Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of July 23, 2016 (N=195)

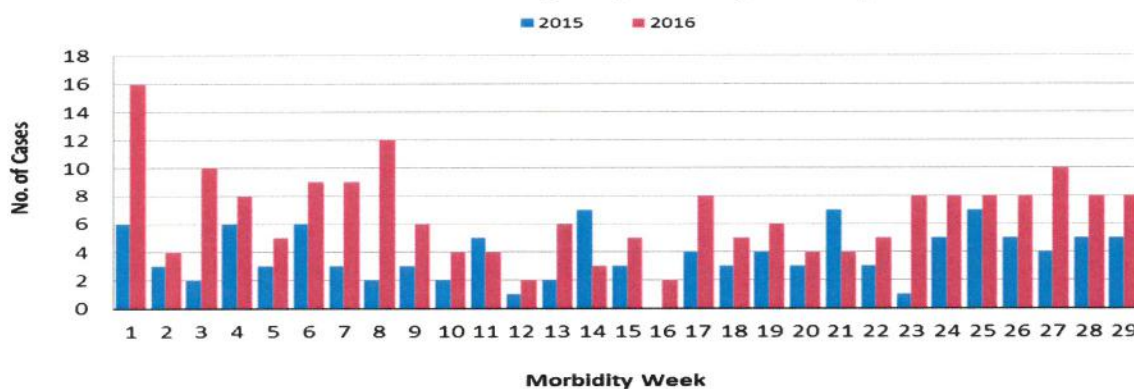


Fig. 2 Confirmed Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of July 23, 2016 (n=19)

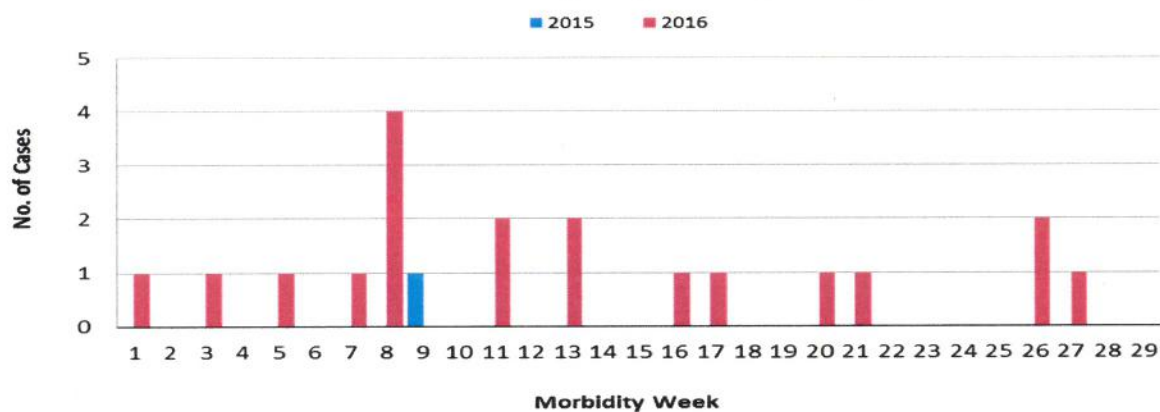
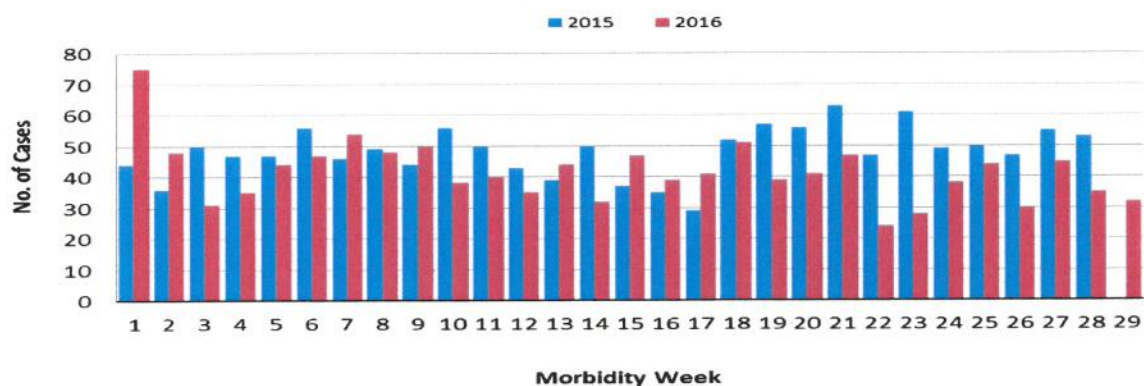


Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of July 23, 2016 (N=1,202)

