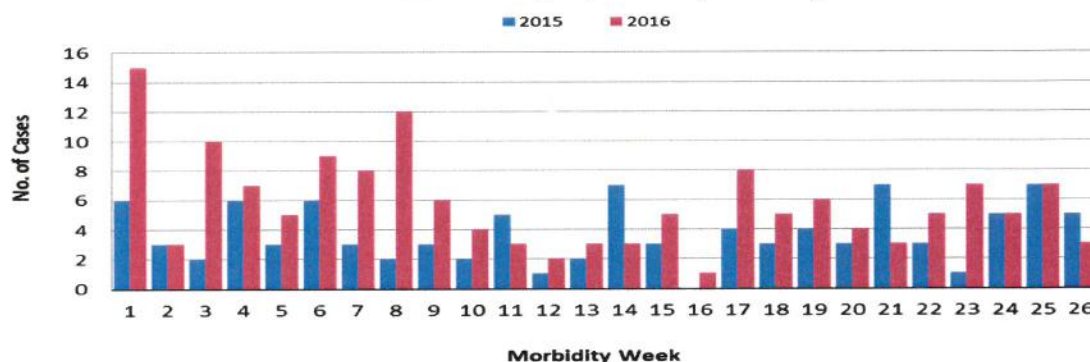


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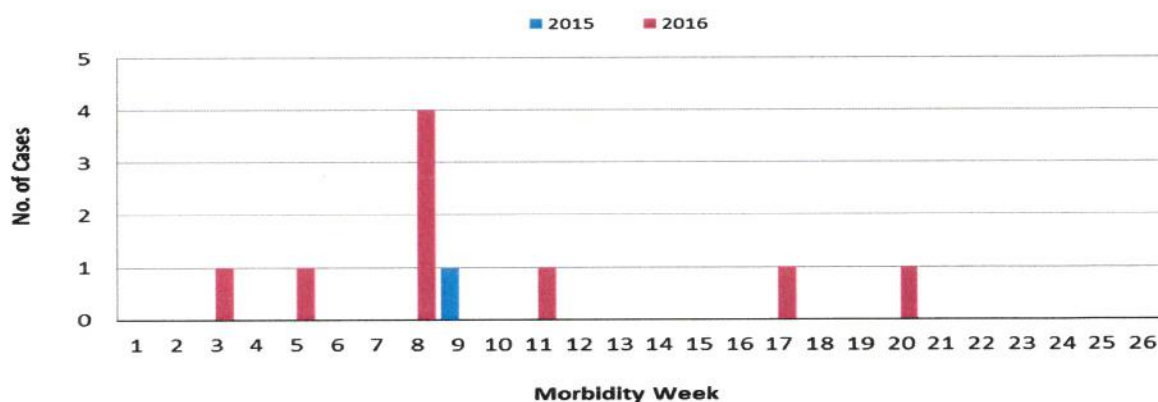

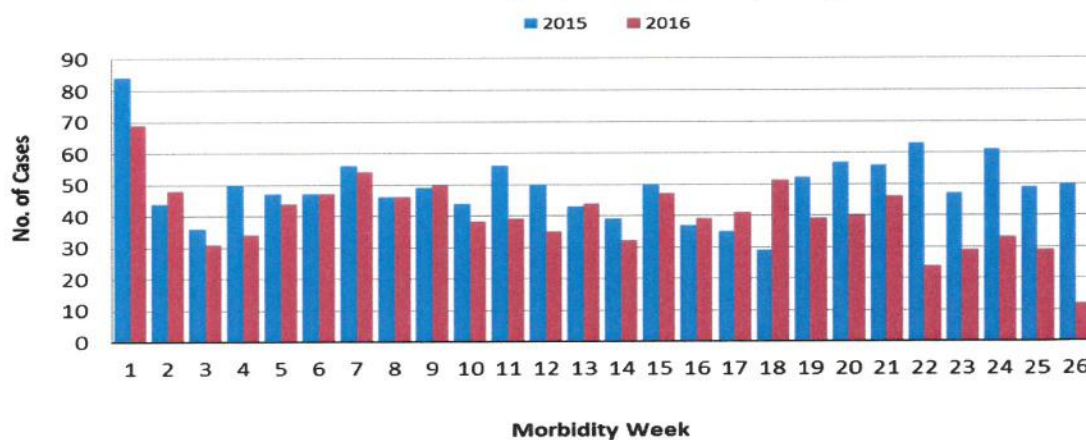
**Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of July 2, 2016 (N=149)**

**Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of July 2, 2016 (N=1,041)**



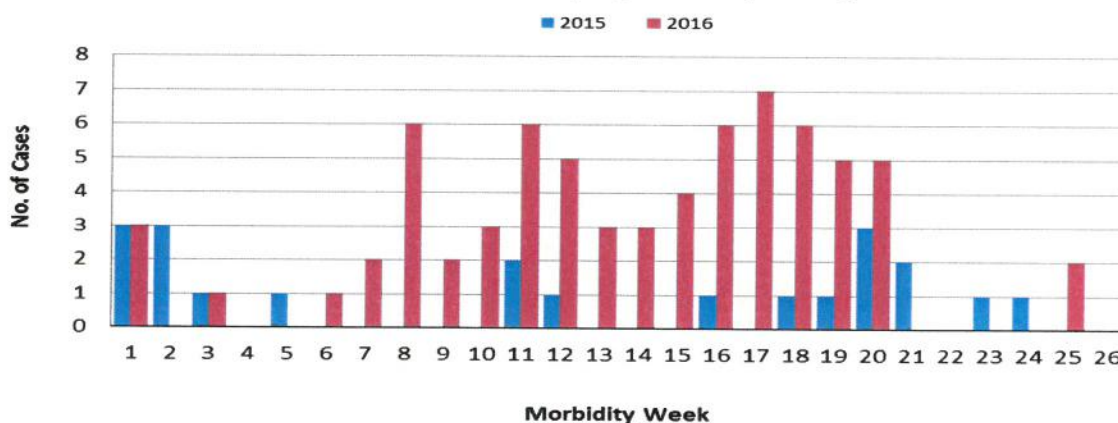




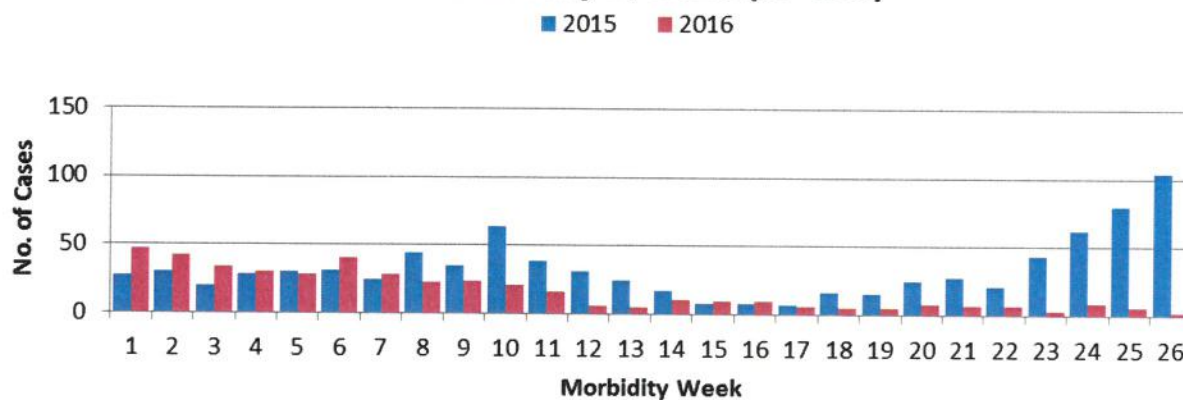
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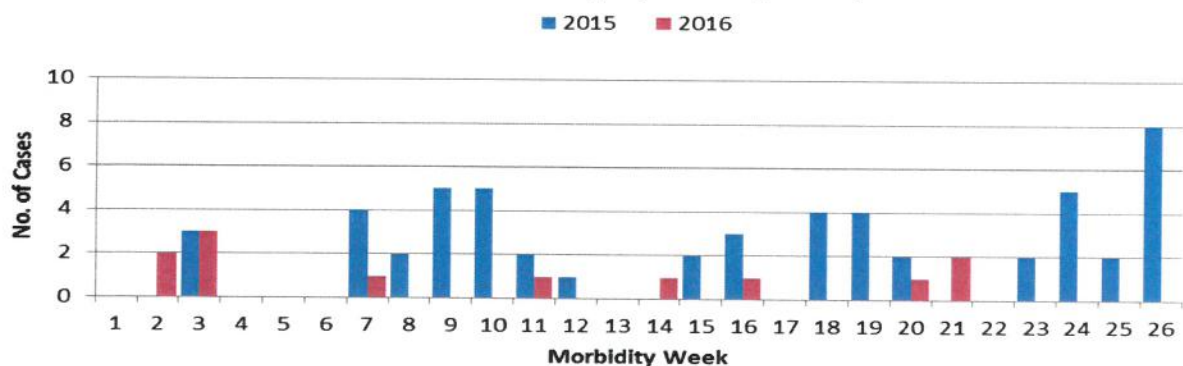
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of July 2, 2016 (n=12)**

