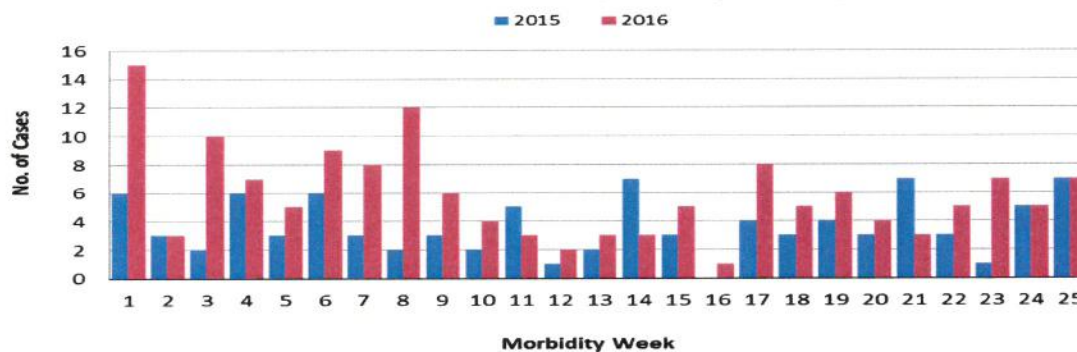

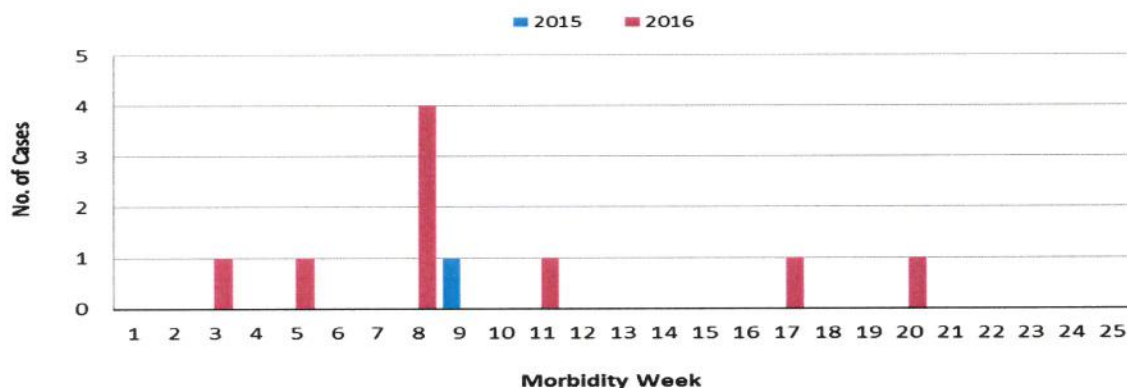

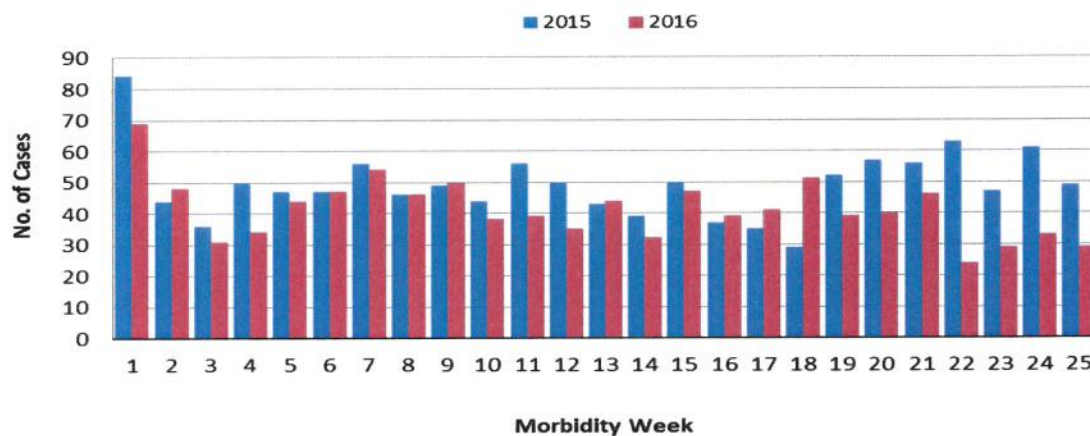
**Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases

