Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of September 10, 2016 (N=283)

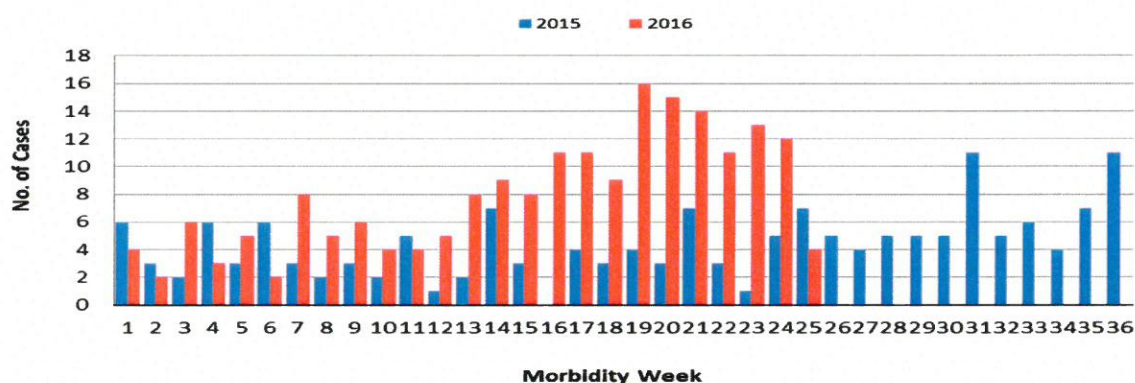


Fig. 2 Confirmed Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases as of September 10, 2016 (n=22)

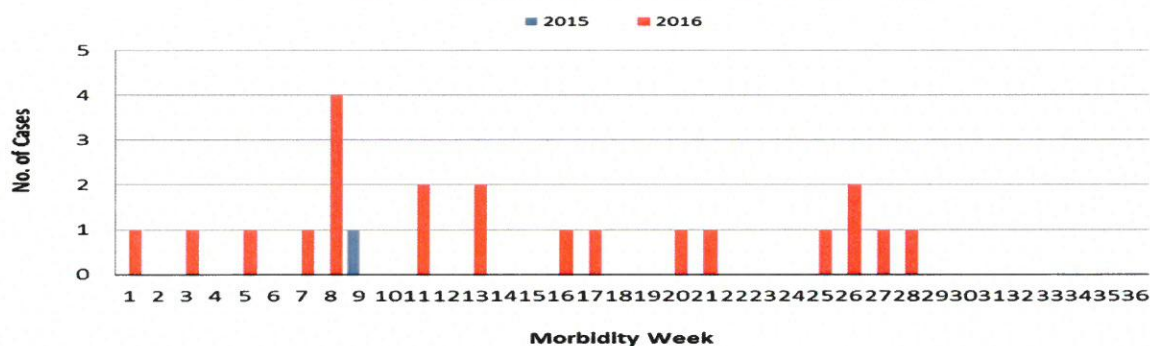
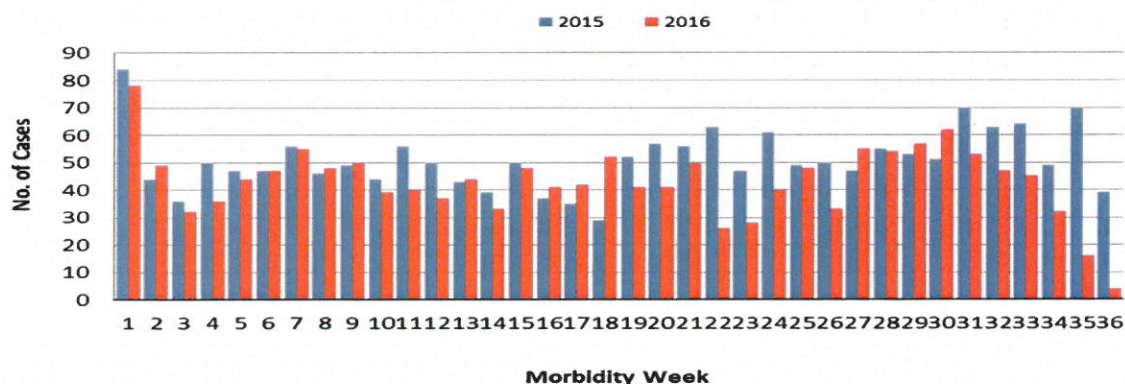


Fig. 3 Suspect Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of September 10, 2016 (N=1,547)

Fig. 4 Confirmed Bacterial Meningitis Cases as of September 10, 2016 (n=87)

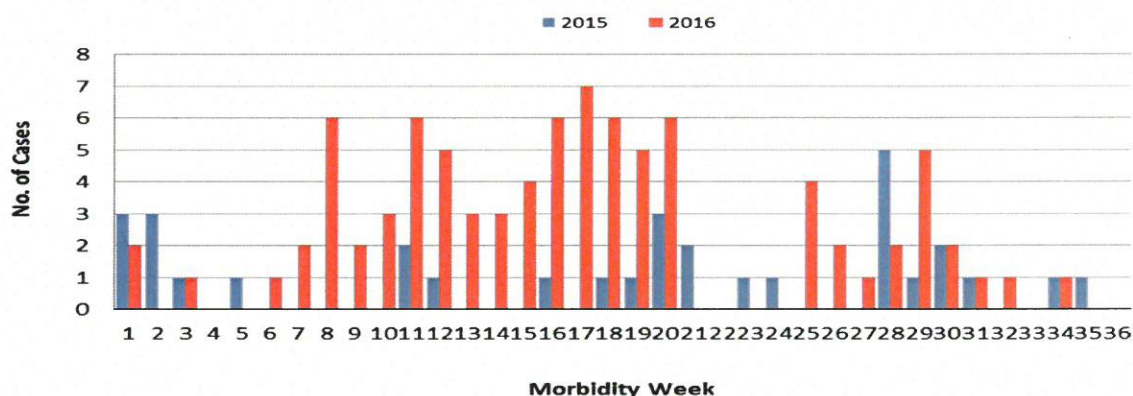


Fig.5 Suspect Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease Cases as of September 10, 2016 (N=510)