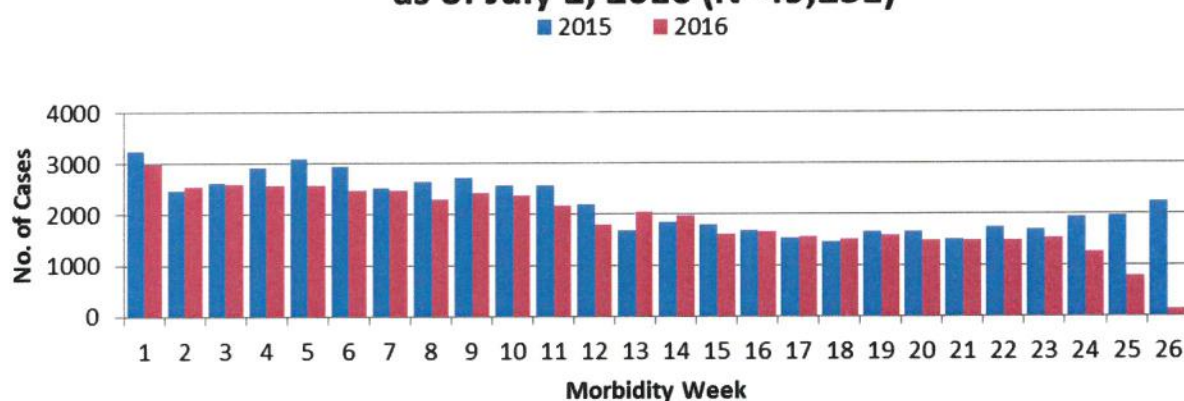




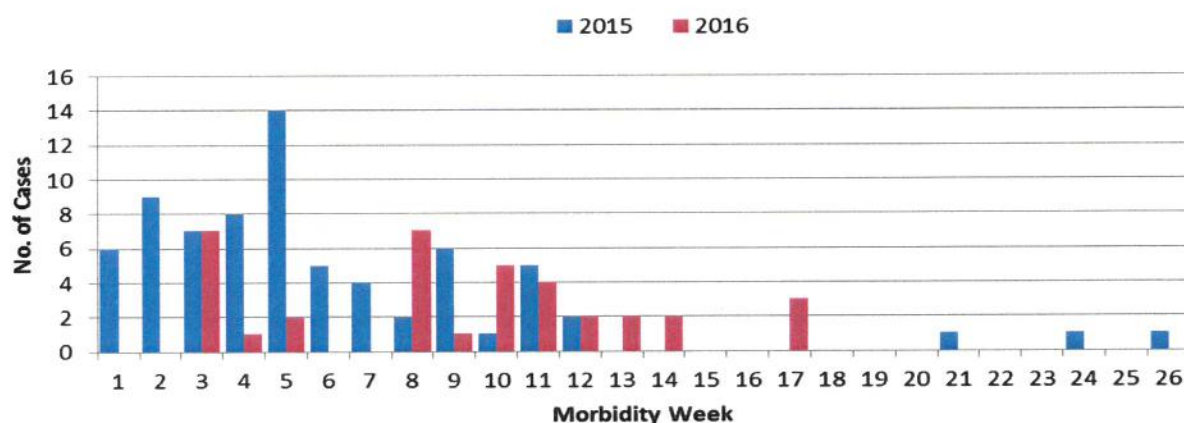
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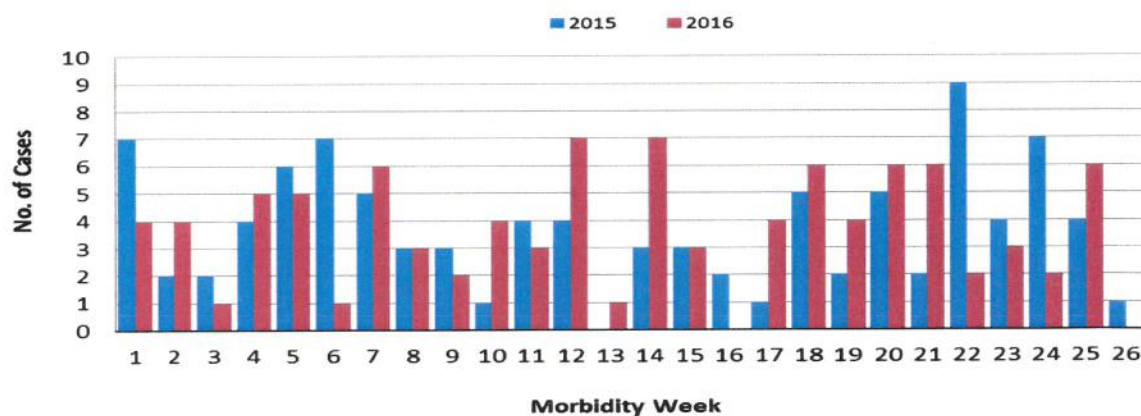
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of July 2, 2016 (N=95)**

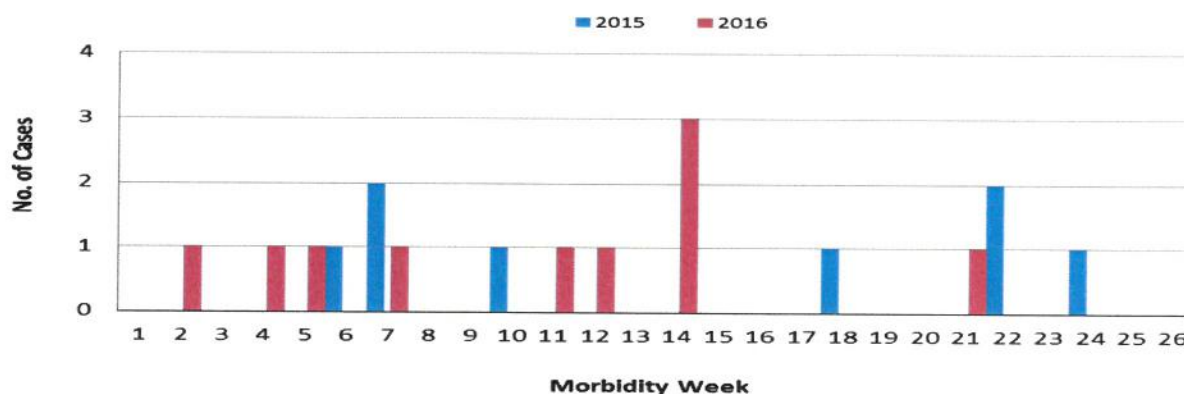




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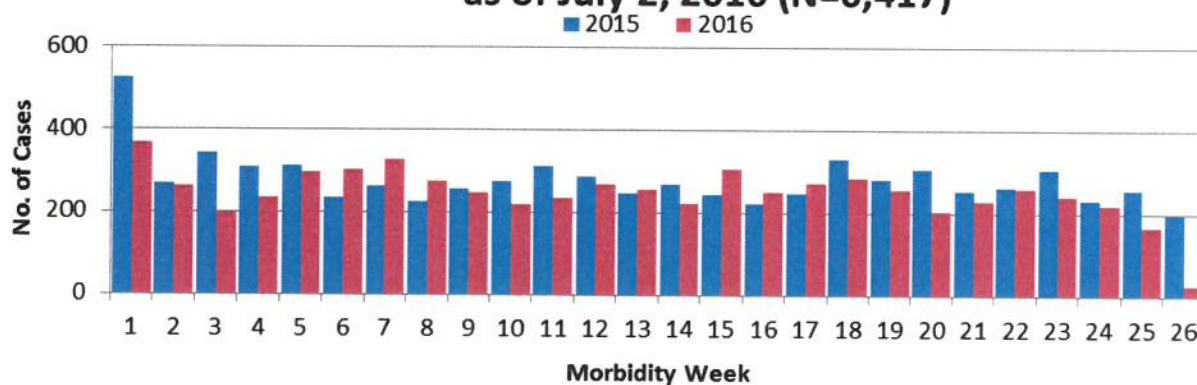
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases  
as of July 2, 2016 (n=10)**