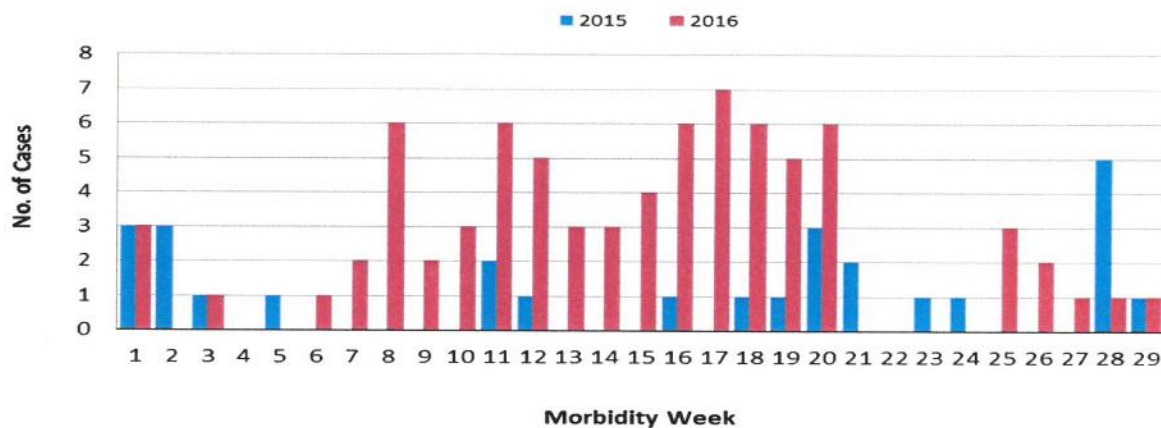




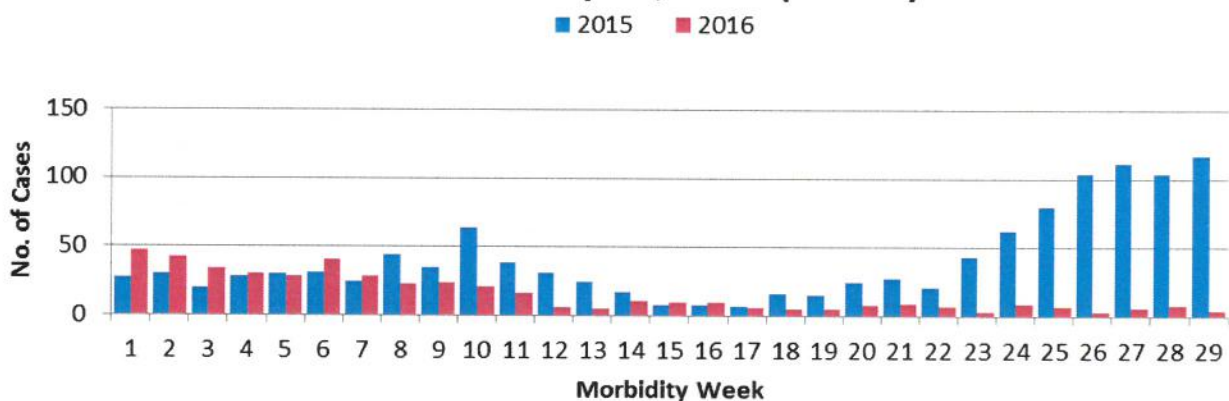
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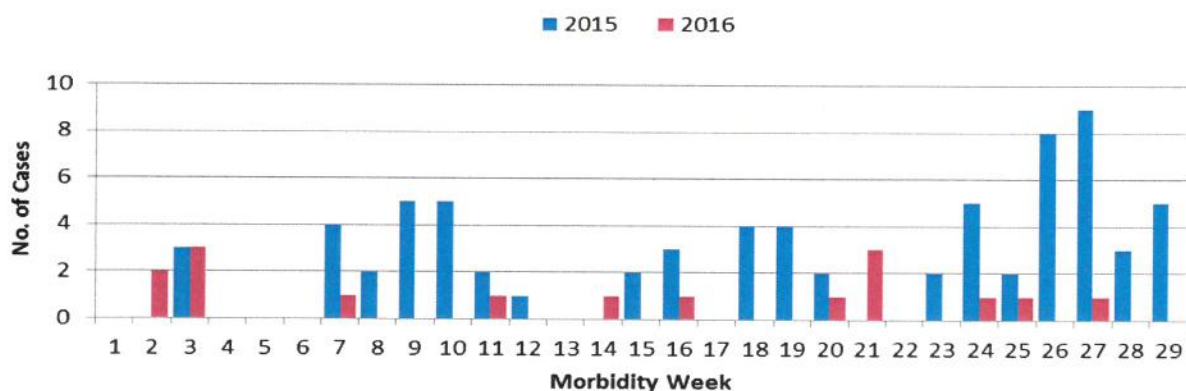
**Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases

as of July 23, 2016 (n=16)**

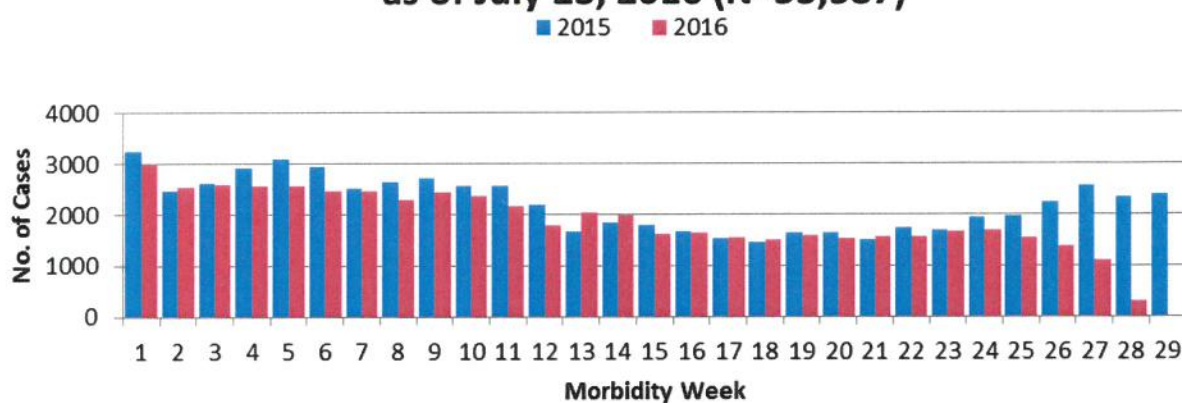




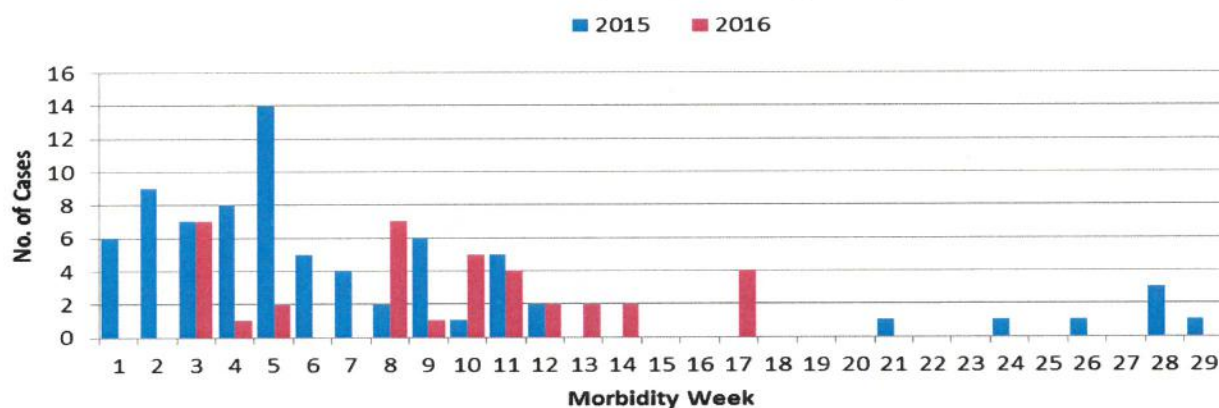
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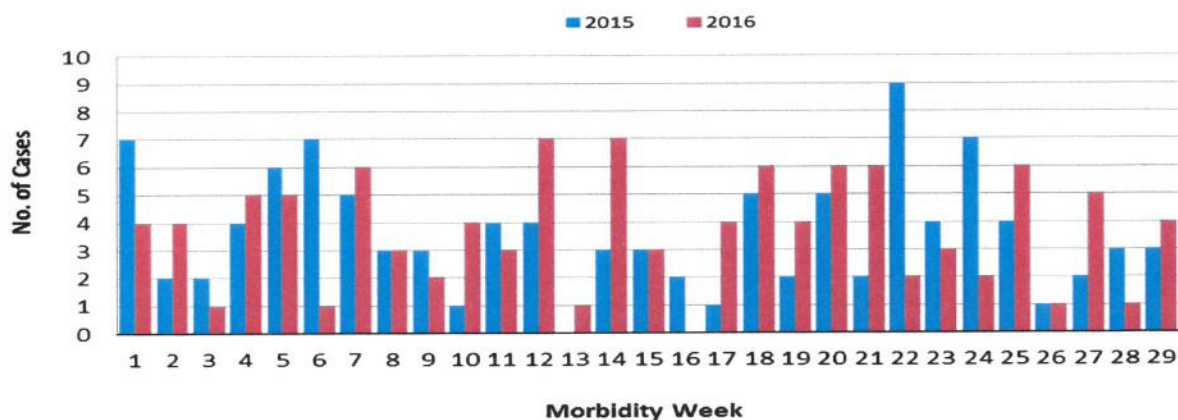
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of July 23, 2016 (N=106)**

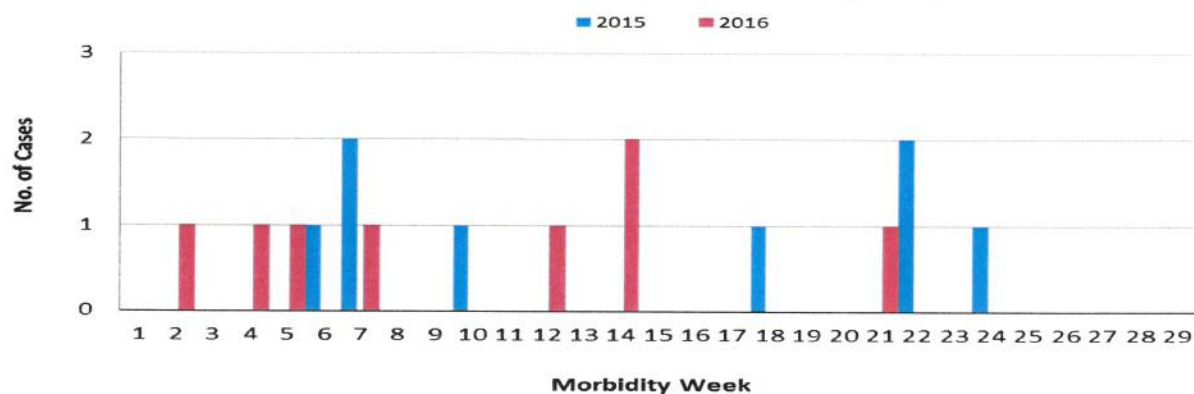




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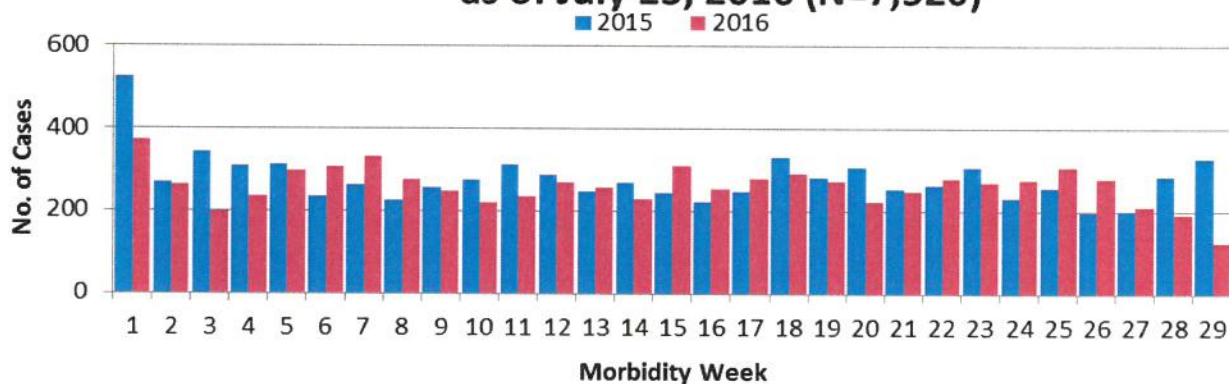
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**Fig. 10 Confirmed Meningococcal Disease Cases
as of July 23, 2016 (n=8)**