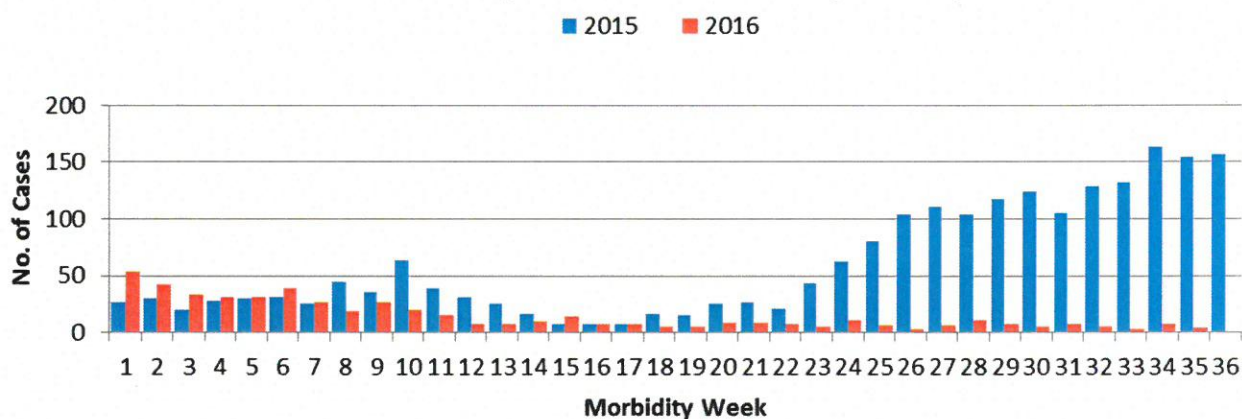
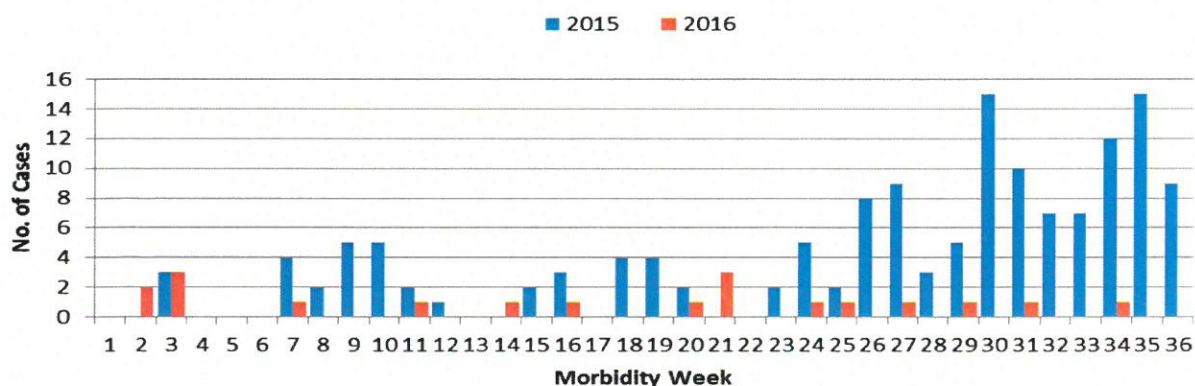


Fig.6 Confirmed Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease Cases as of September 10, 2016 (n=19)