as of June 25, 2016 (N=1,029)**

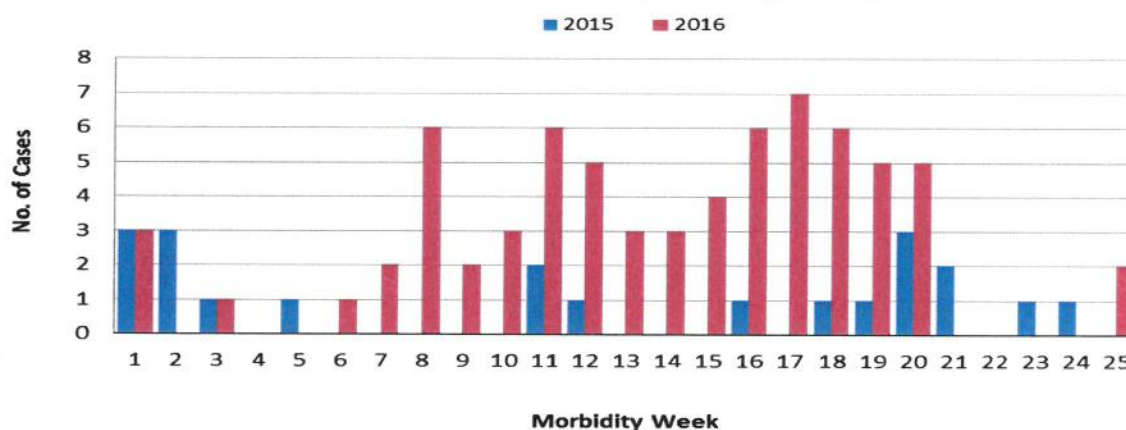




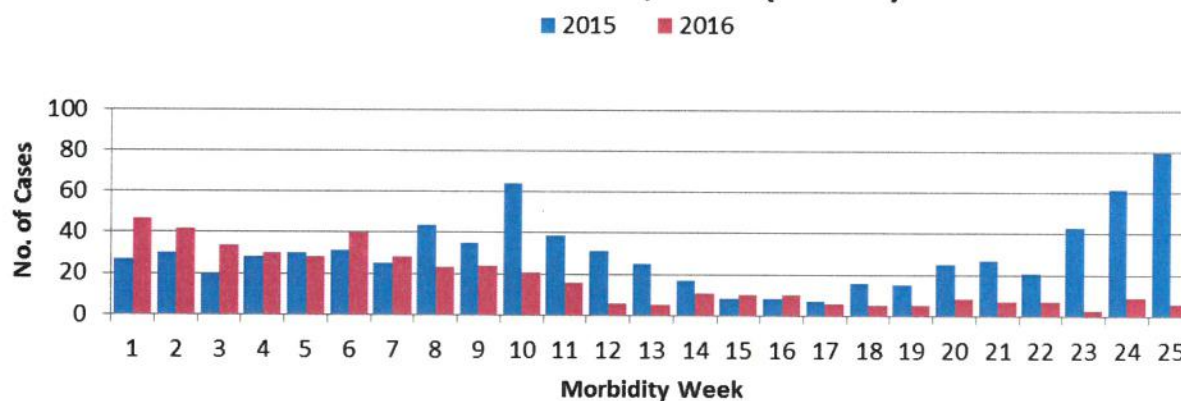

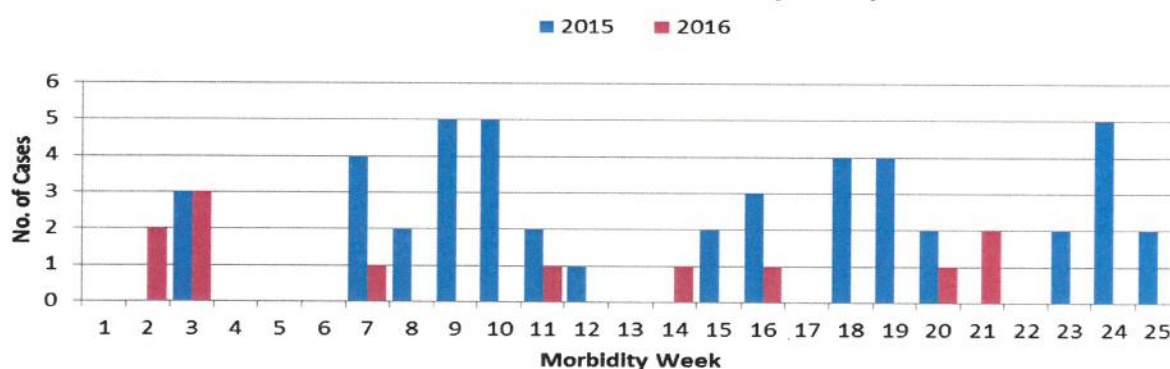
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of June 25, 2016 (n=12)**