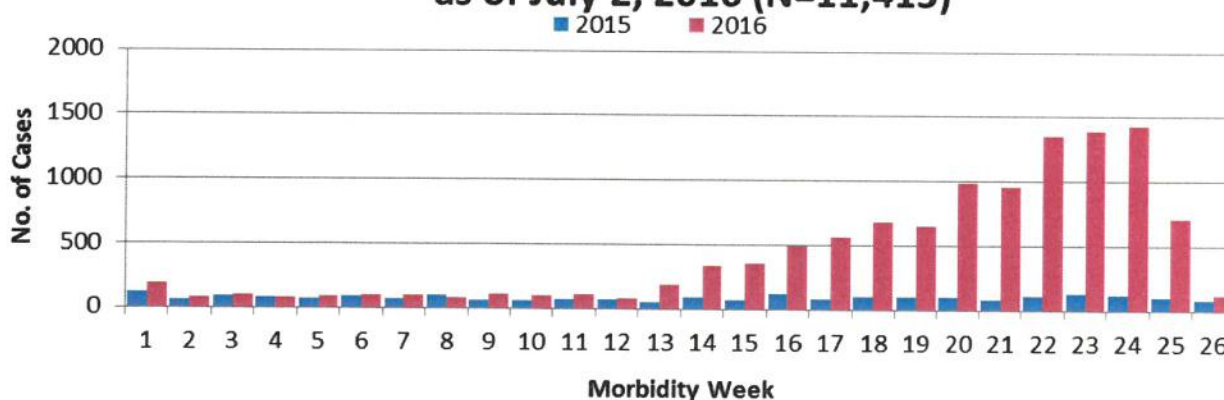

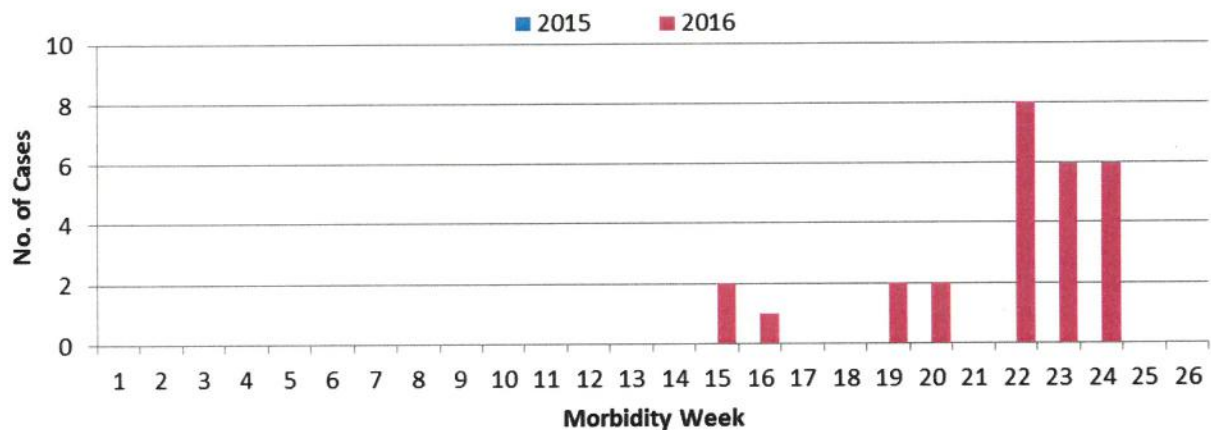




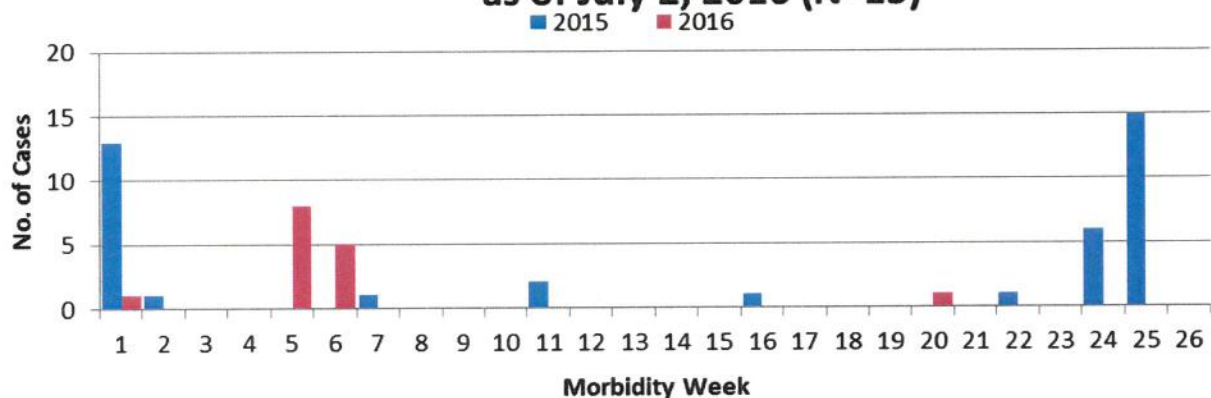
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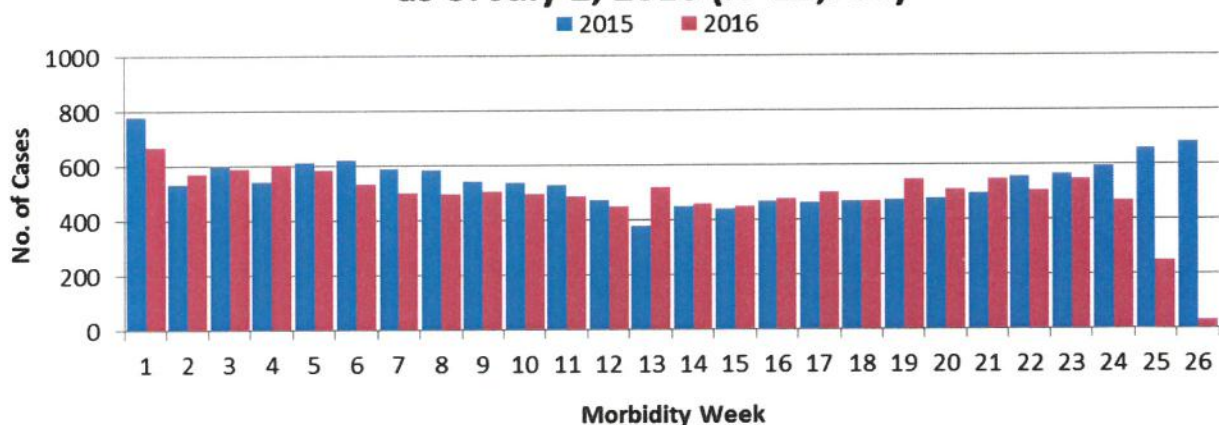
