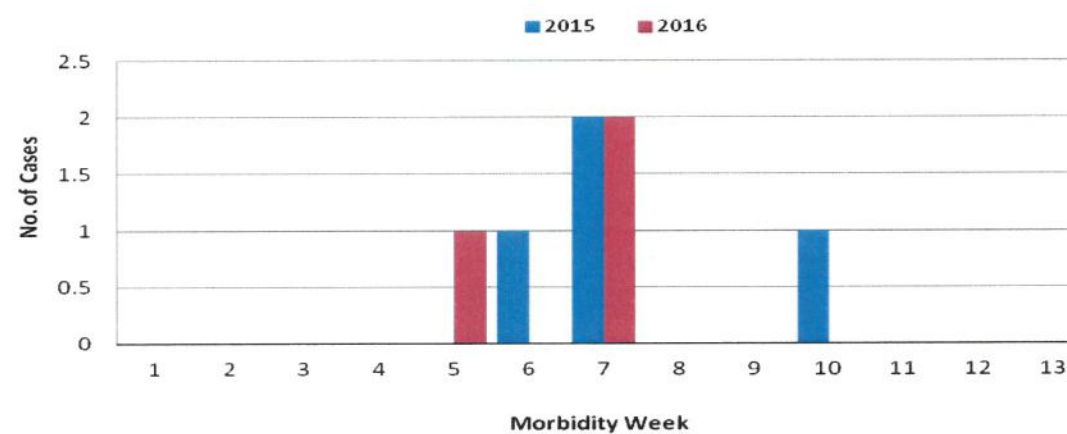
**Fig.7 Influenza Cases

 as of April 2, 2016 (n=3)**



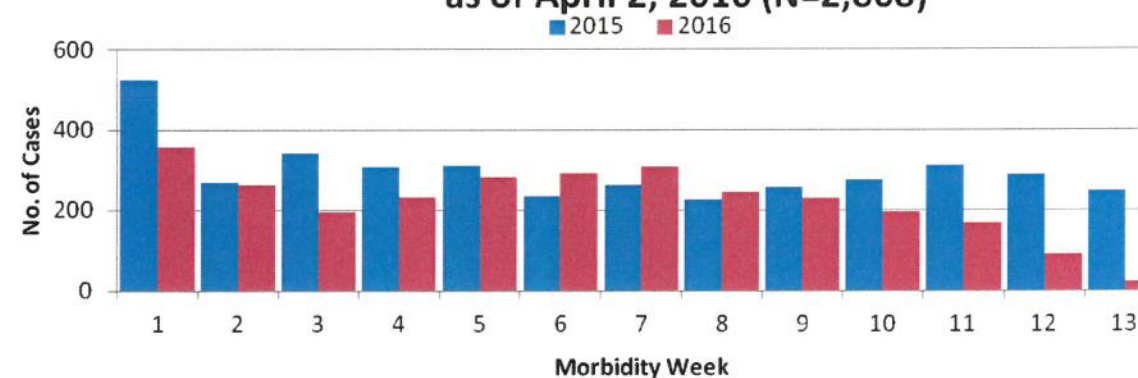


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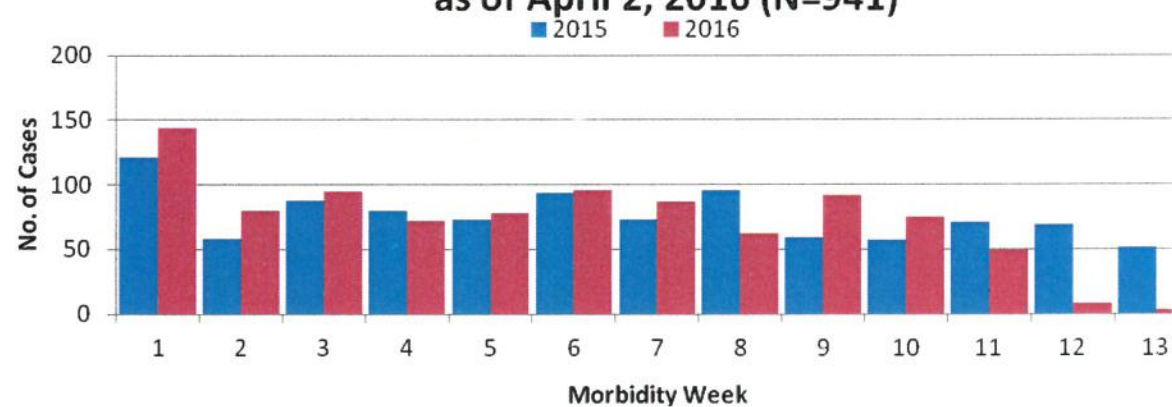