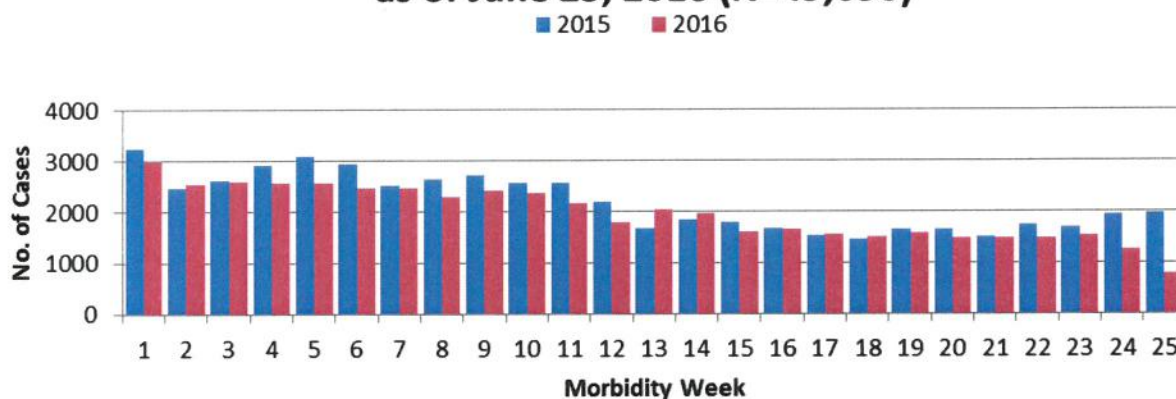




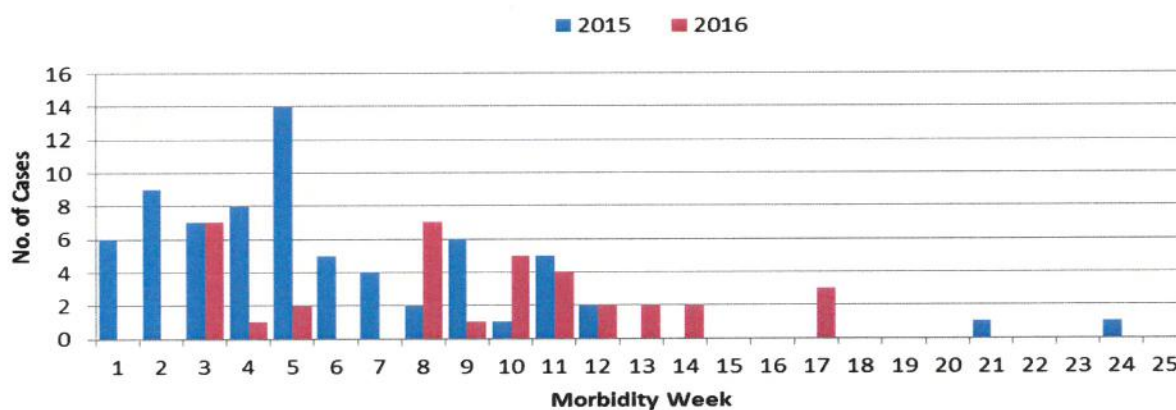

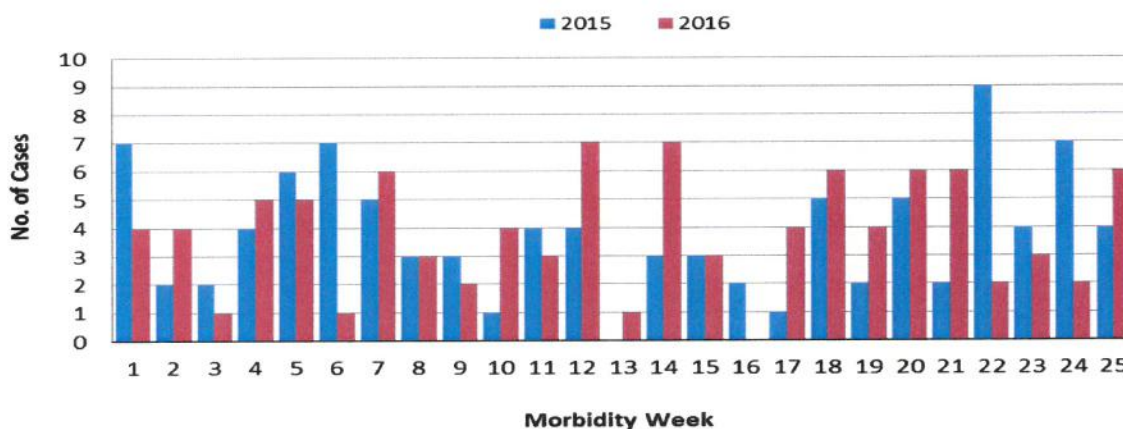
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of June 25, 2016 (N=95)**