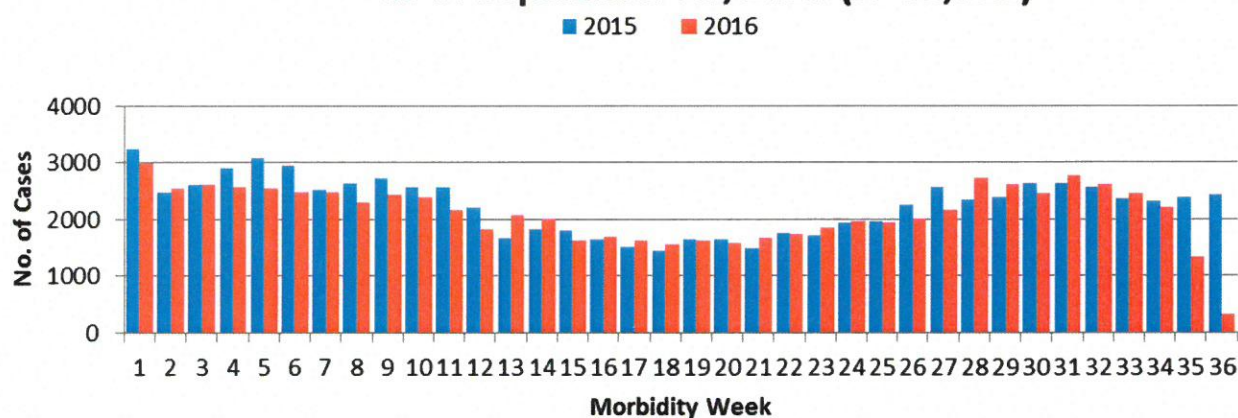




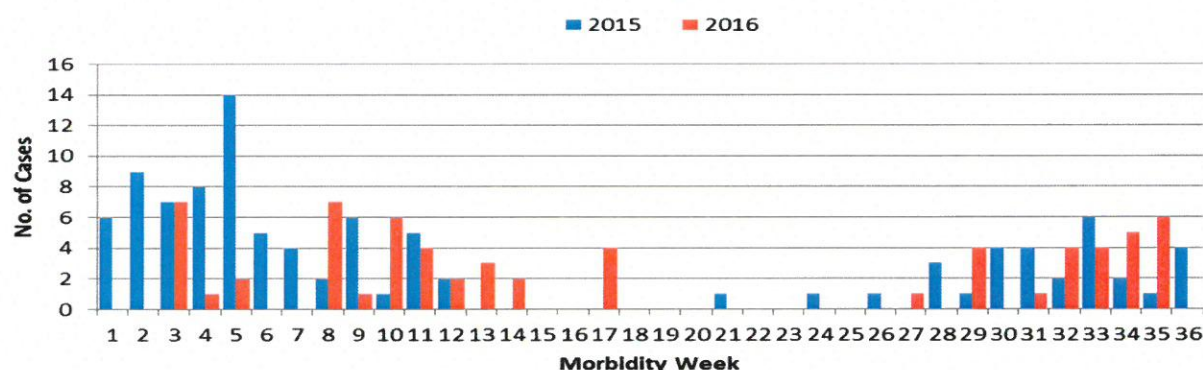

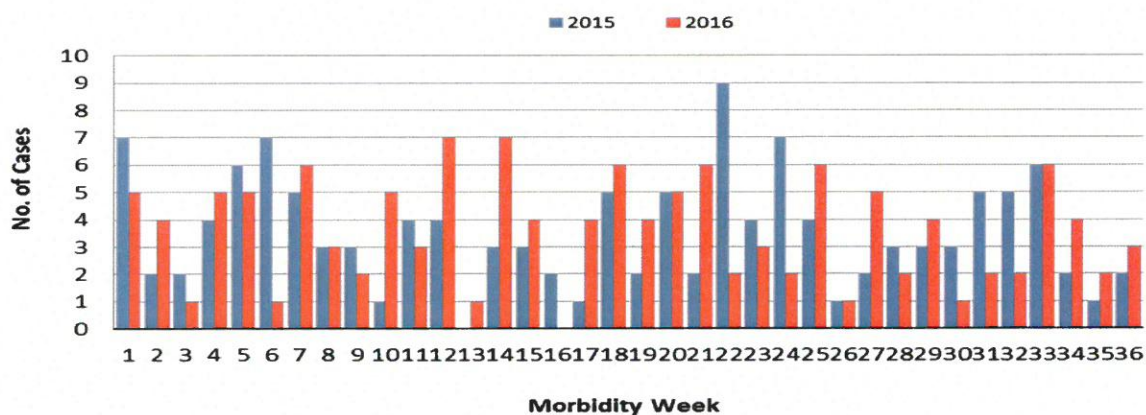
**Fig.7 Influenza-like Illness Cases

as of September 10, 2016 (N=129)**

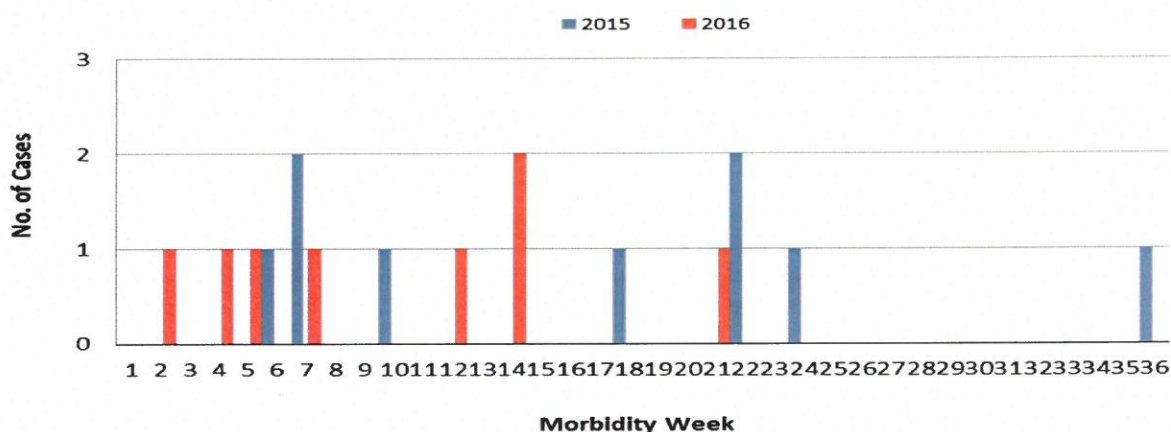

