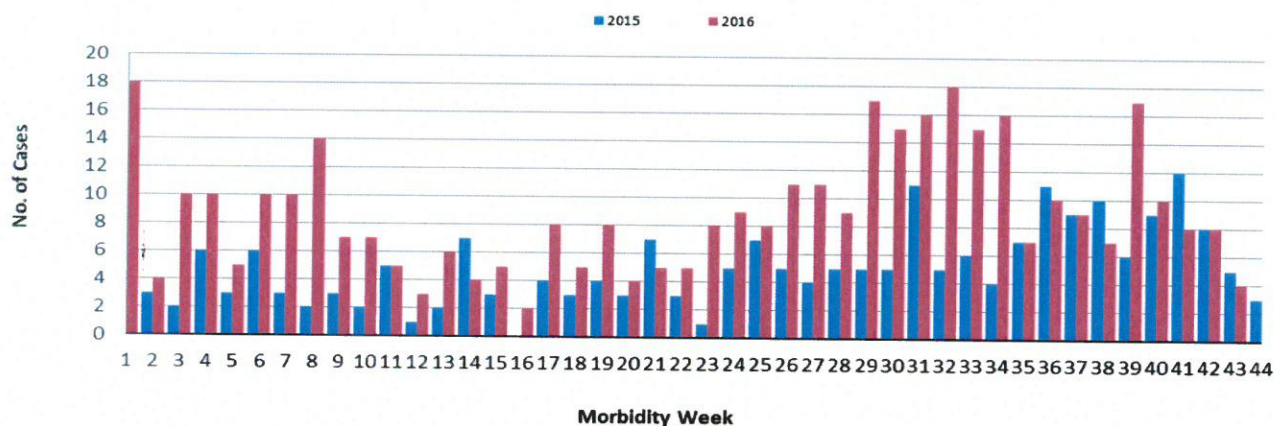

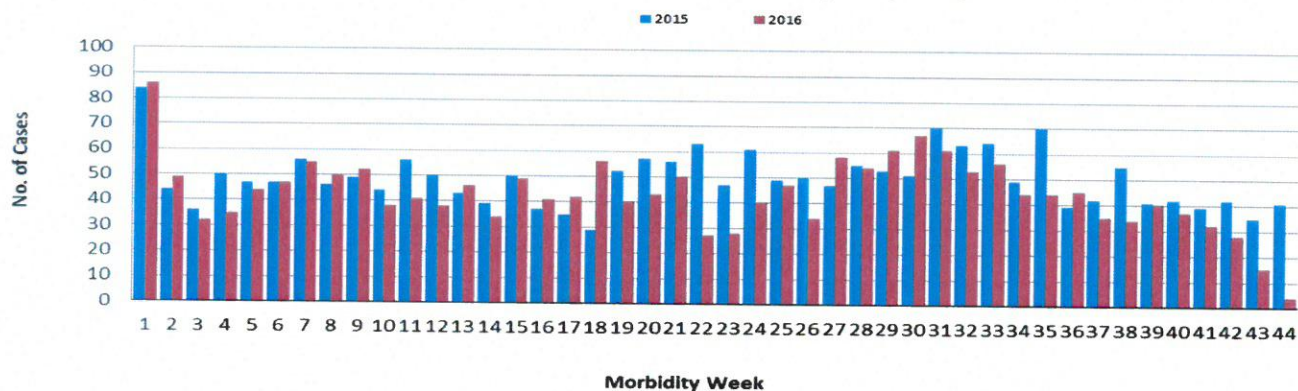

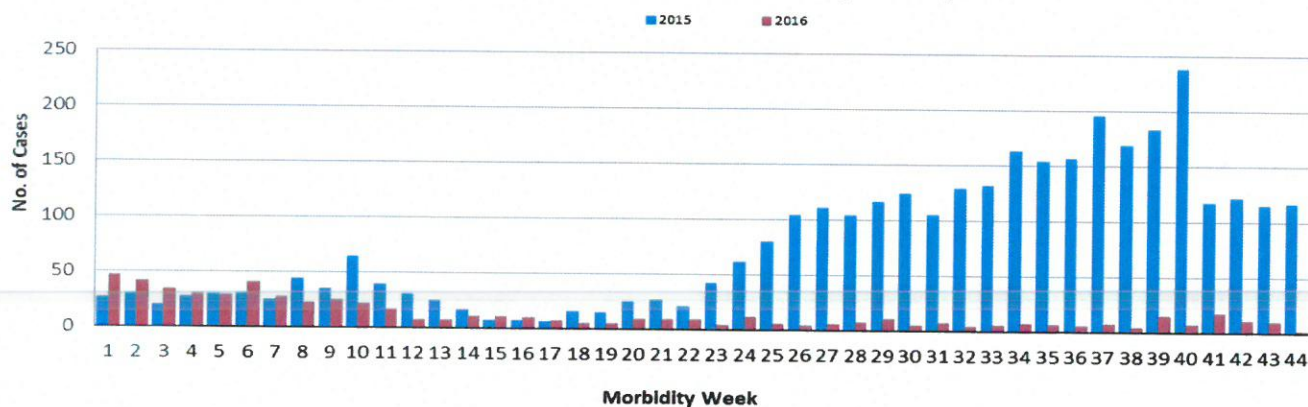
**Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases