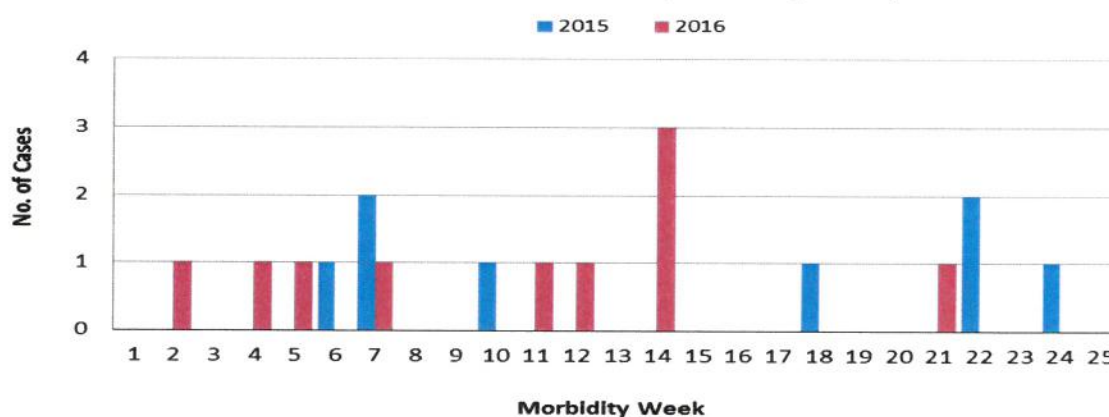

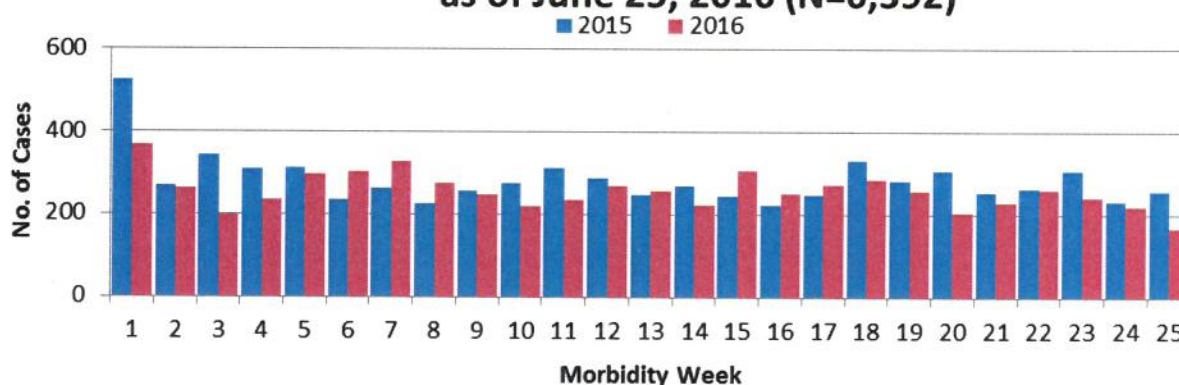

as of June 25, 2016 (n=10)**

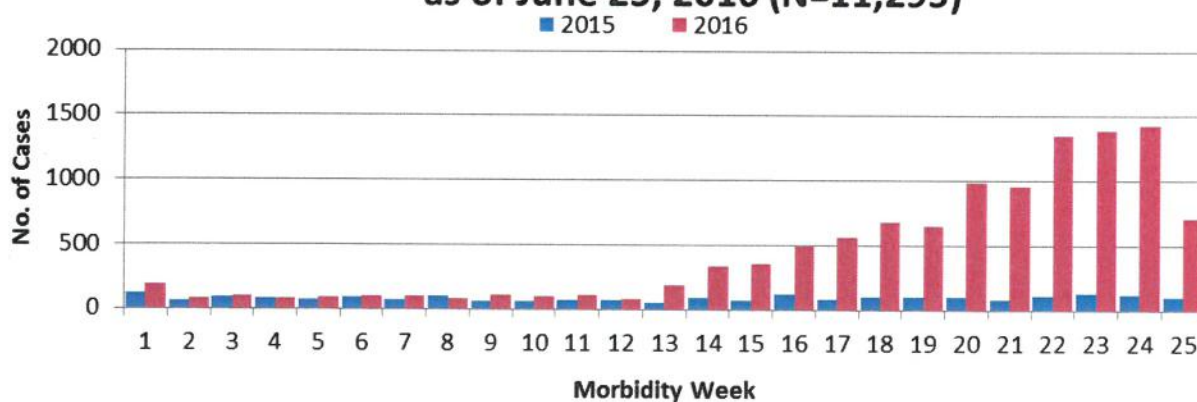

as of June 25, 2016 (N=11,295)**