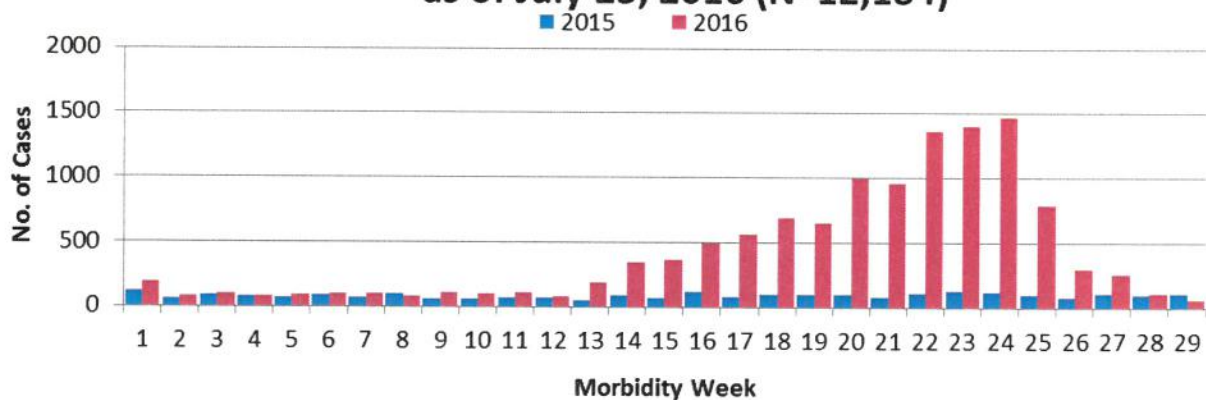

as of July 23, 2016 (N=12,184)**

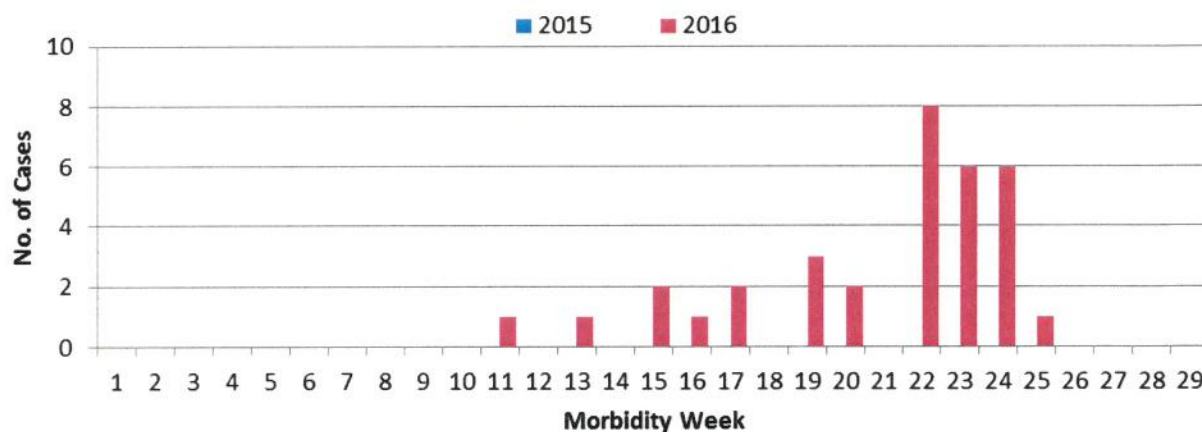




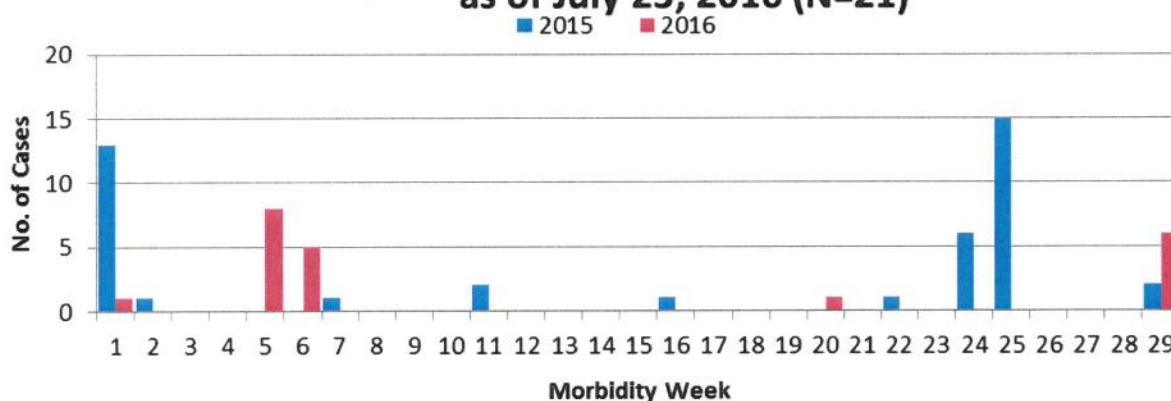
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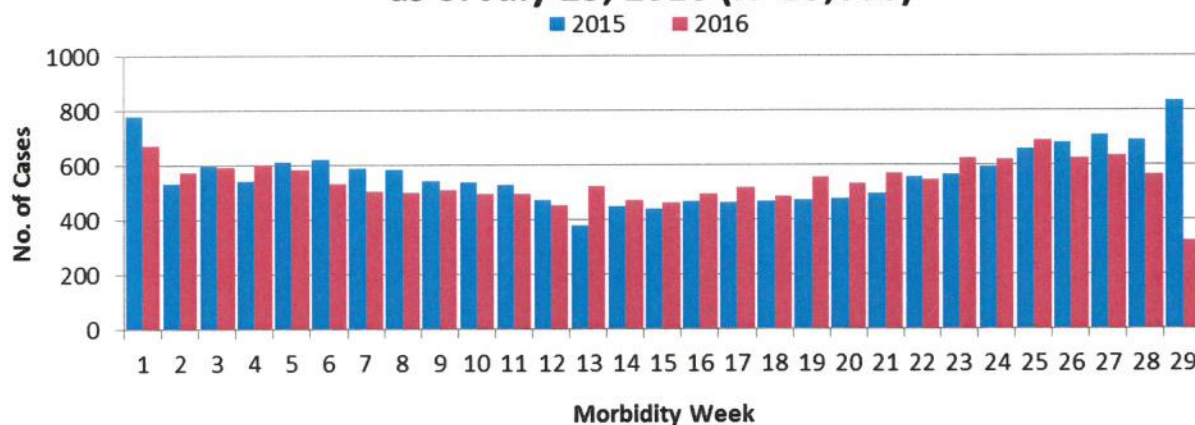