as of November 5, 2016 (N=602)**

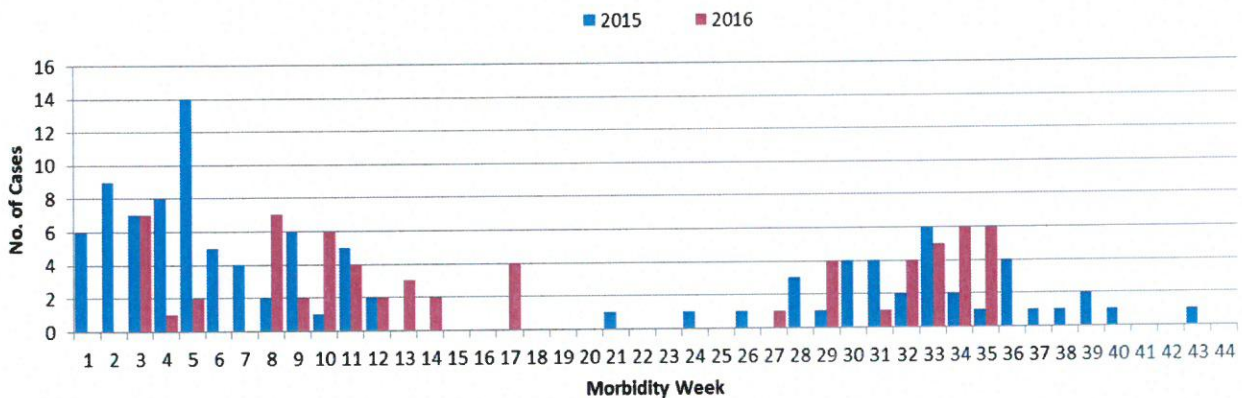




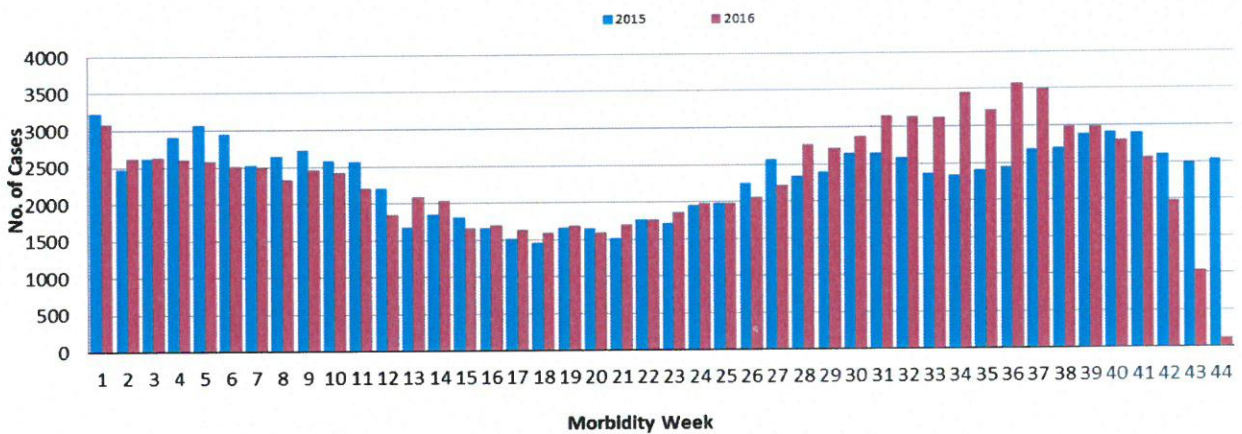

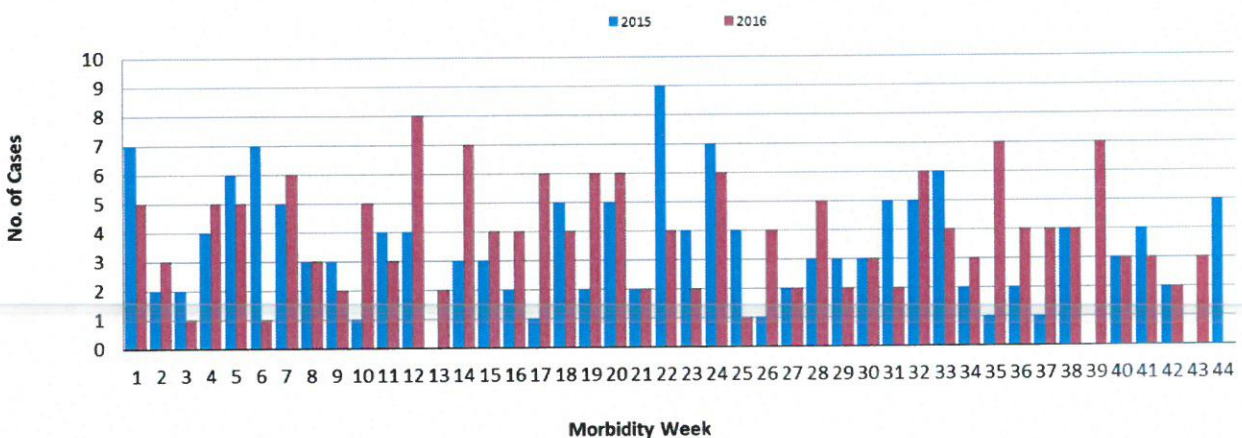
**Fig. 4 Influenza Cases

as of November 5, 2016 (N=169)**