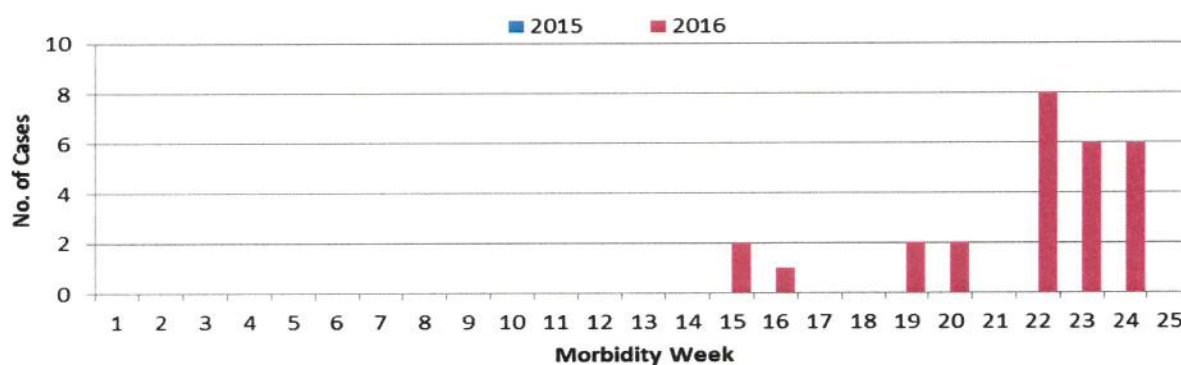




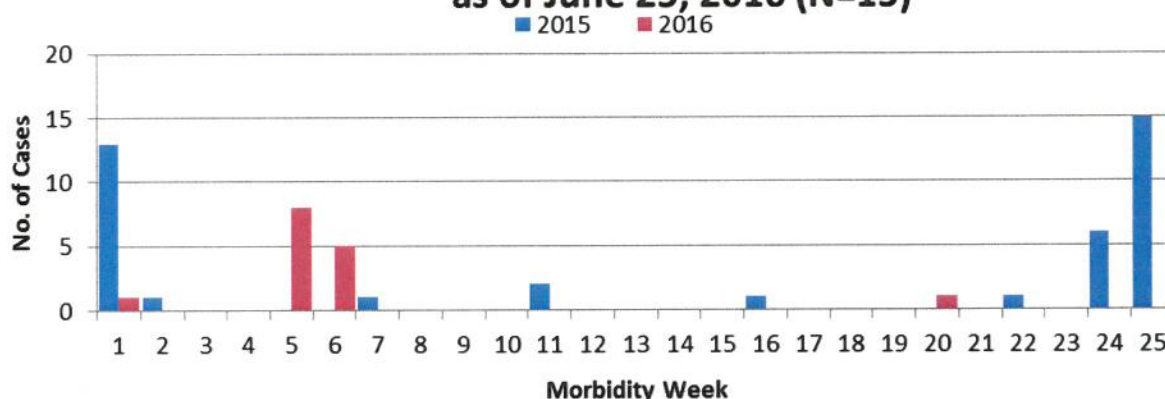

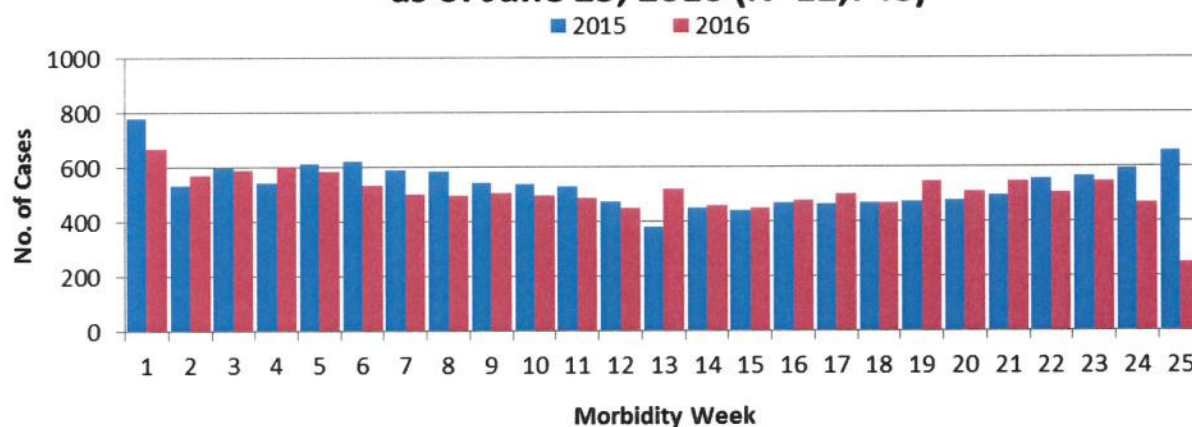
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of June 25, 2016 (N=12,748)**