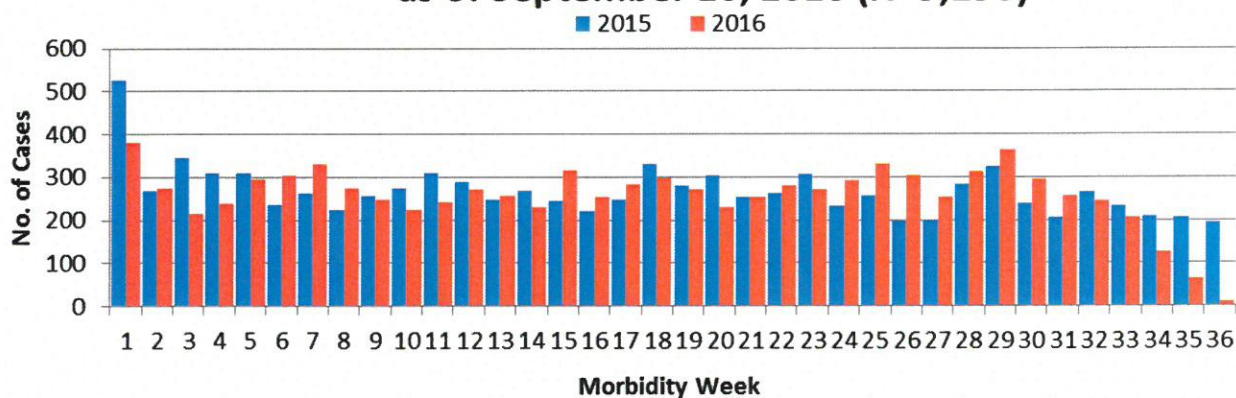

as of September 10, 2016 (n=8)**

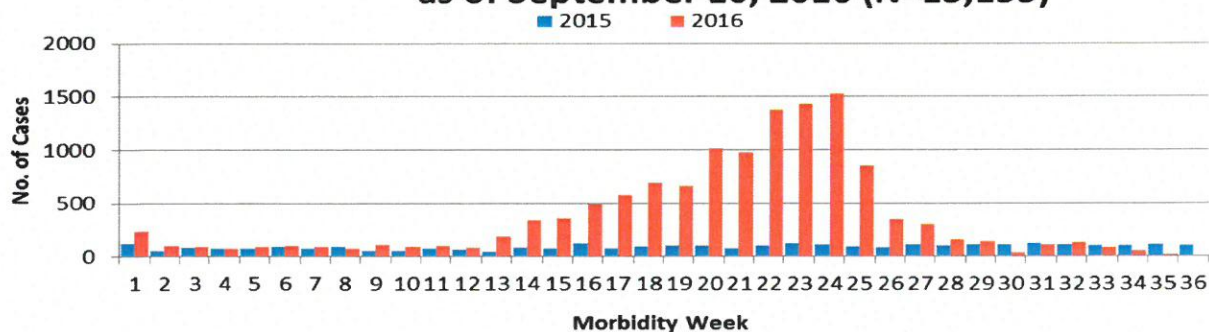

as of September 10, 2016 (N=13,155)**

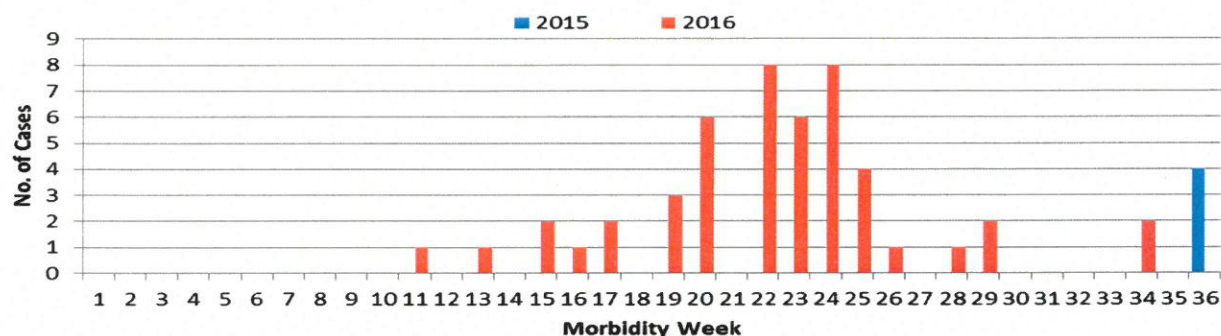




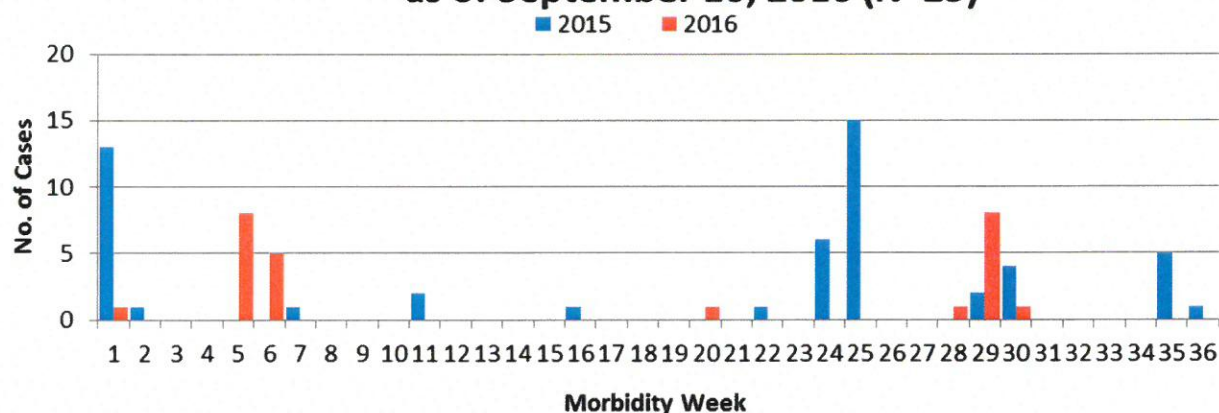

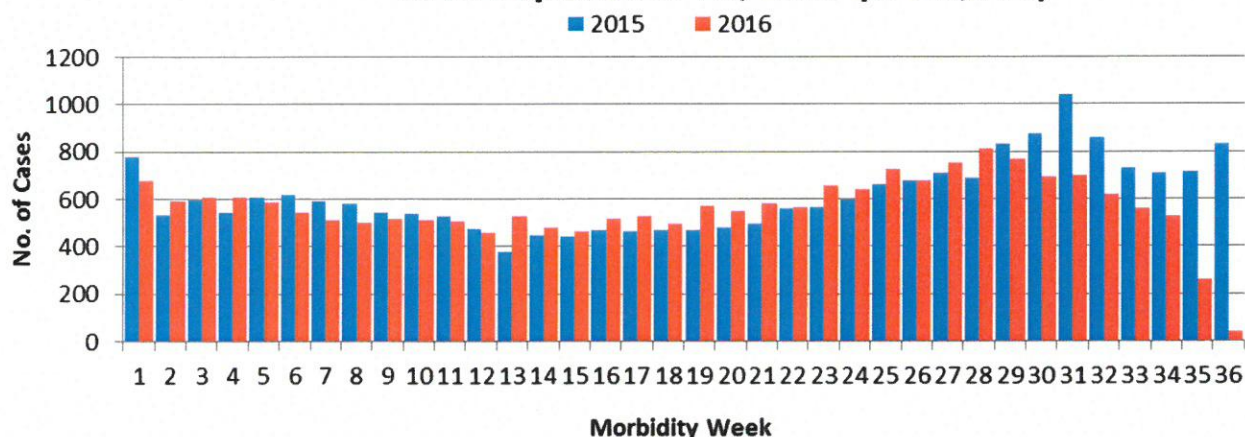