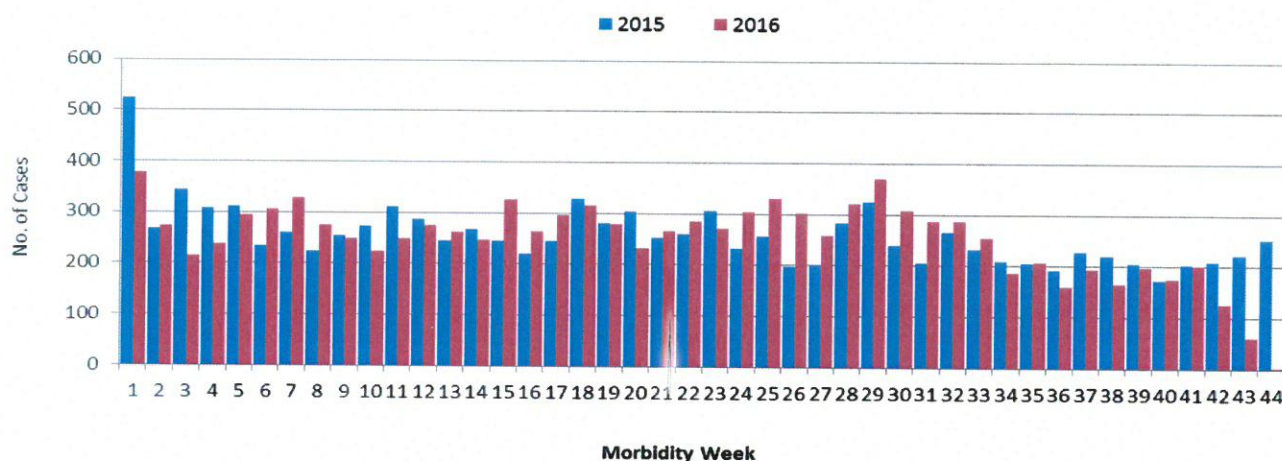

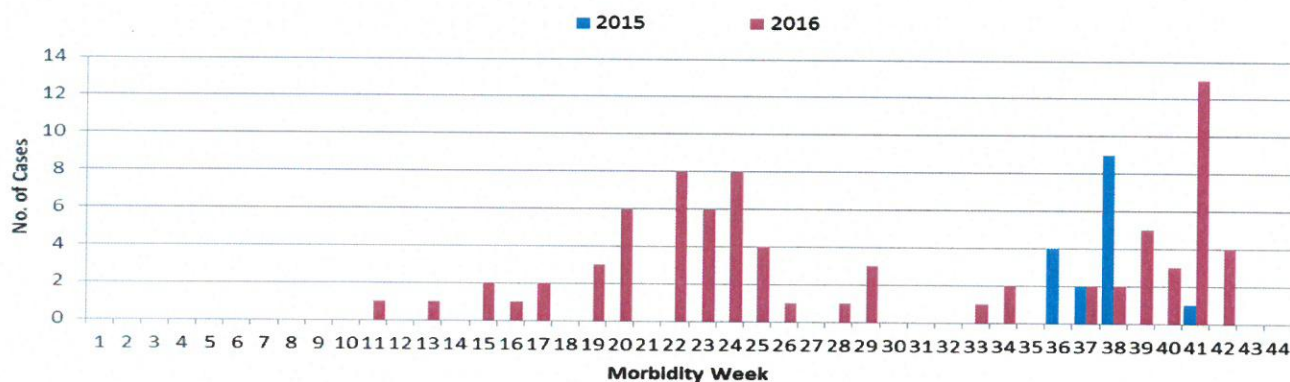

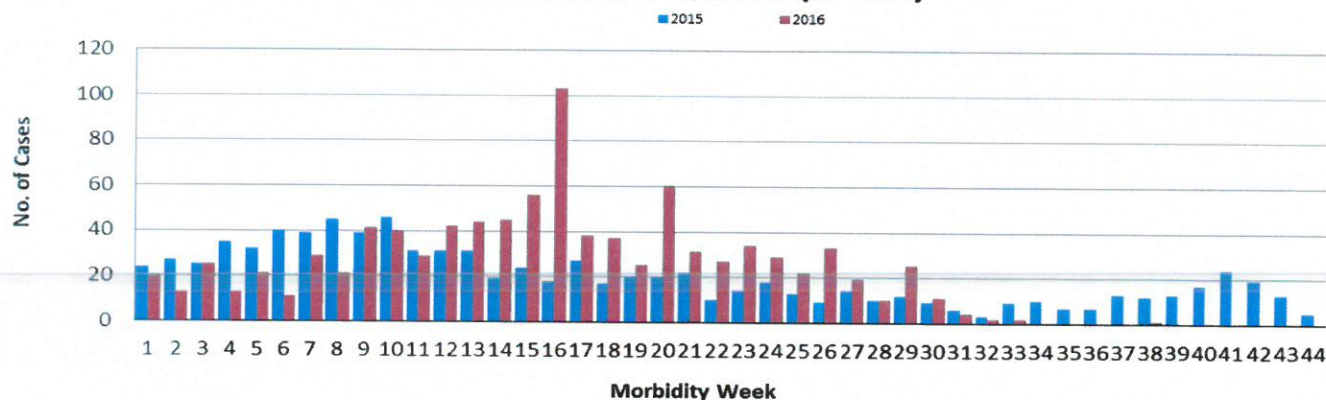
**Fig. 7 Acute Bloody Diarrhea Cases

as of November 5, 2016 (N=963)**