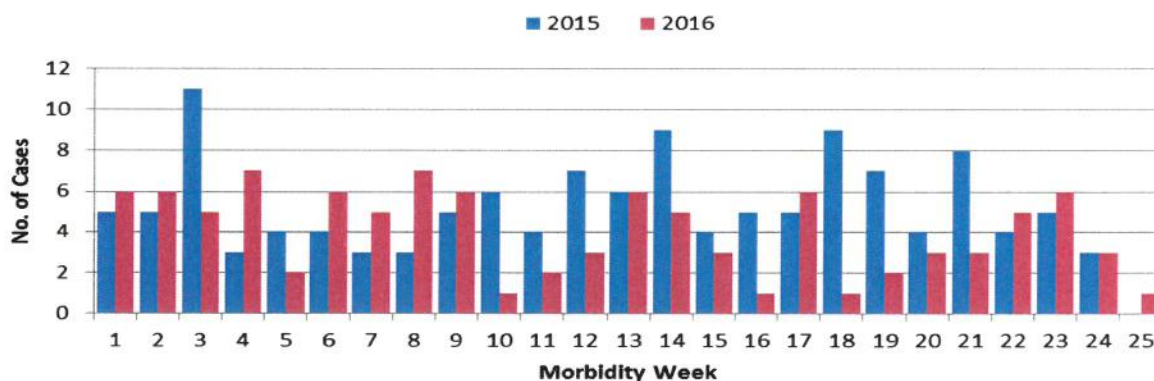




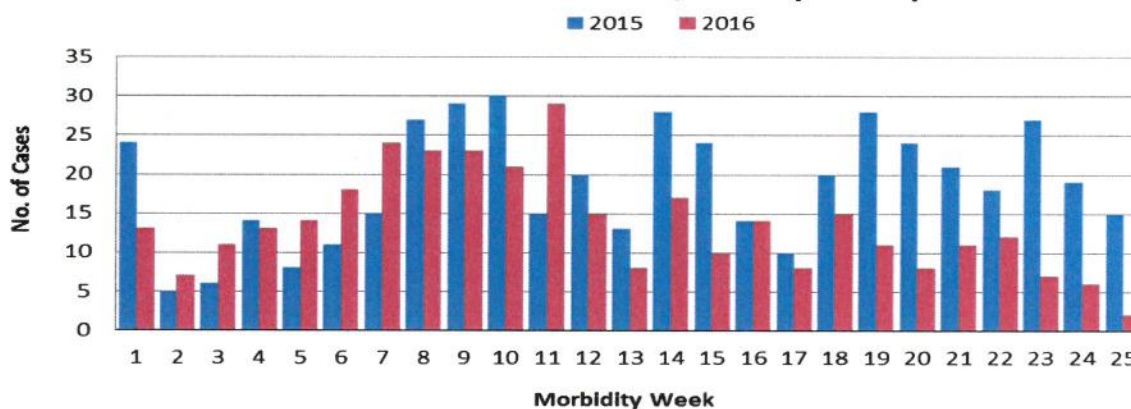

as of June 25, 2016 (n=101)**

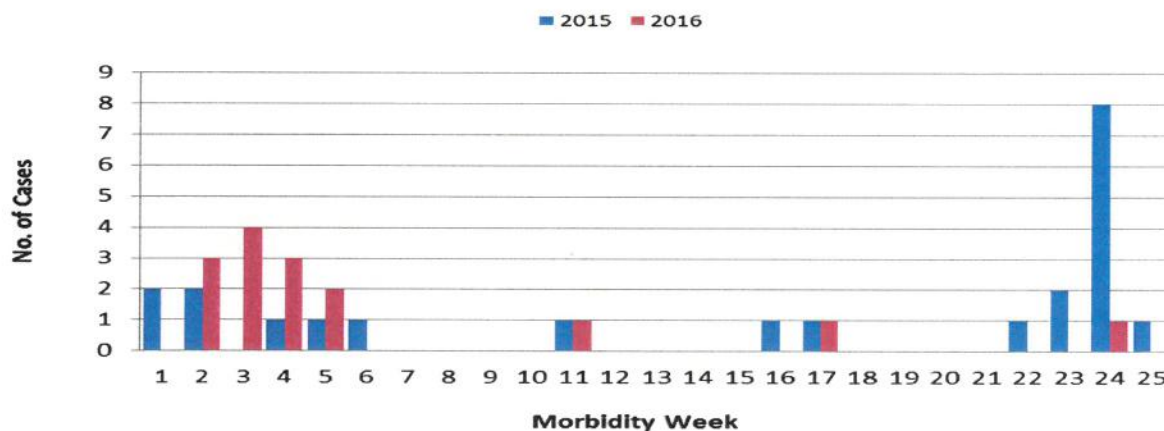


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of June 25, 2016 (N=15)**

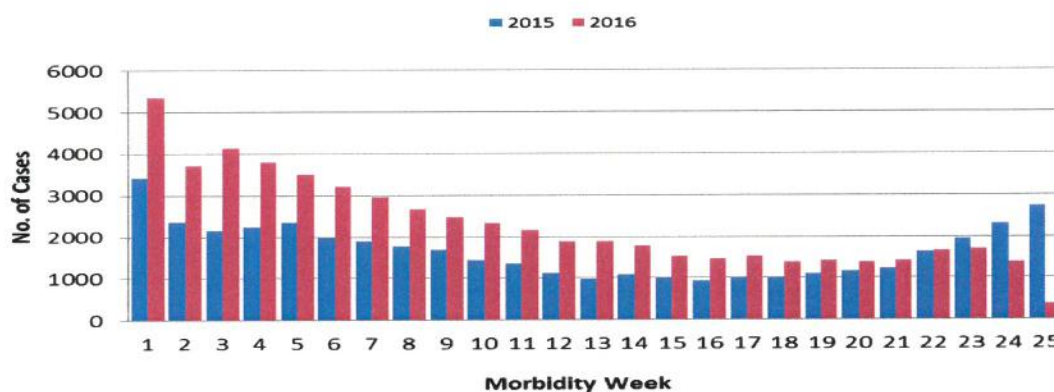




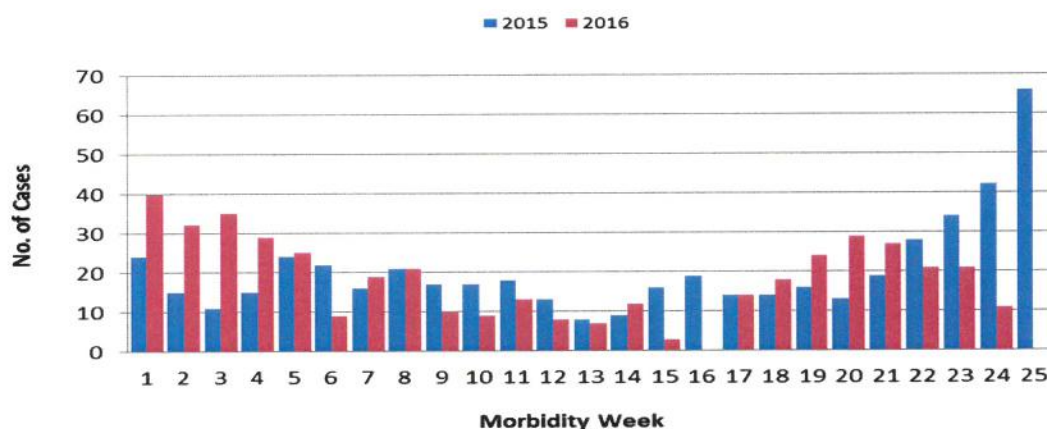

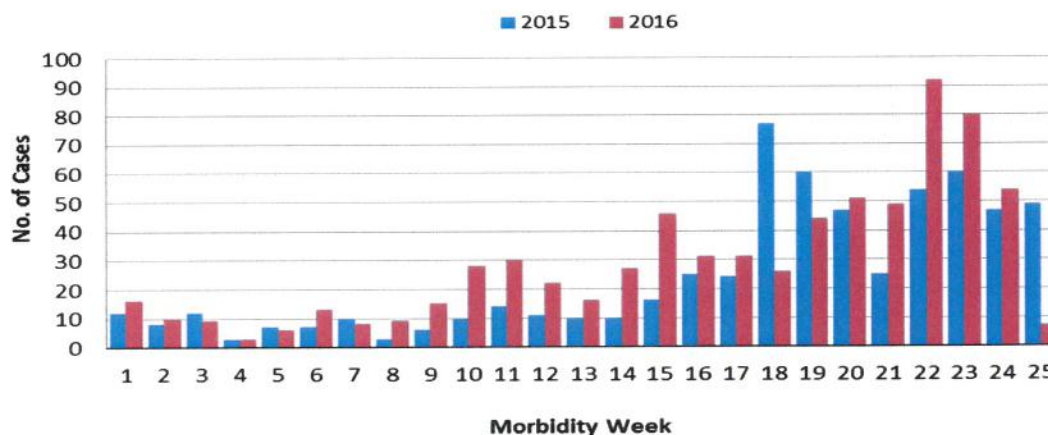
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of June 25, 2016 (N=723)**