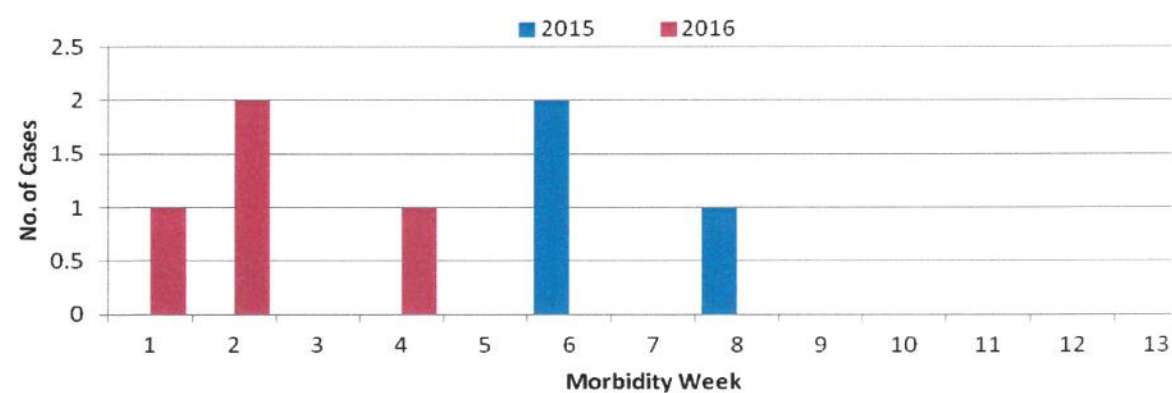
**Fig.10 Acute Bloody Diarrhea Cases

 as of April 2, 2016 (N=14)

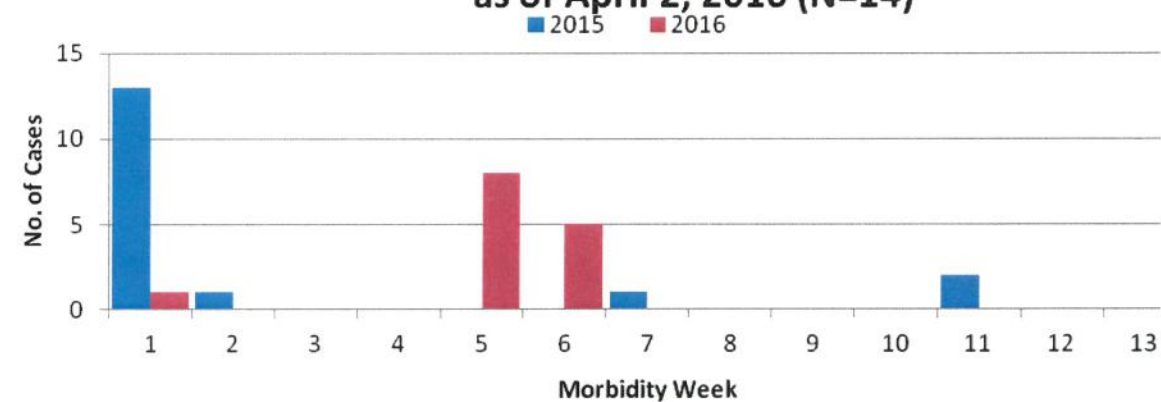


Fig.14 Suspect Typhoid Cases
 as of April 2, 2016 (N=5,547)