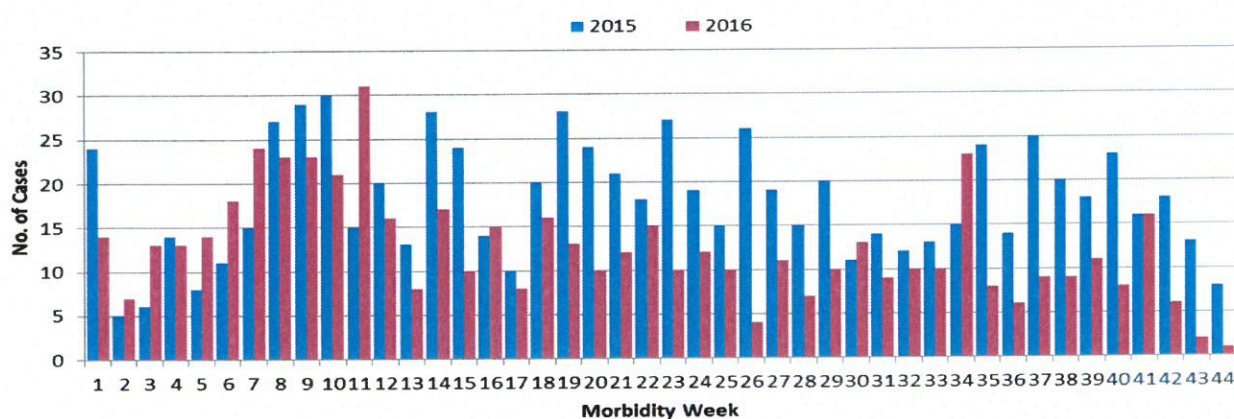




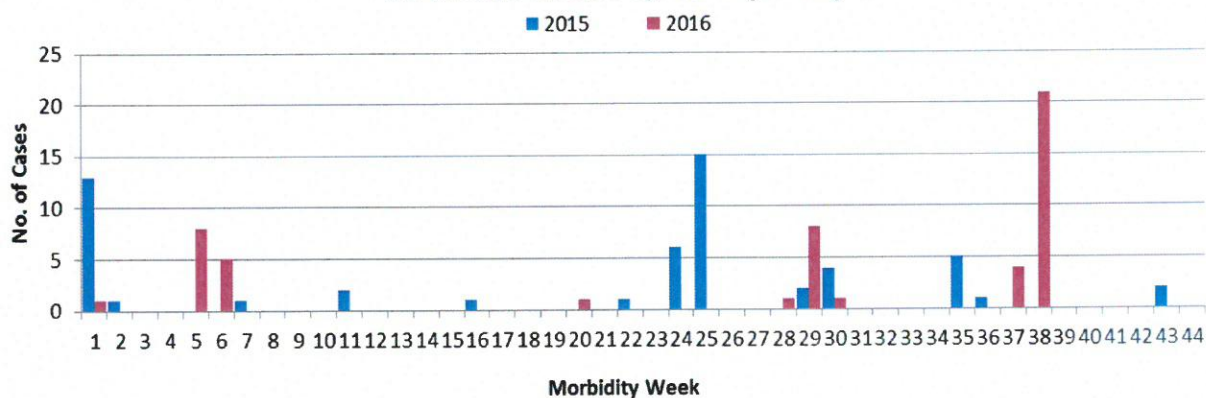

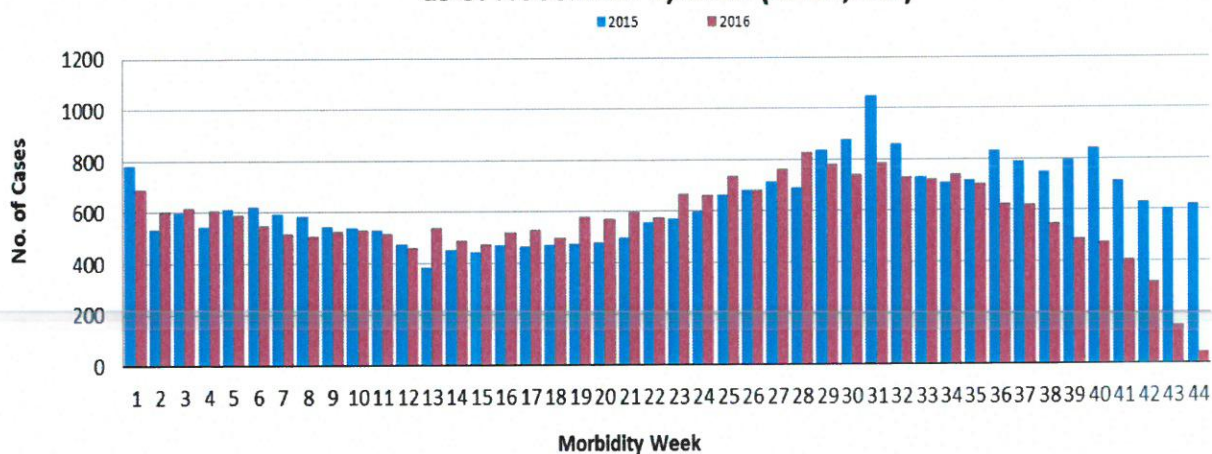
**Fig. 10 Hepatitis A Cases

as of November 5, 2016 (N=25,251)**