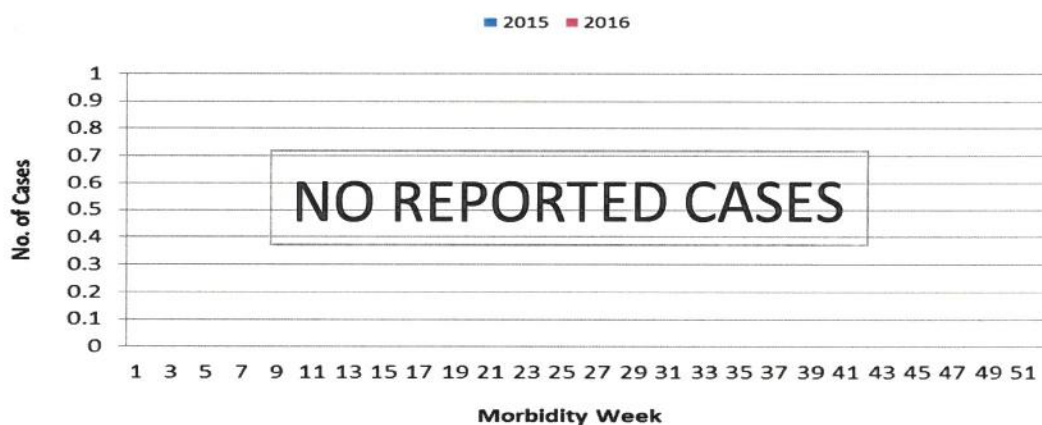

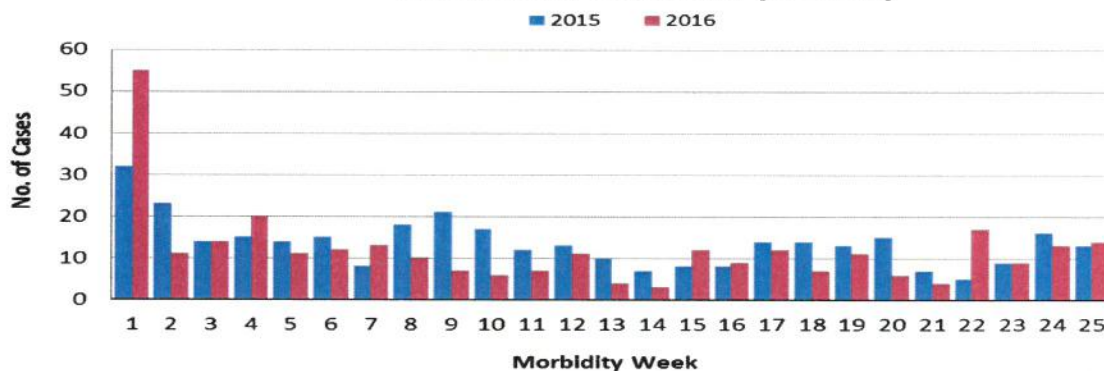

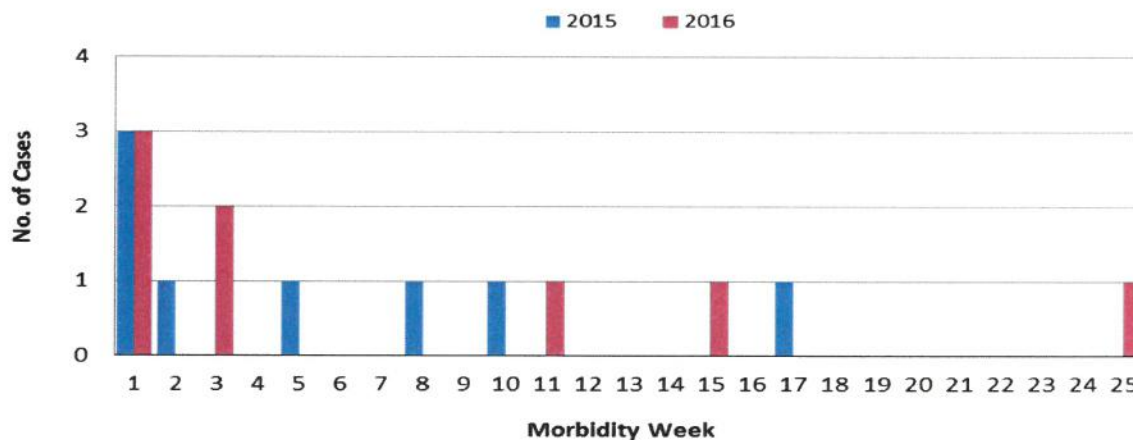
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of June 25, 2016 (n=8)**