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of July 2, 2016 (N=12,780)**

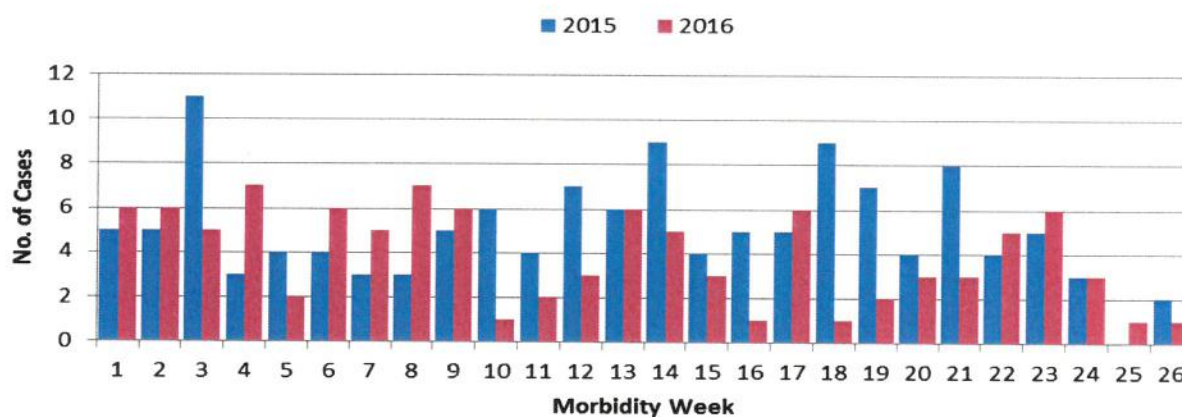




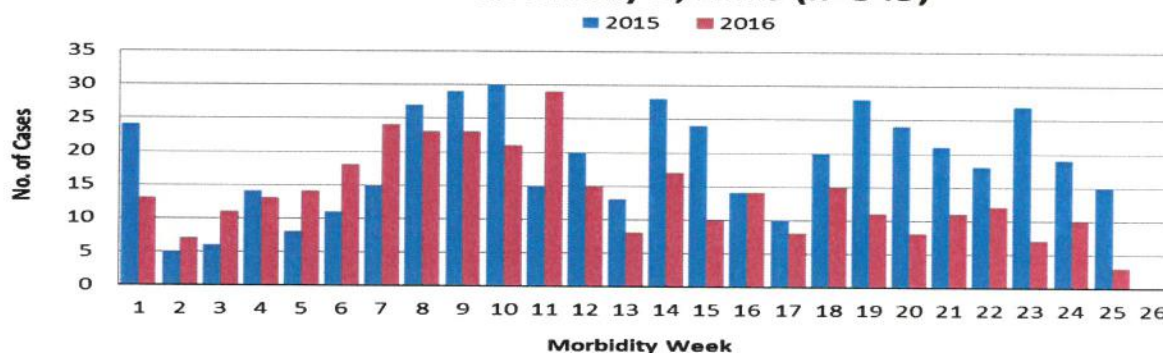
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**Fig.16 Confirmed Typhoid Cases  
 as of July 2, 2016 (n=102)**