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of July 23, 2016 (N=15,808)**

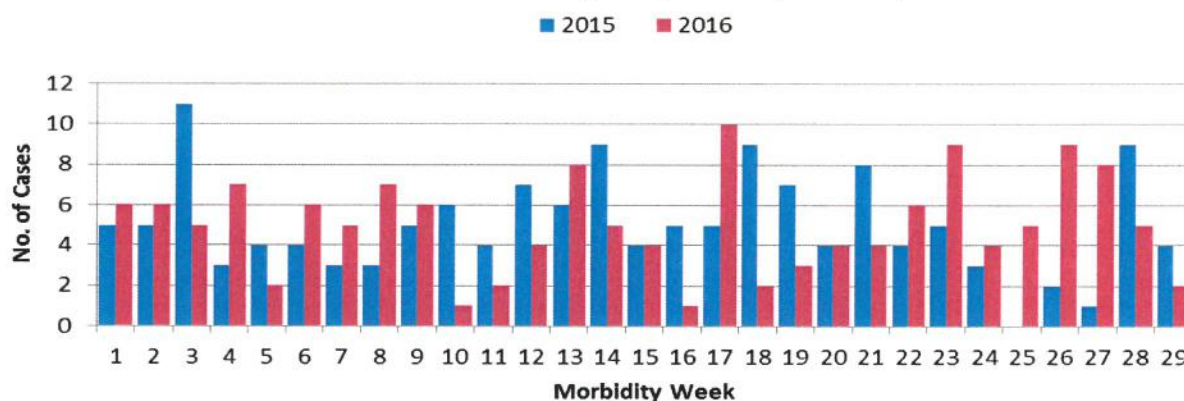




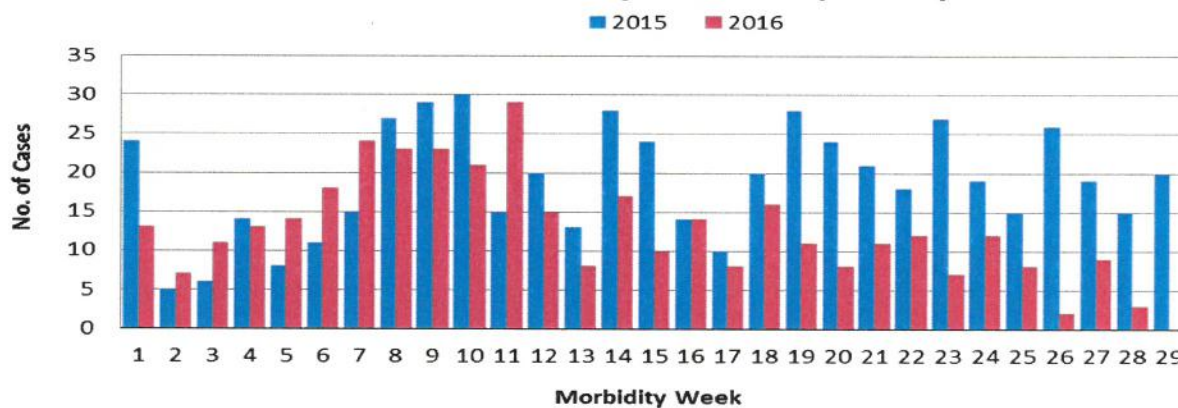
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**Fig.16 Confirmed Typhoid Cases
as of July 23, 2016 (n=146)**