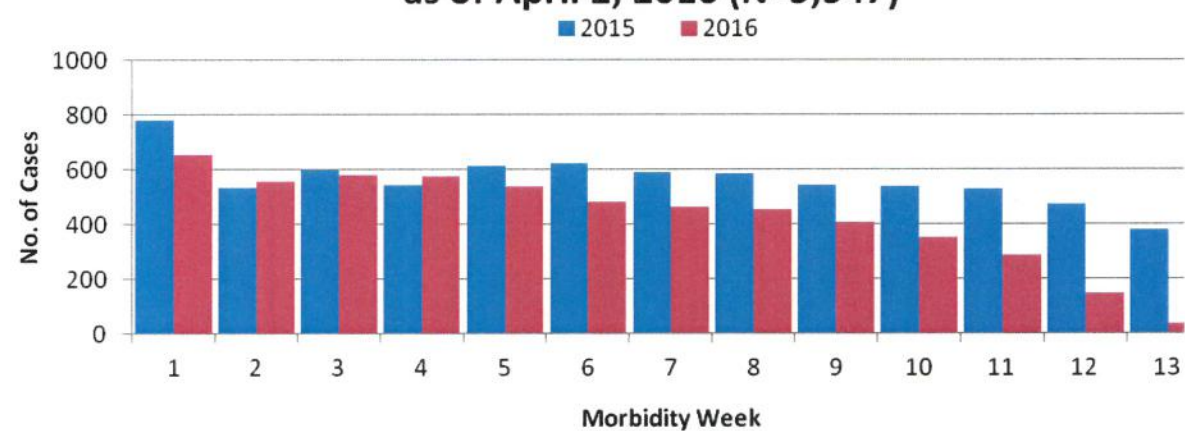
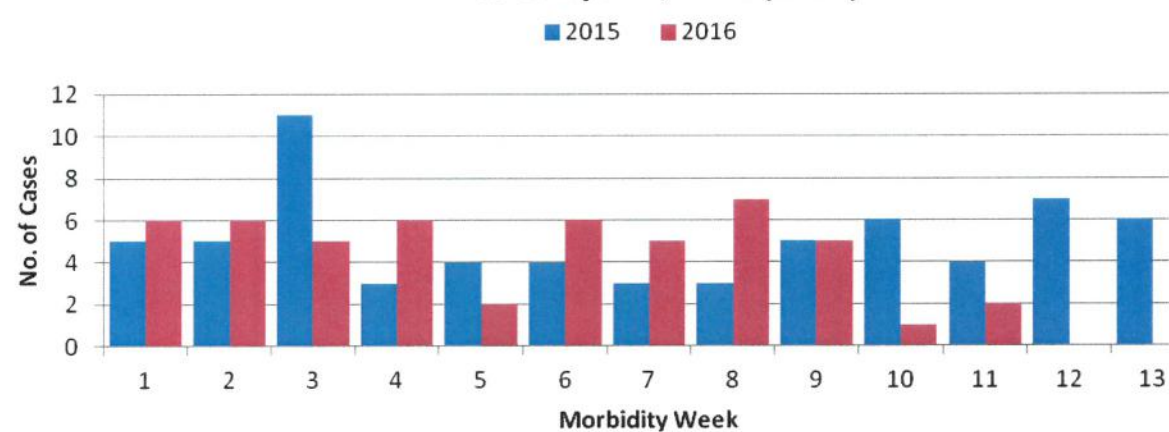


Fig.15 Confirmed Typhoid Cases
 as of April 2, 2016 (n=51)