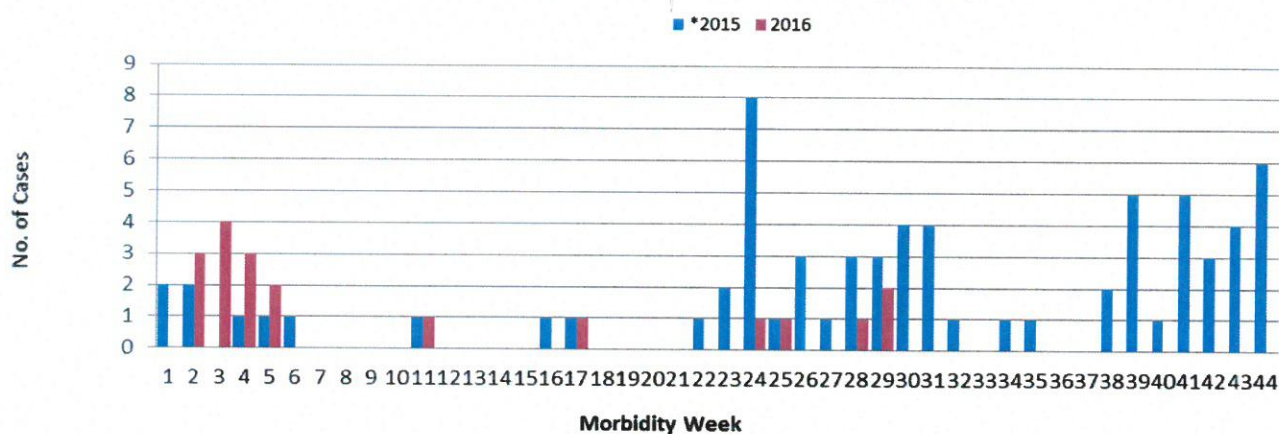

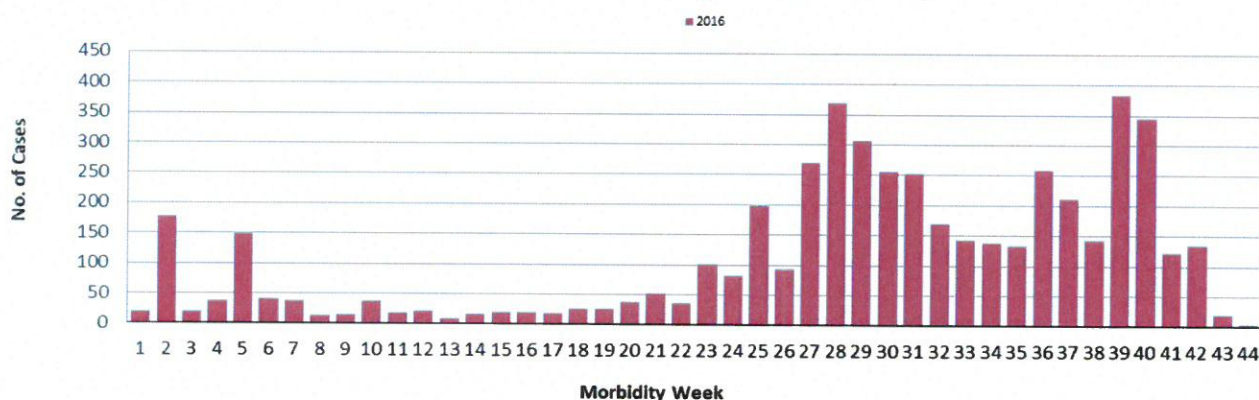

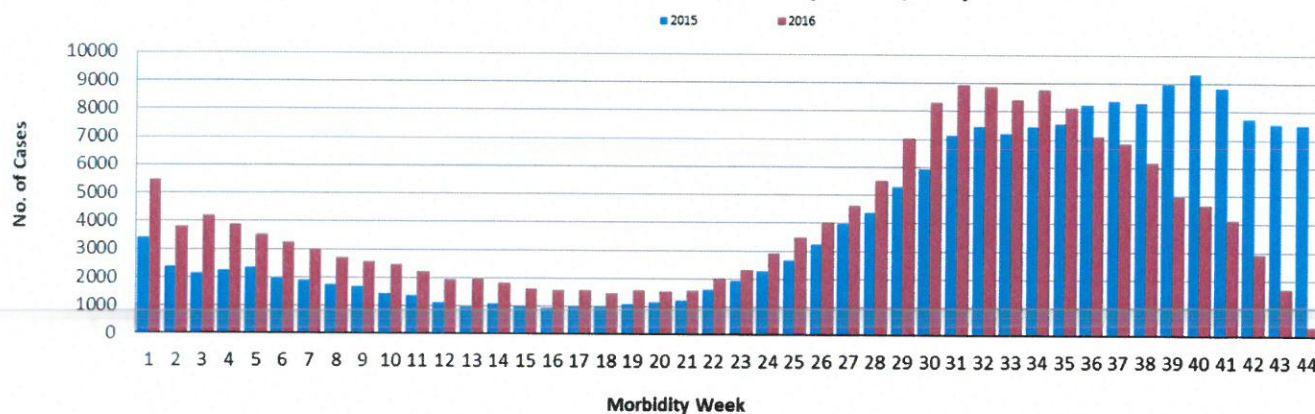
**Fig. 13 Suspect Acute Hemorrhagic Fever Cases