**Fig.13 Confirmed Cholera Cases

as of September 10, 2016 (N=20,360)**

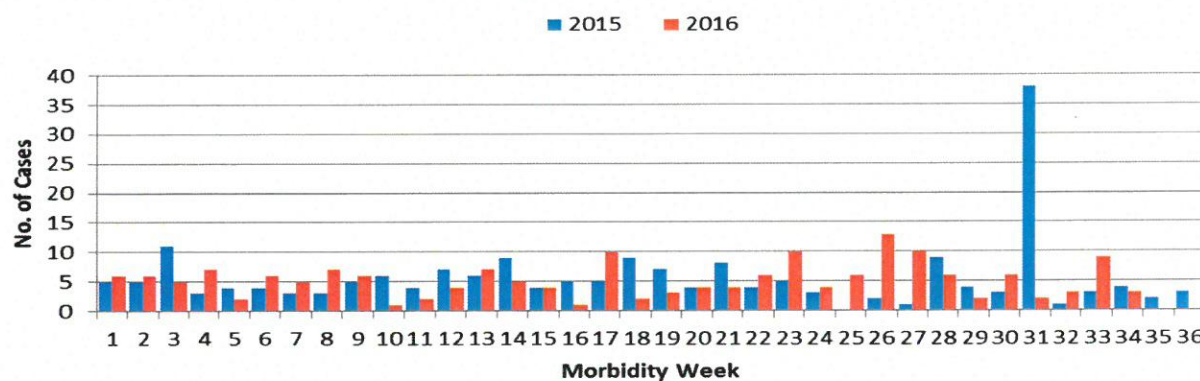




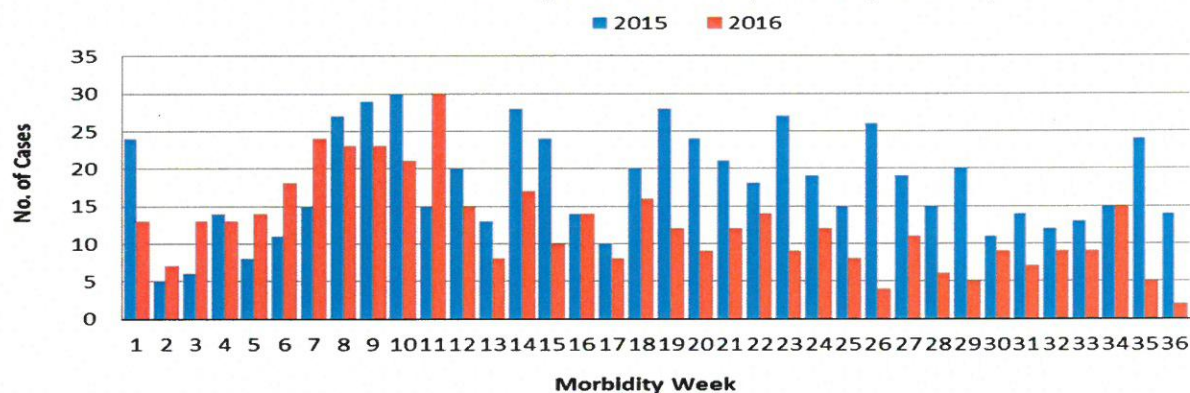

as of September 10, 2016 (n=177)**

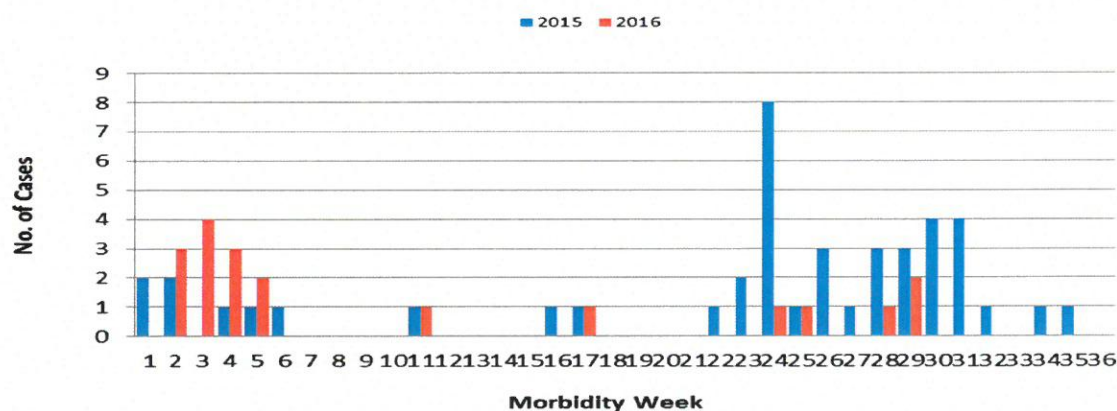