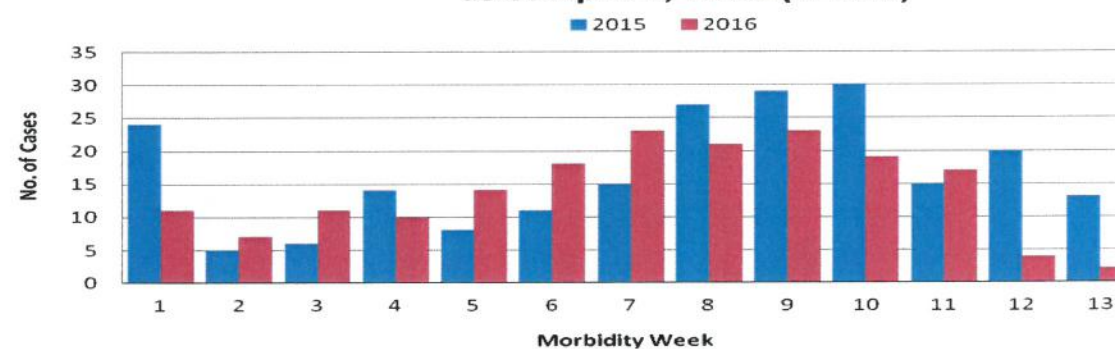




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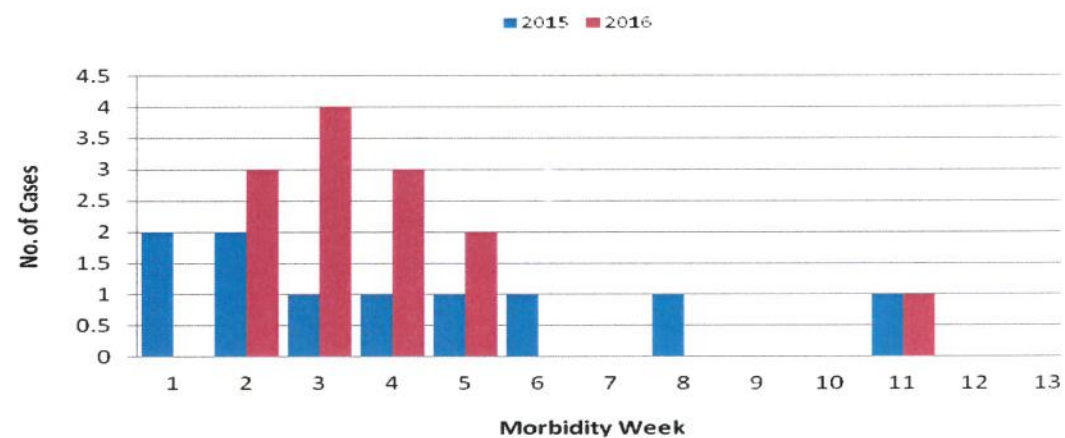
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**Fig. 16 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases
as of April 2, 2016 (n=180)**

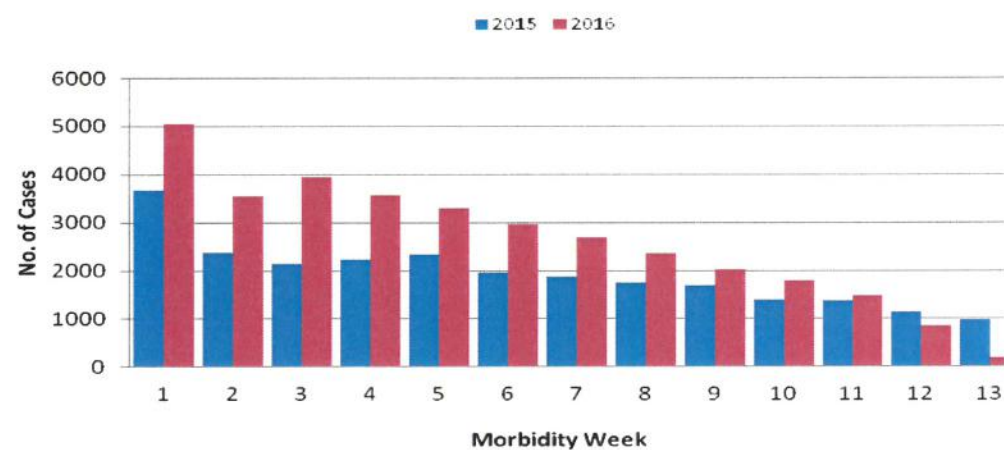

as of April 2, 2016 (N=13)**



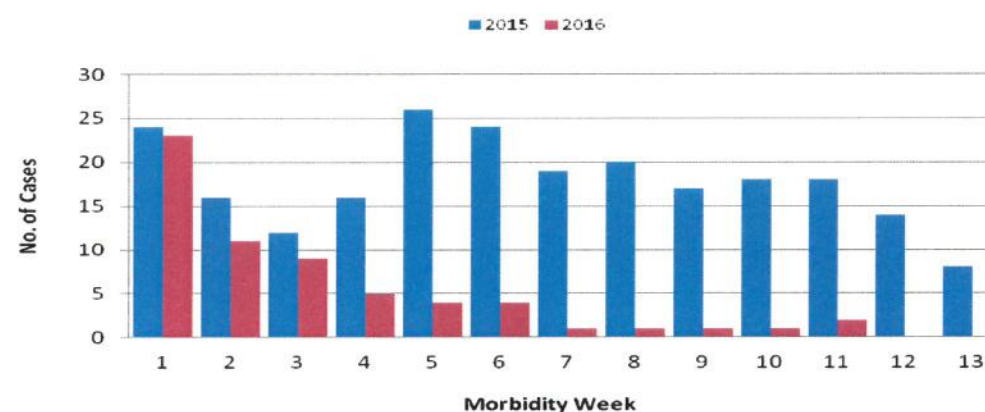
**Fig. 18 Suspect Dengue Cases
as of April 2, 2016 (N=33,748)**