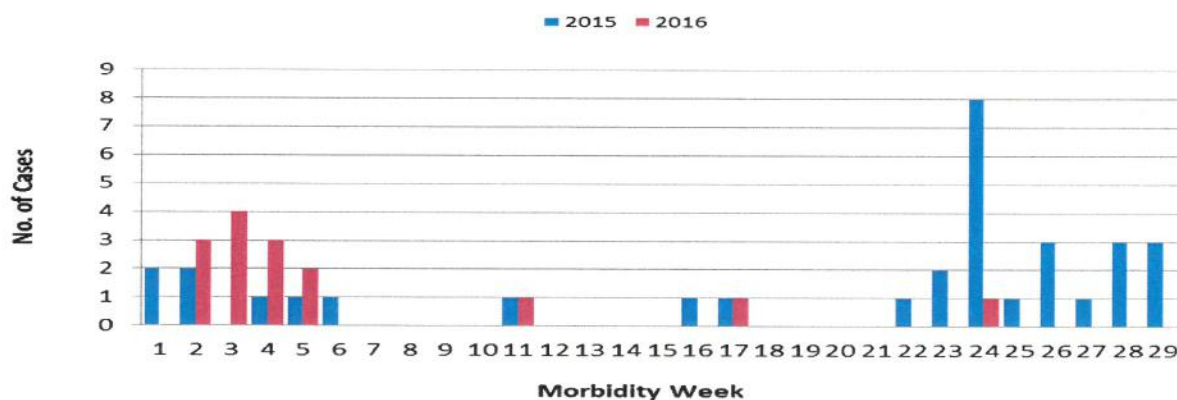


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of July 23, 2016 (N=15)**

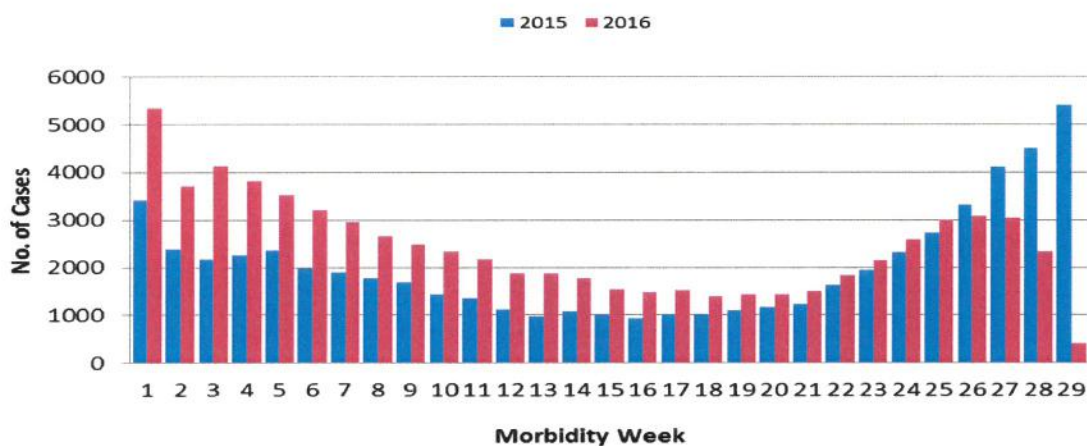




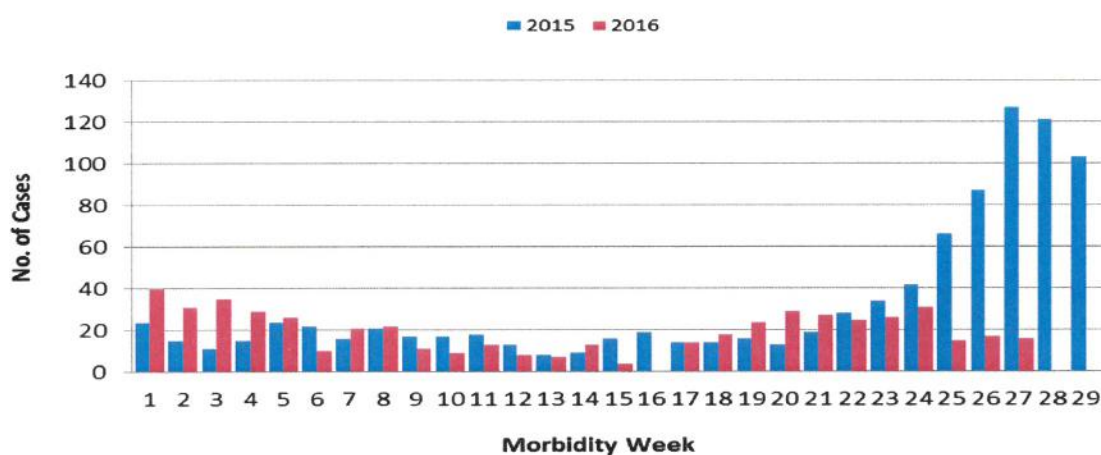
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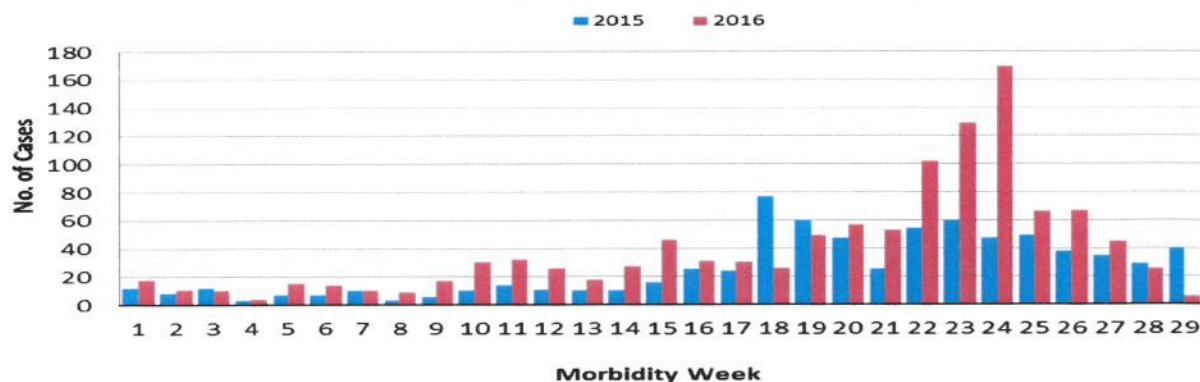
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of July 23, 2016 (N=1,142)**