**Fig. 17 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of September 10, 2016 (N=19)**

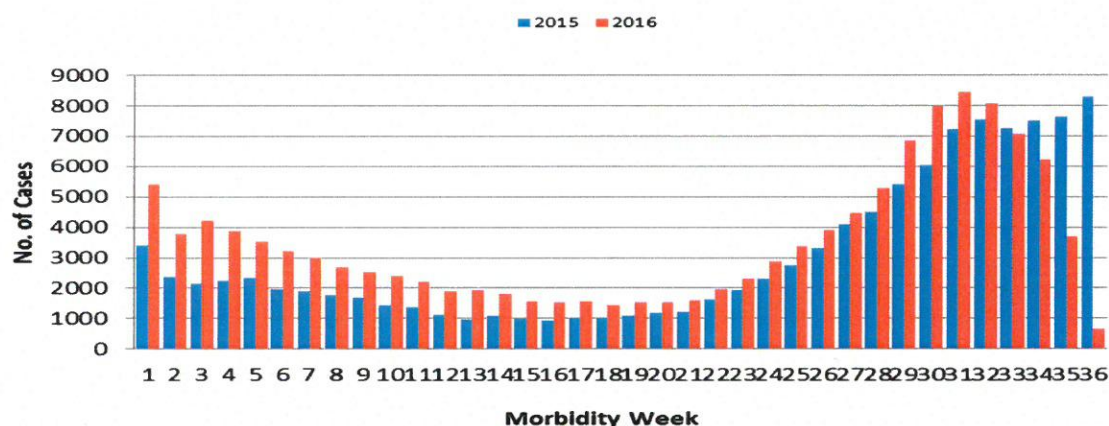




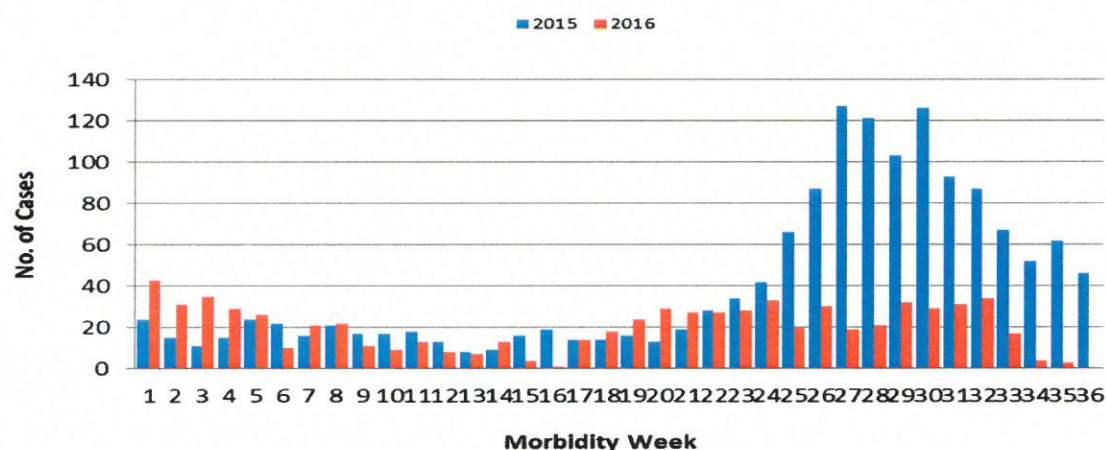

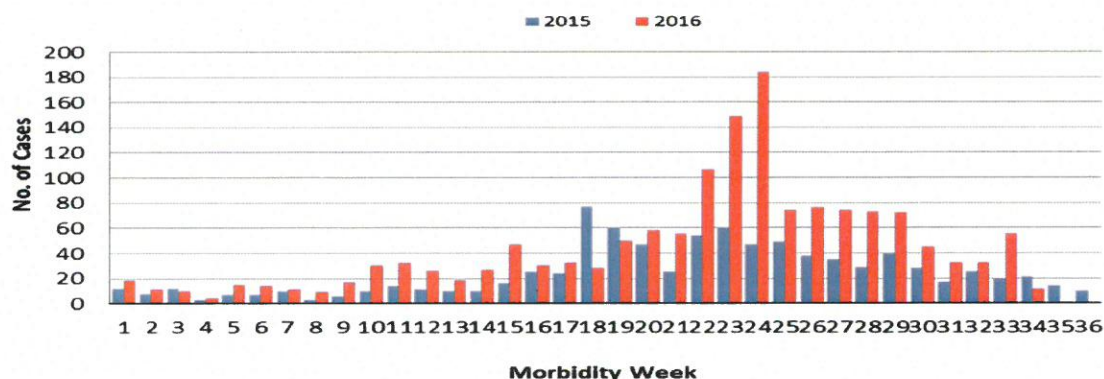