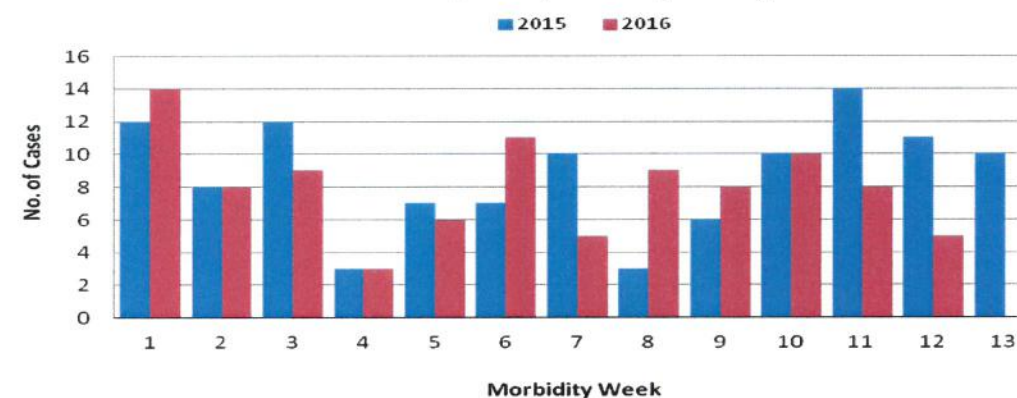
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**Fig. 19 Confirmed Dengue Cases
 as of April 2, 2016 (n=62)**