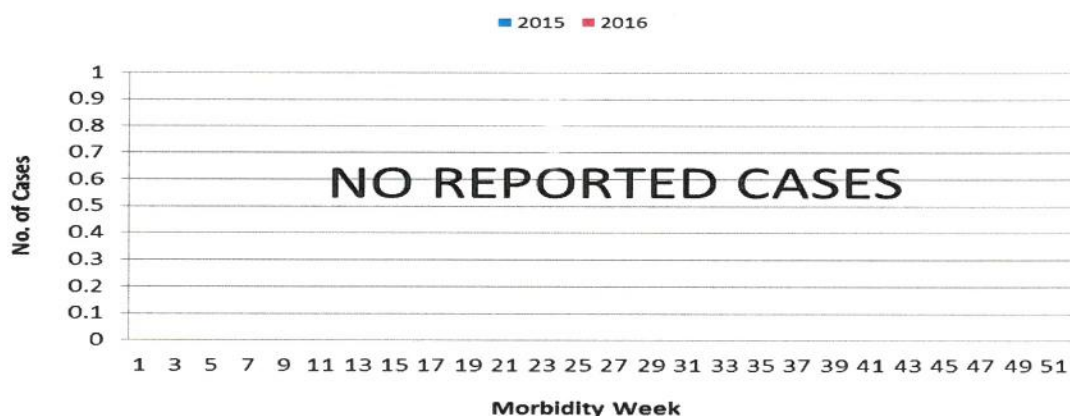


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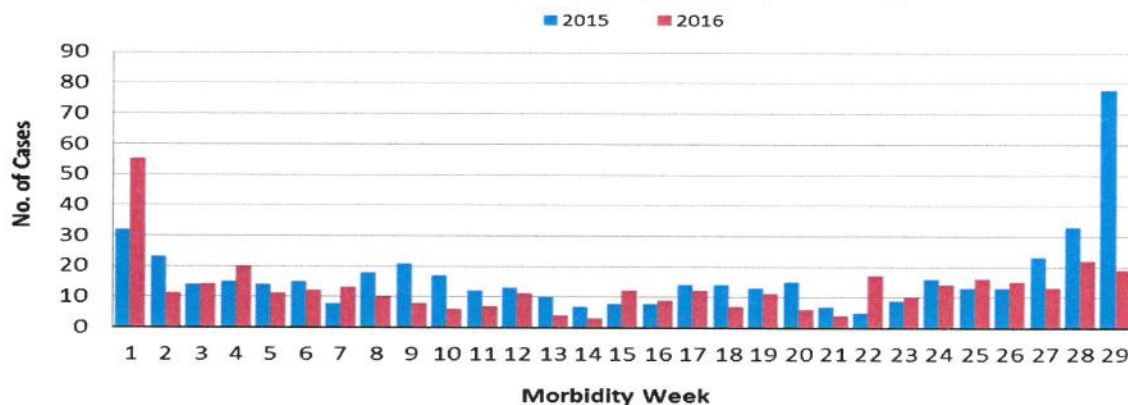

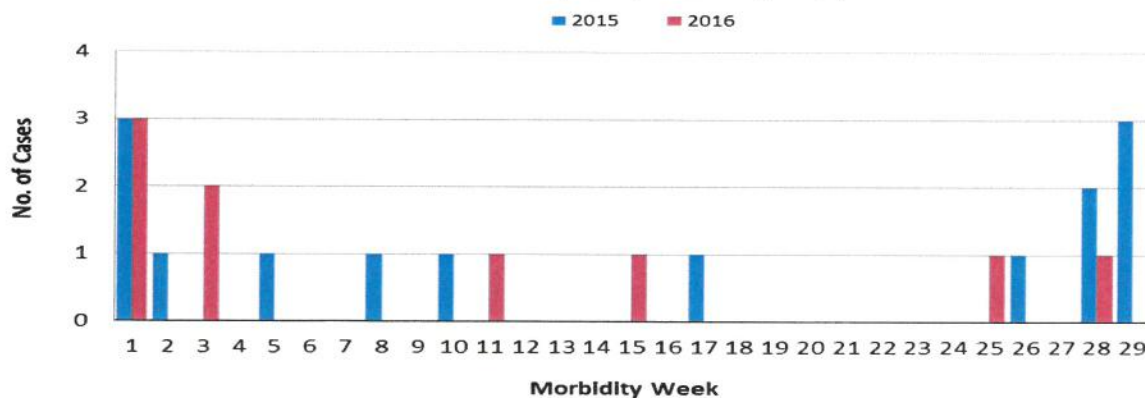
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of July 23, 2016 (n=9)**