**Fig. 19 Suspect Dengue Cases

as of September 10, 2016 (N=1,526)**



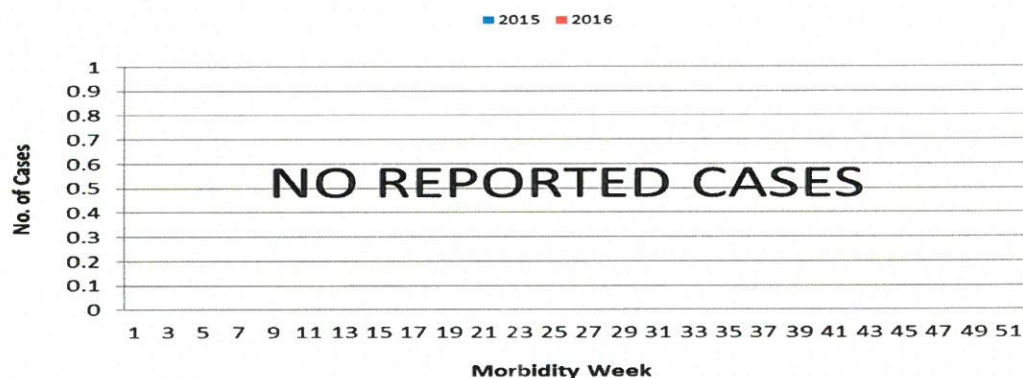

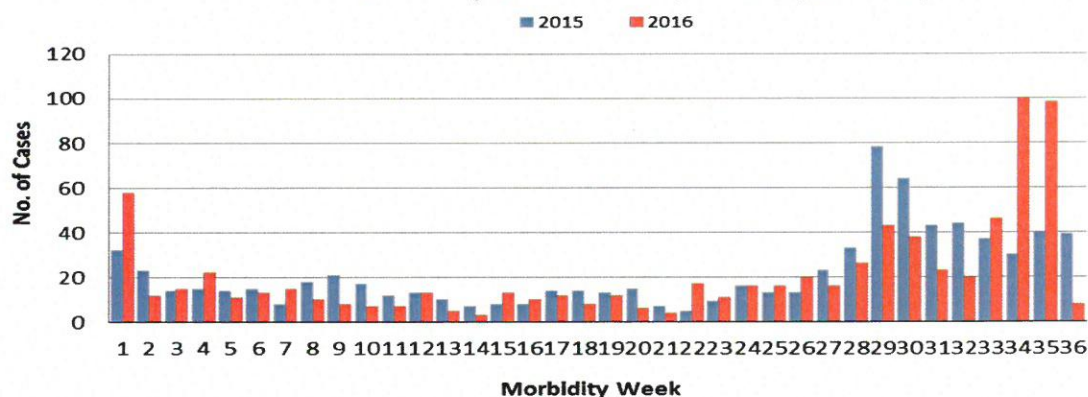

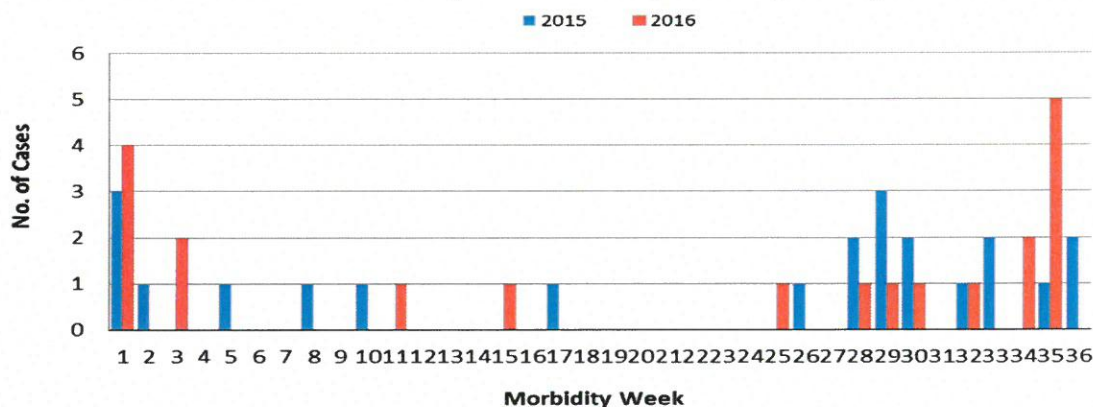
**Fig. 22 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of September 10, 2016 (n=20)**