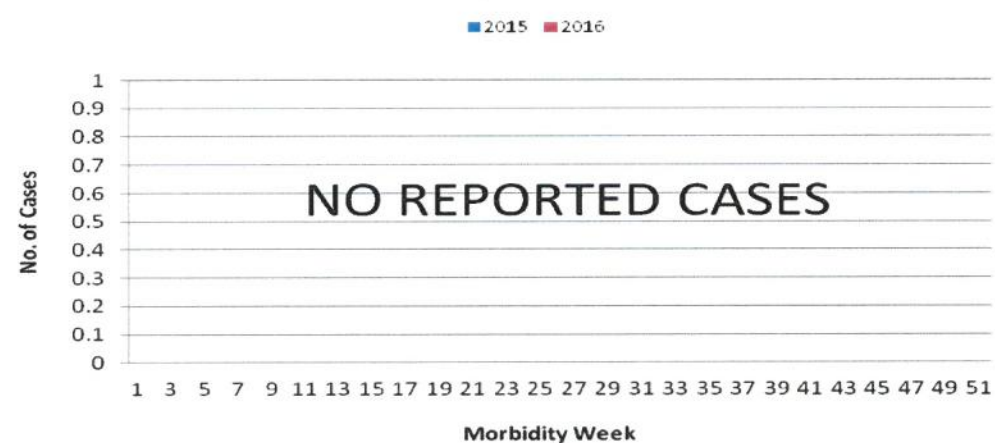


**Fig. 20 Suspect Malaria Cases

 as of April 2, 2016 (N=0)**

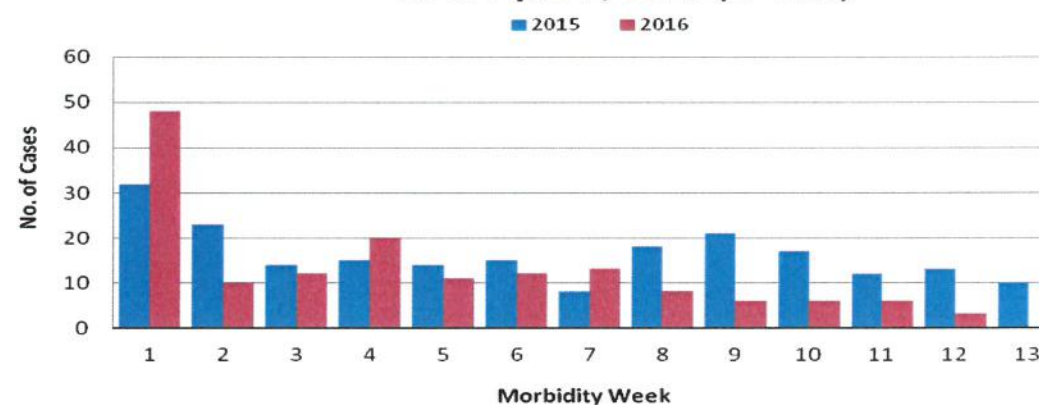




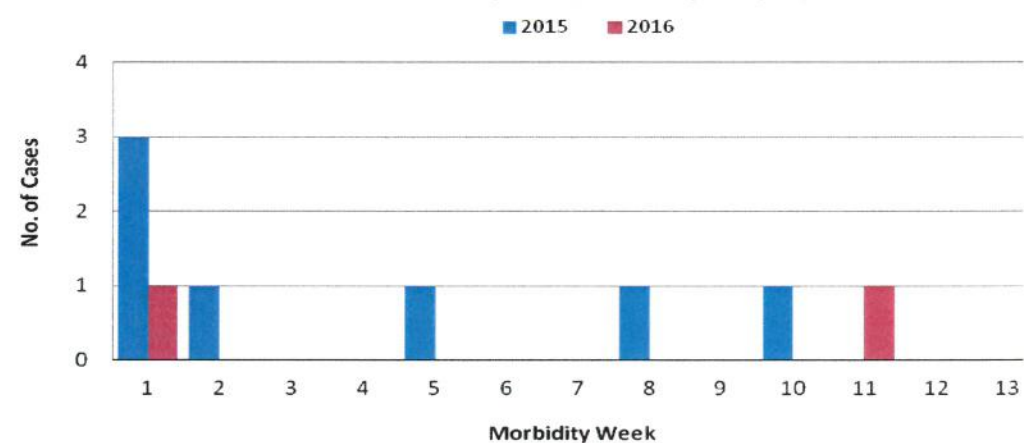
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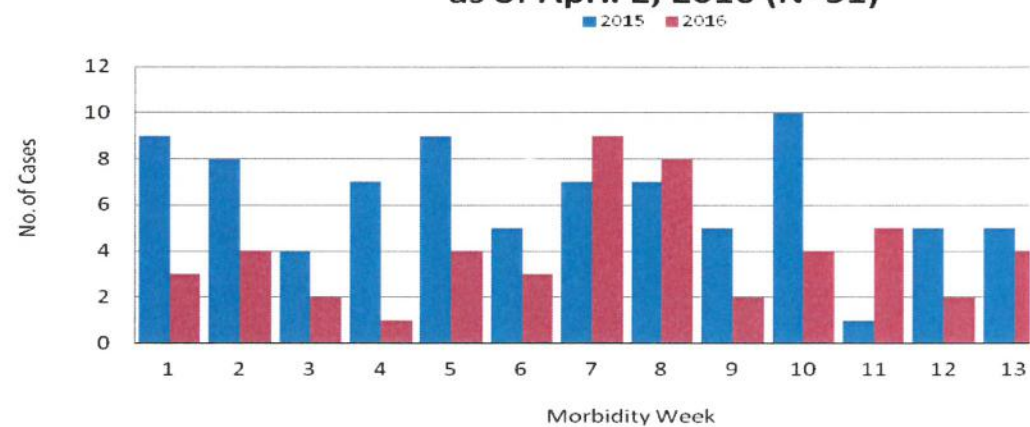
**Fig. 22 Suspect Leptospirosis Cases

Fig. 25 Confirmed Non-neonatal Tetanus Cases as of April 2, 2016 (n=177)