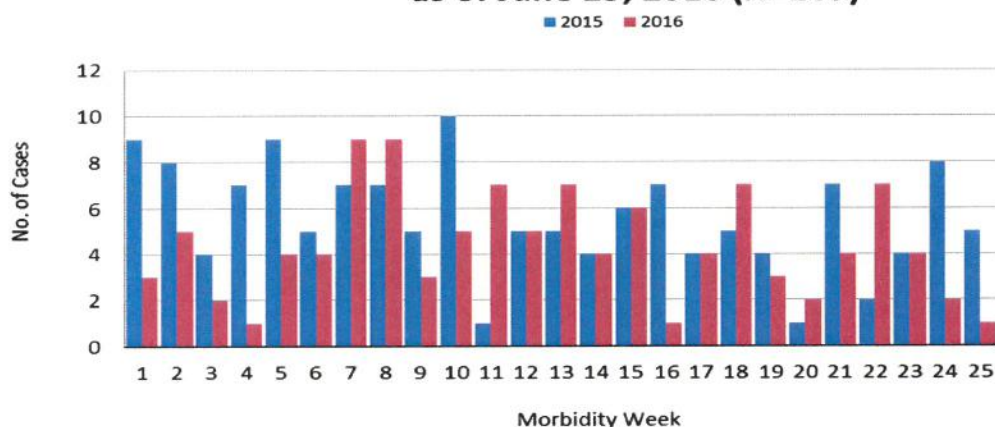

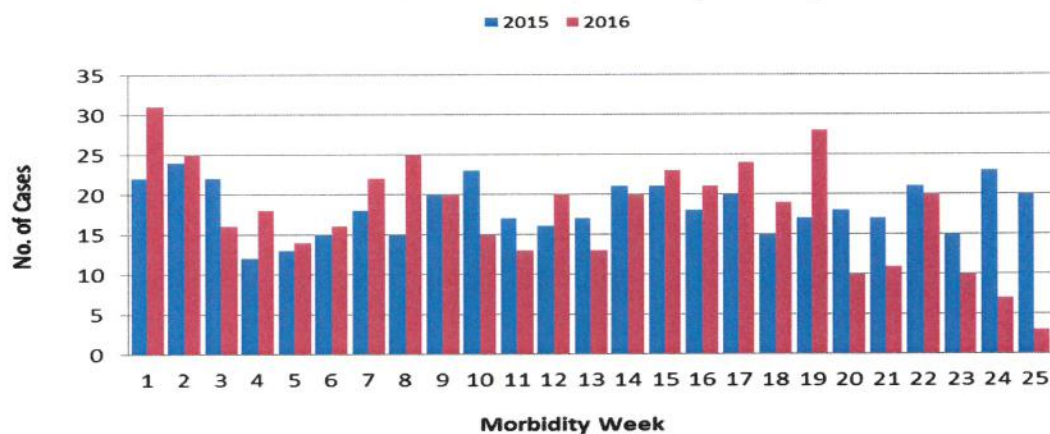

as of June 25, 2016 (N=109)**

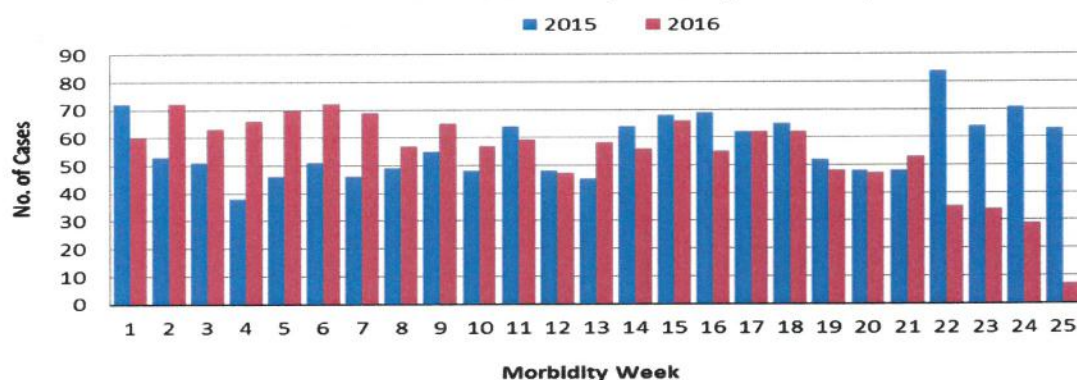

as of June 25, 2016 (n=1369)**

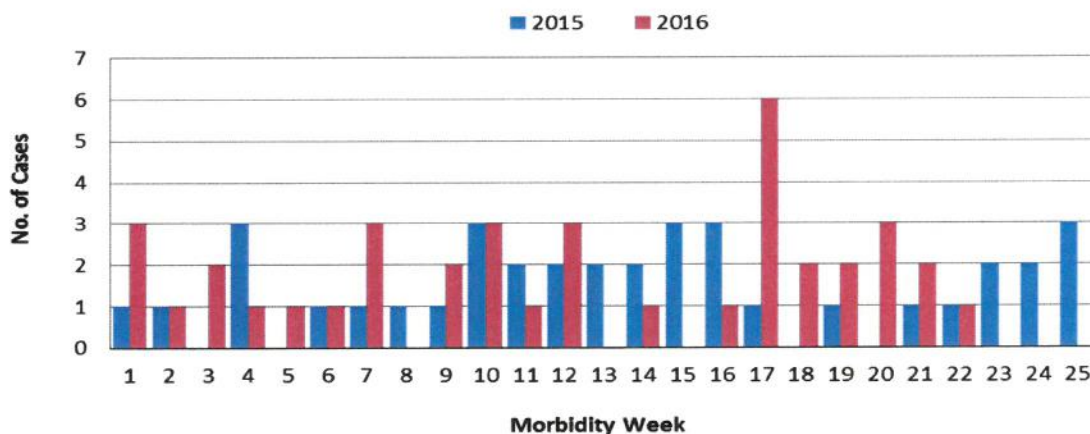



as of June 25, 2016 (n=39)**