as of November 5, 2016 (N=175,468)**

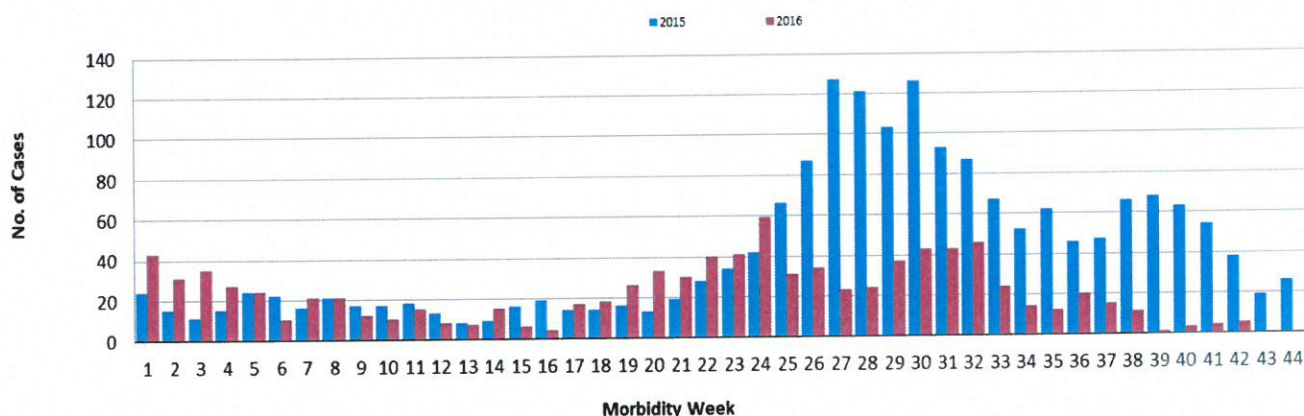




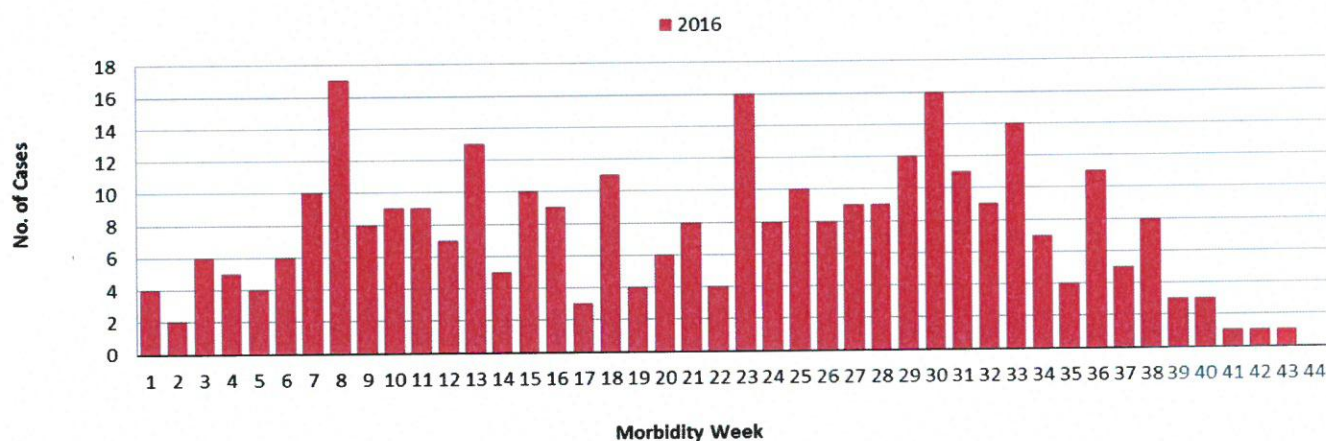

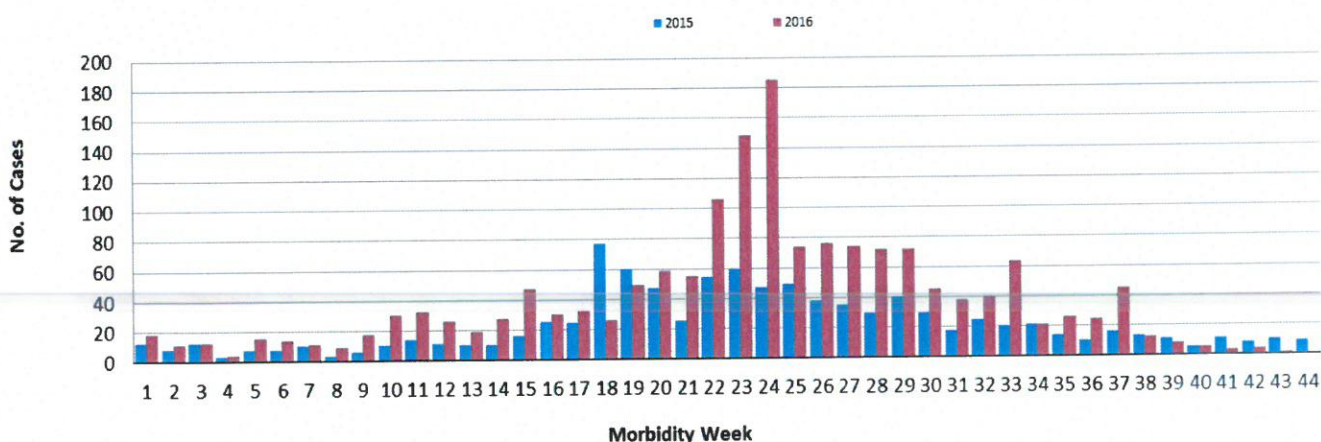