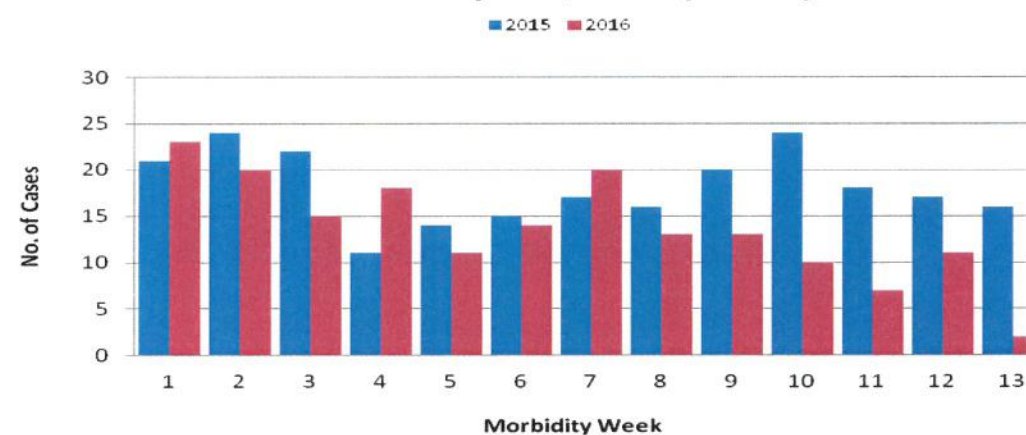


Fig. 26 Confirmed Hepatitis B Cases as of April 2, 2016 (n=660)

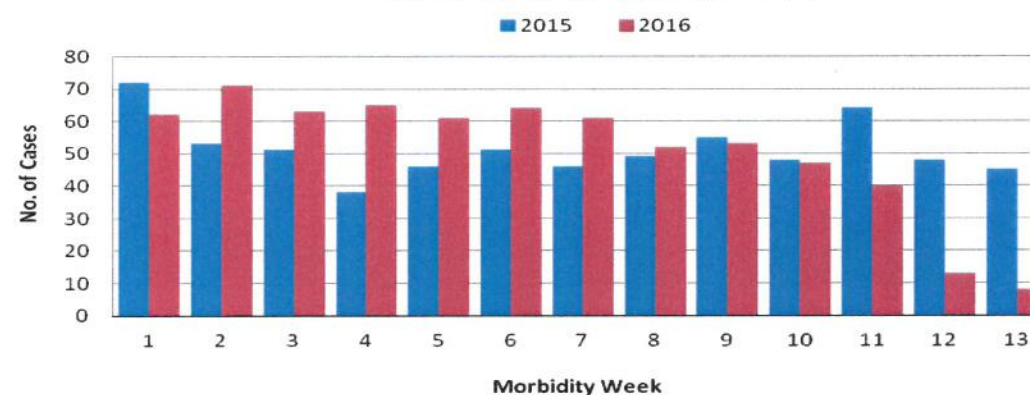
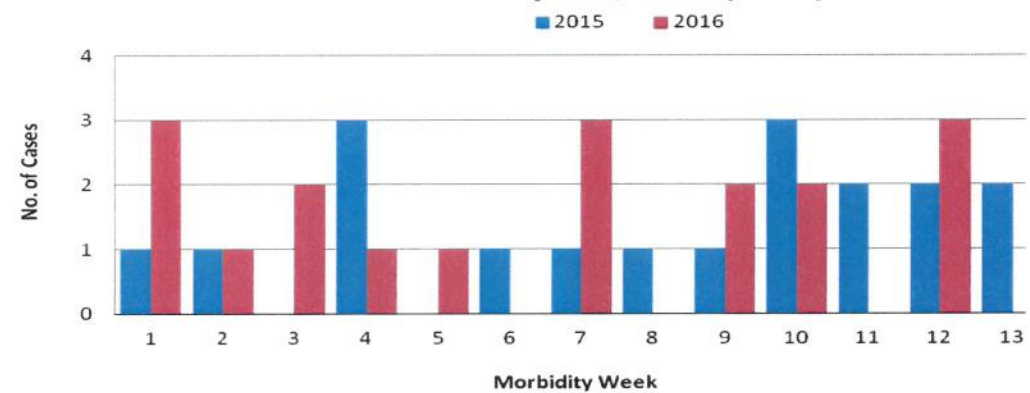


Fig. 27 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases as of April 2, 2016 (n=18)







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
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