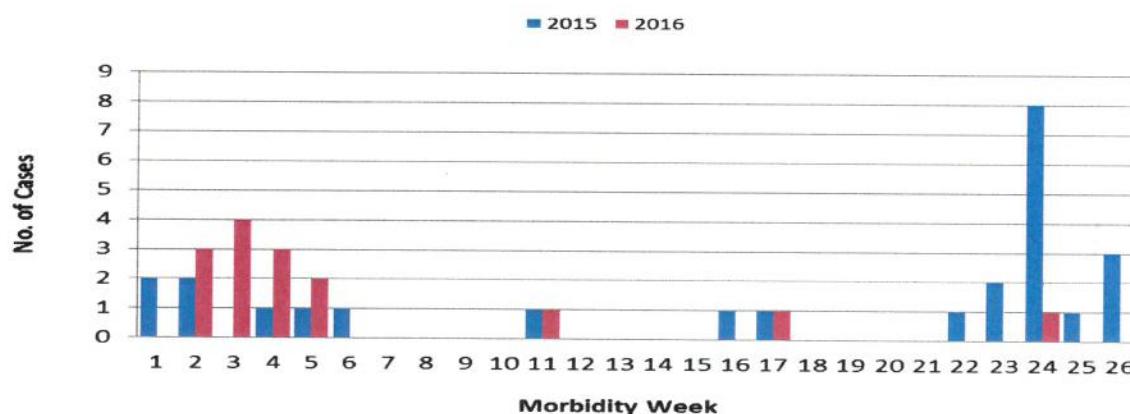


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

 as of July 2, 2016 (N=15)**

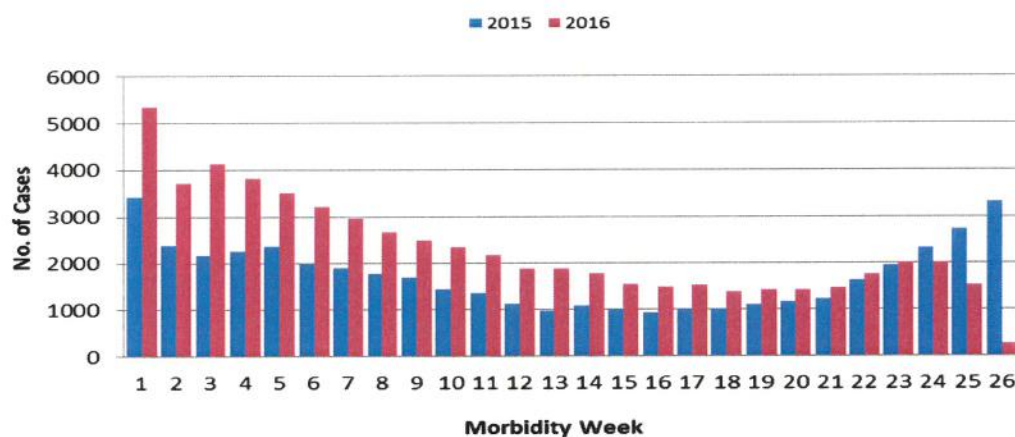




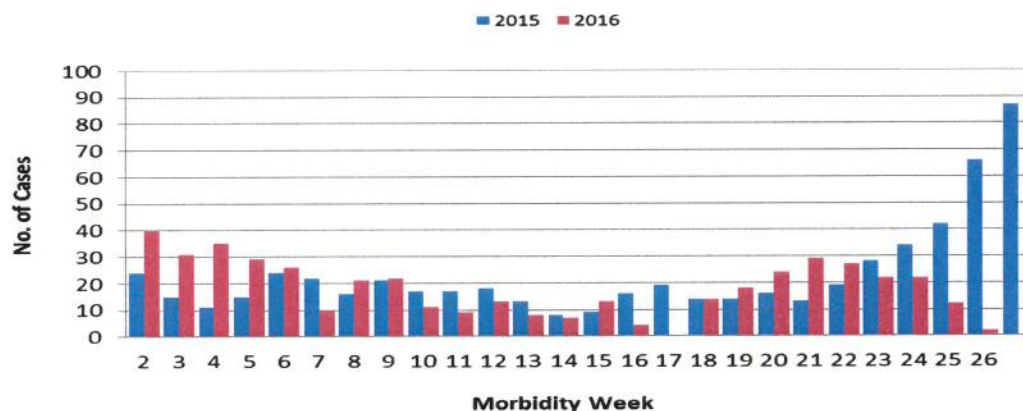
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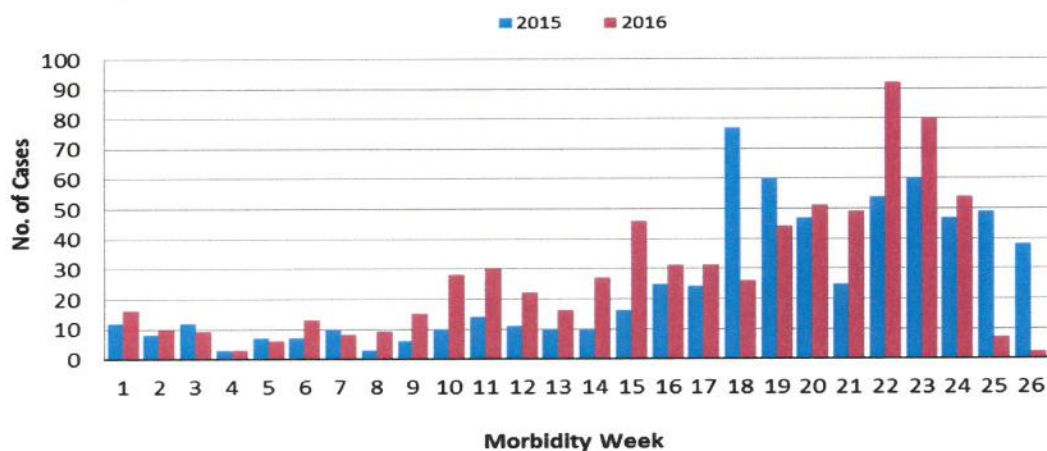
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of July 2, 2016 (N=725)**