**Fig. 16 Confirmed Dengue Cases

as of November 5, 2016 (N=0)

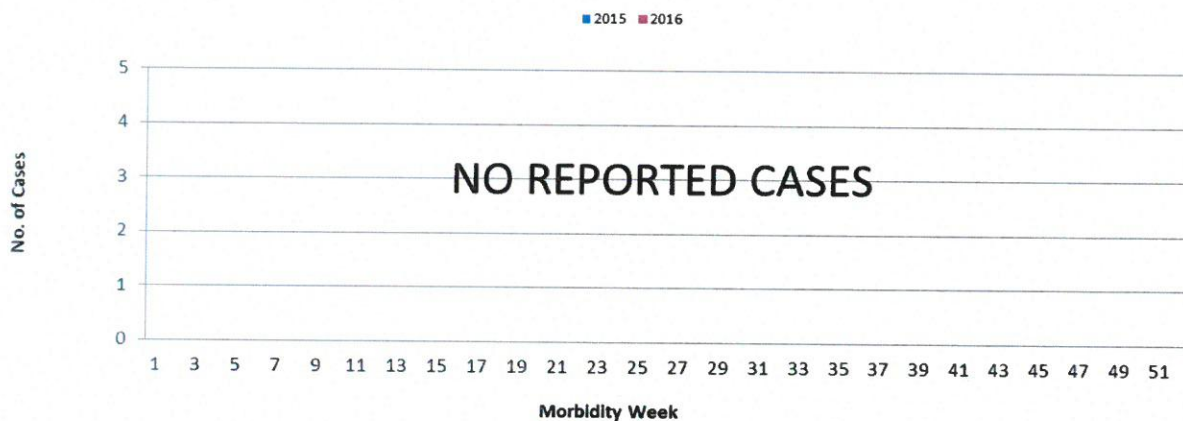


Fig. 20 Leptospirosis Cases
as of November 5, 2016 (N=1,250)