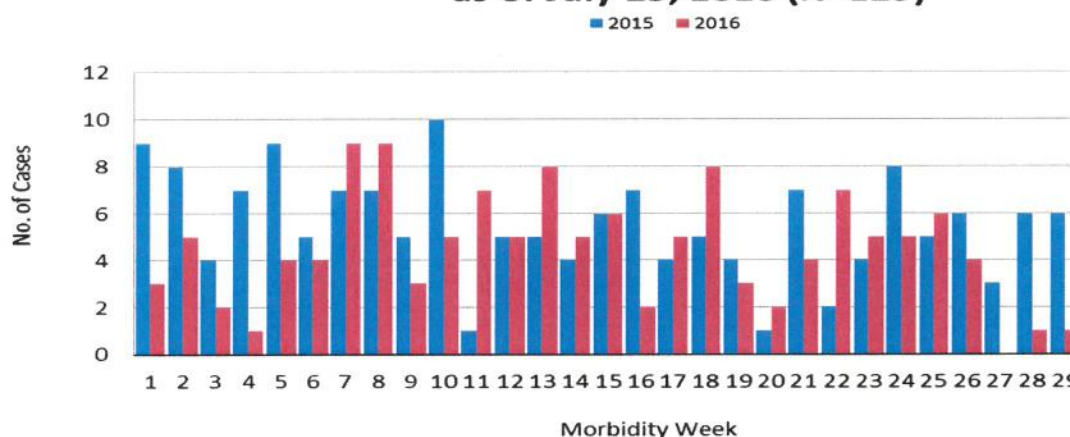




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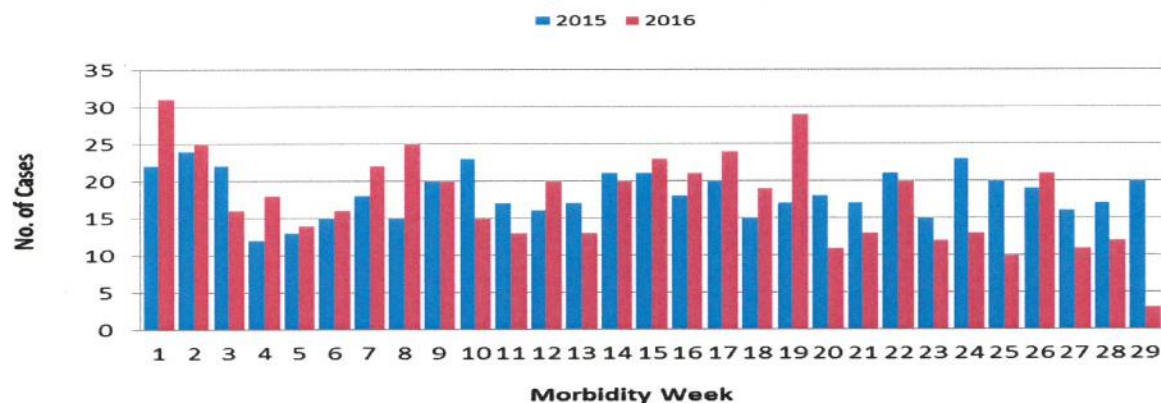
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**Fig. 25 Probable Rabies Cases
as of July 23, 2016 (N=129)**

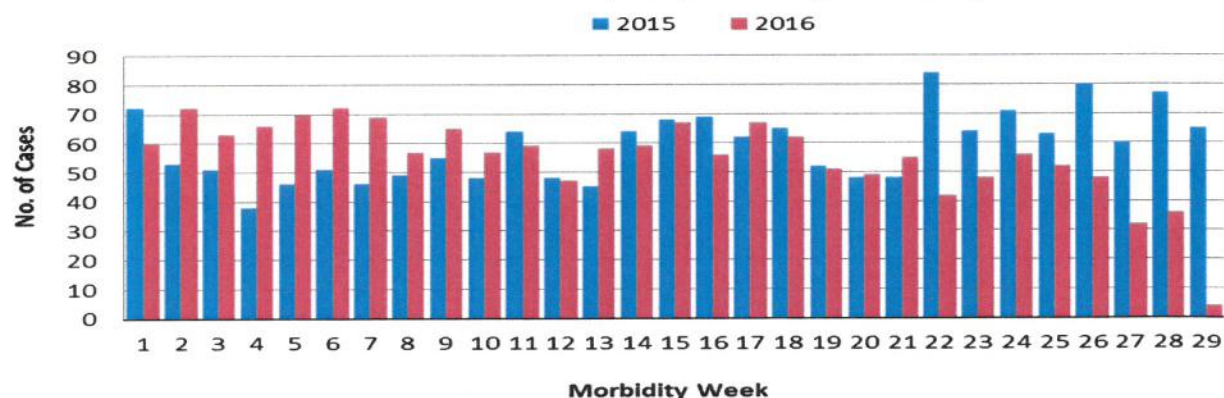

as of July 23, 2016 (n=1599)**

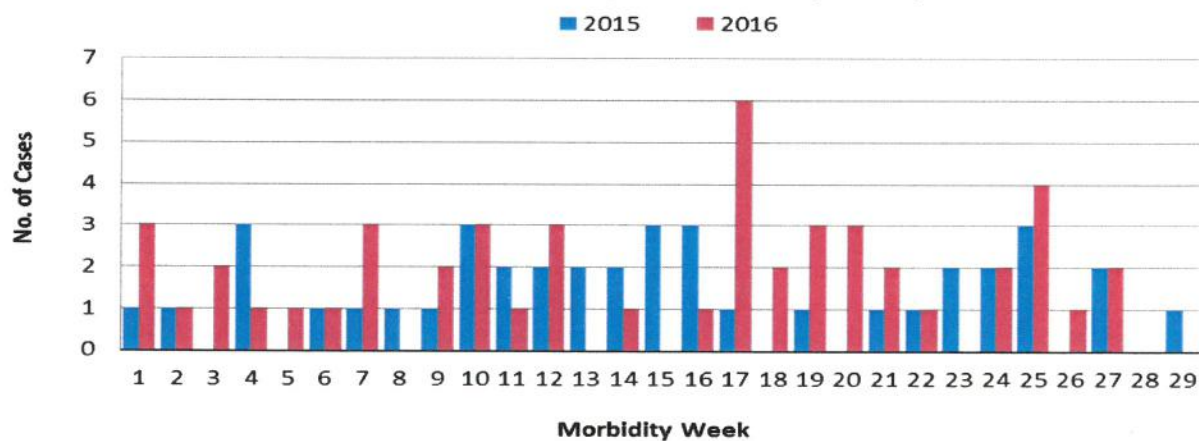




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
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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Hepatitis C Cases