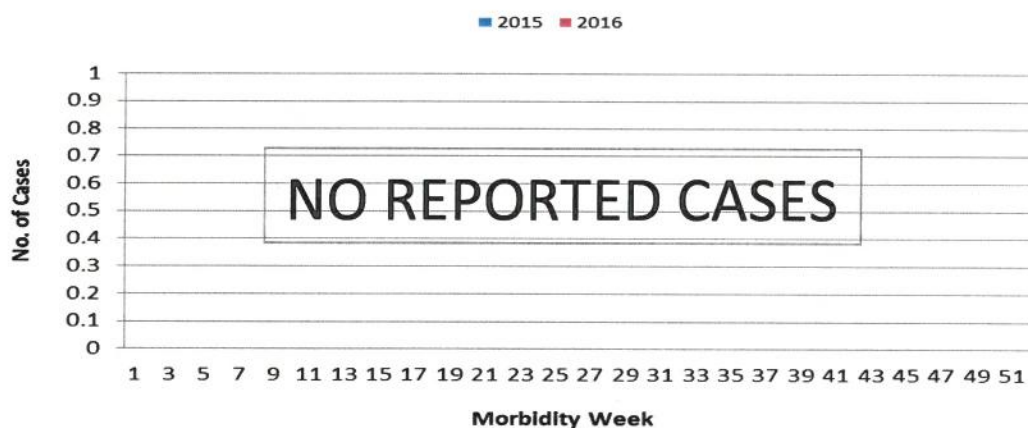


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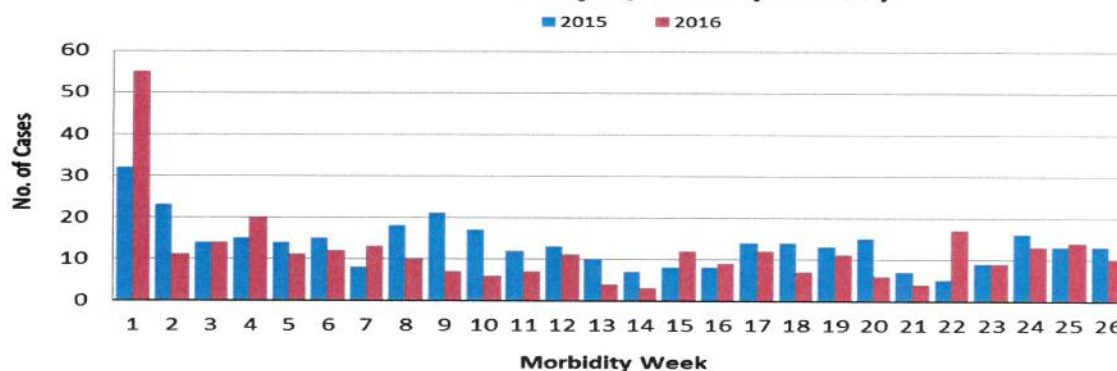

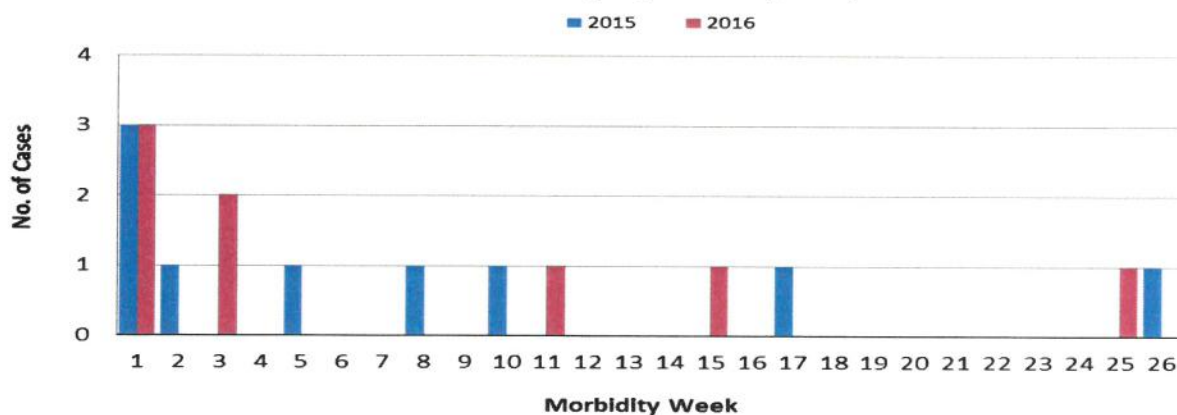
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of July 2, 2016 (n=8)**