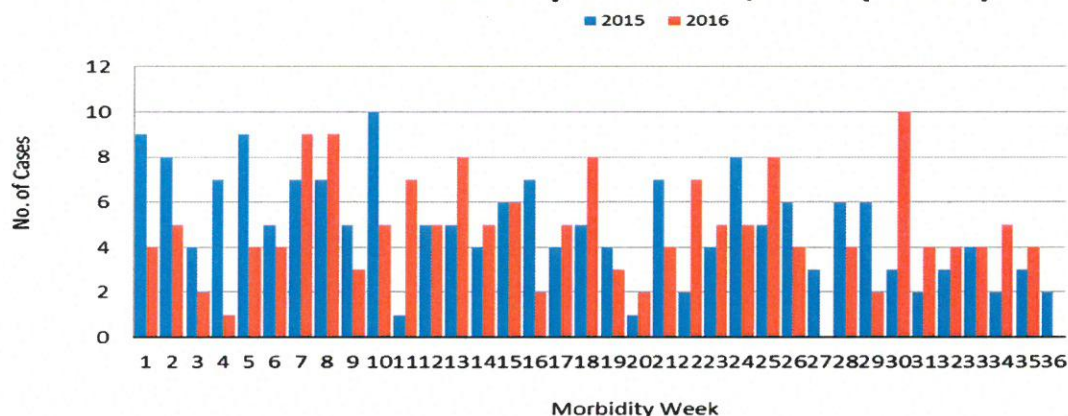

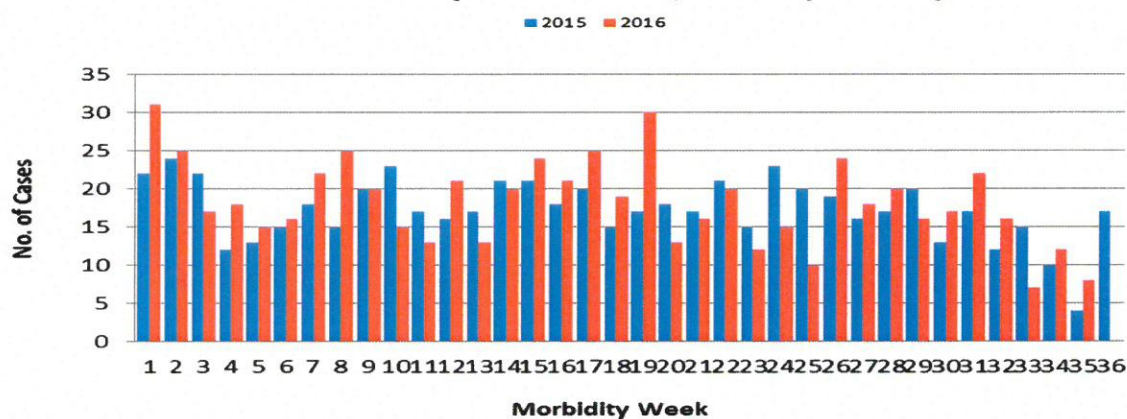

as of September 10, 2016 (N=167)**

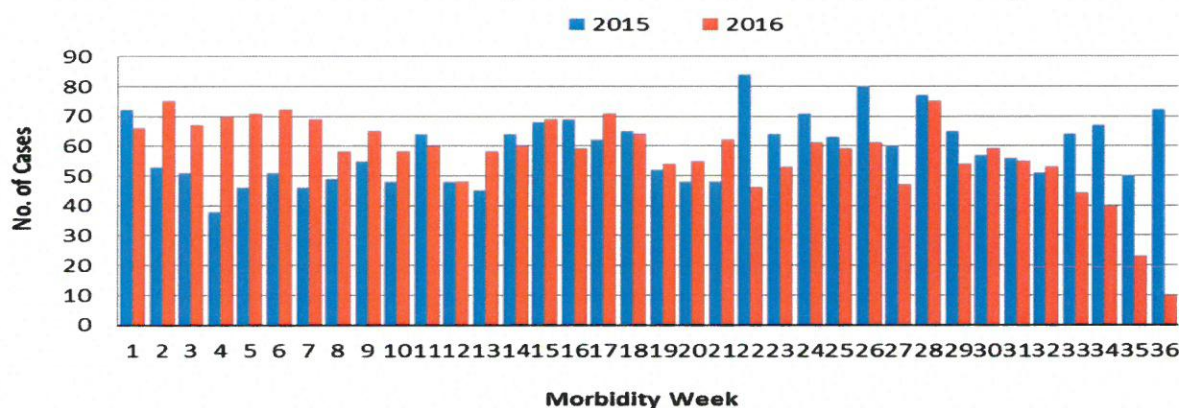

as of September 10, 2016 (n=2071)**

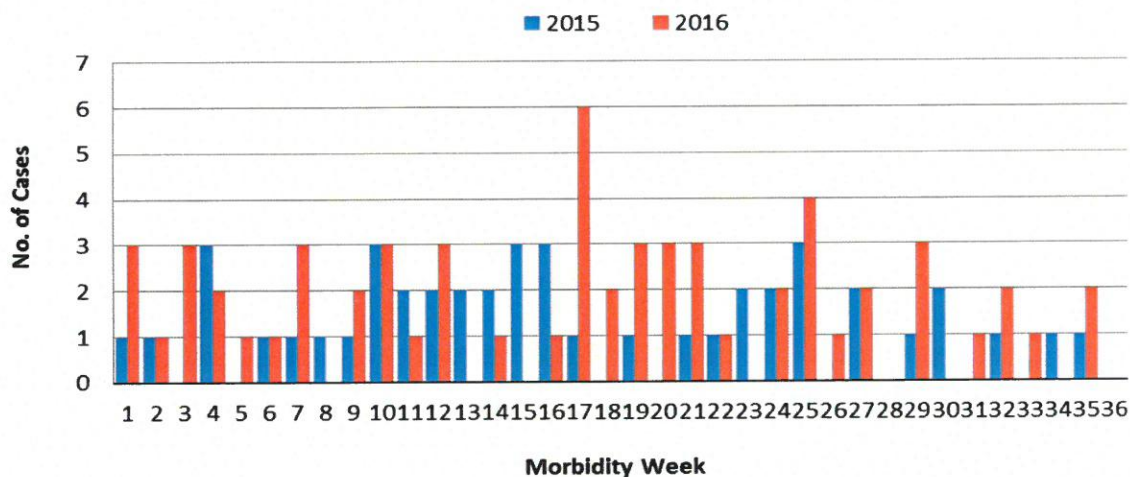



as of September 10, 2016 (n=61)**