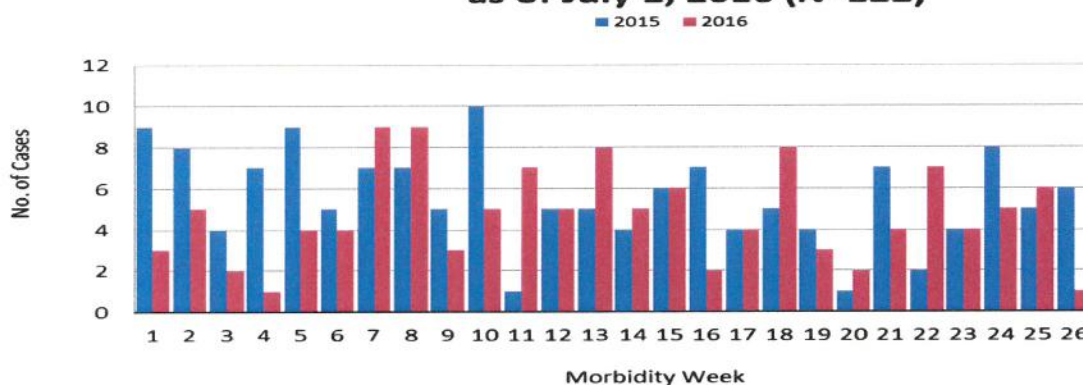




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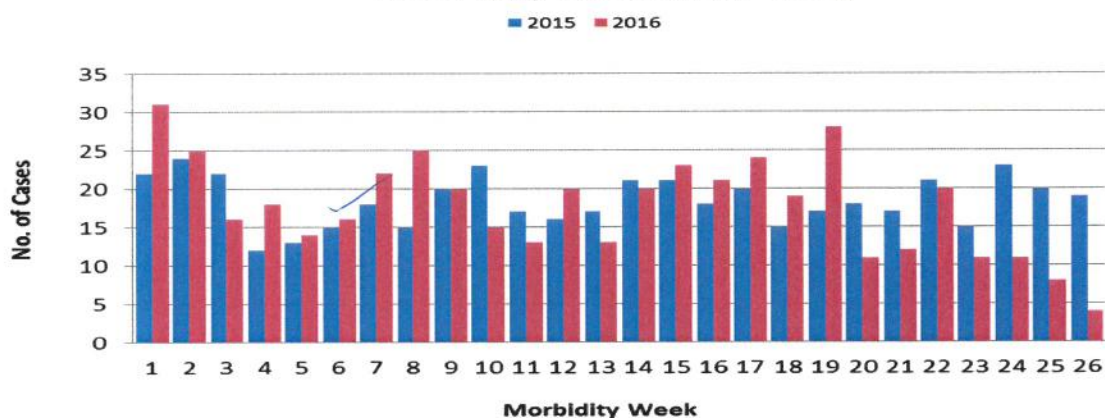
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**Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases  
as of July 2, 2016 (N=122)**

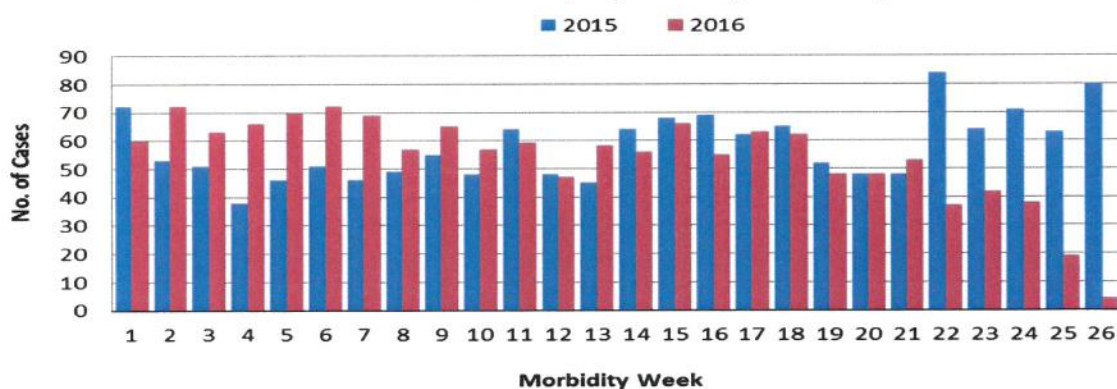

as of July 2, 2016 (n=1406)**



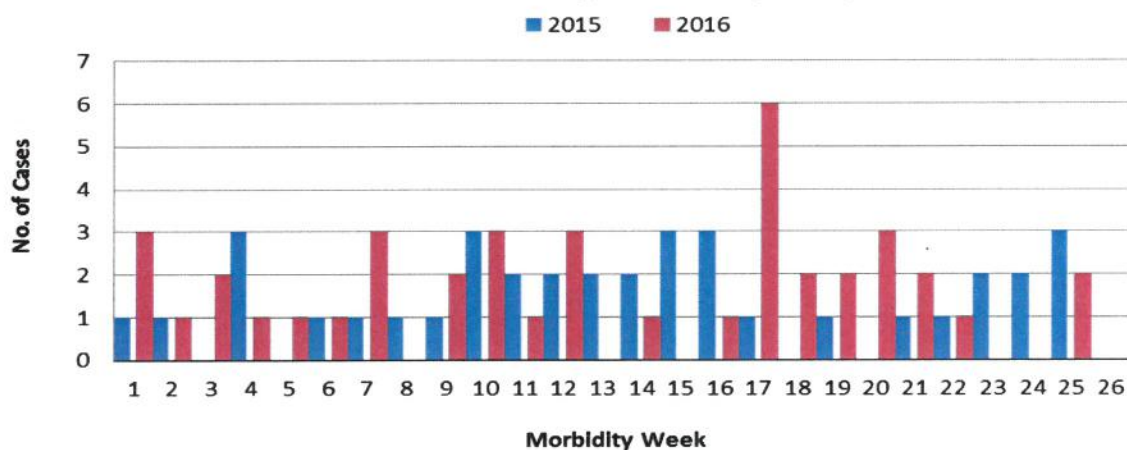





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
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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases