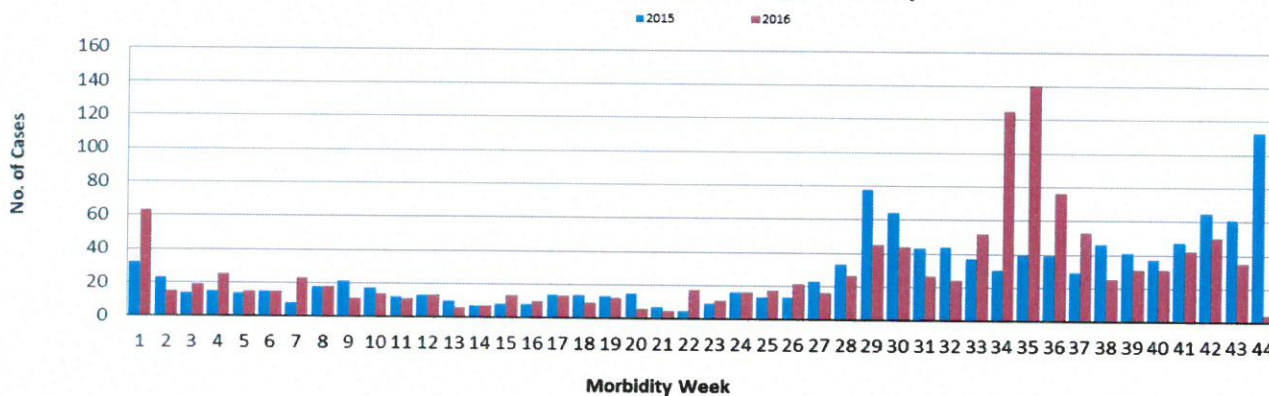
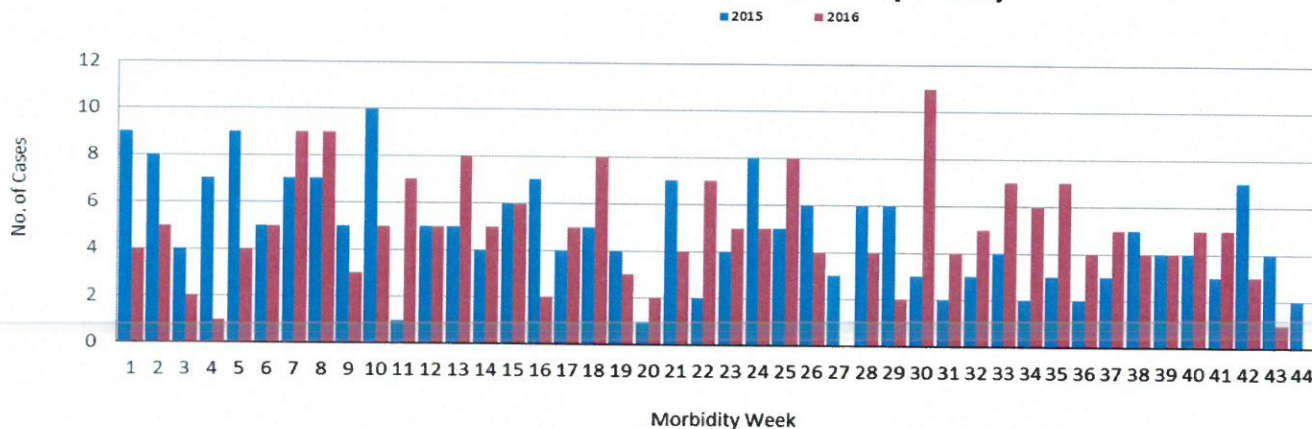


Fig. 21 Rabies Cases
as of November 5, 2016 (N=208)



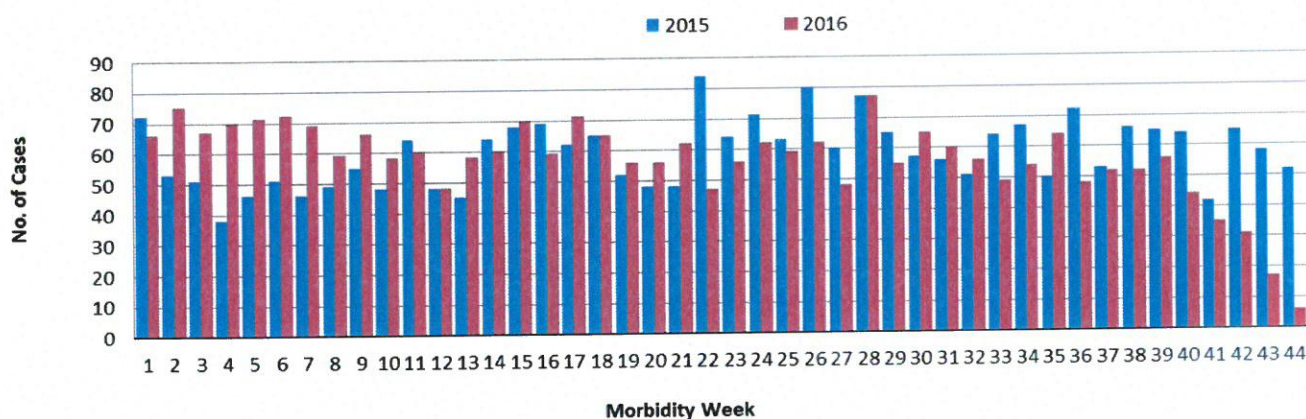

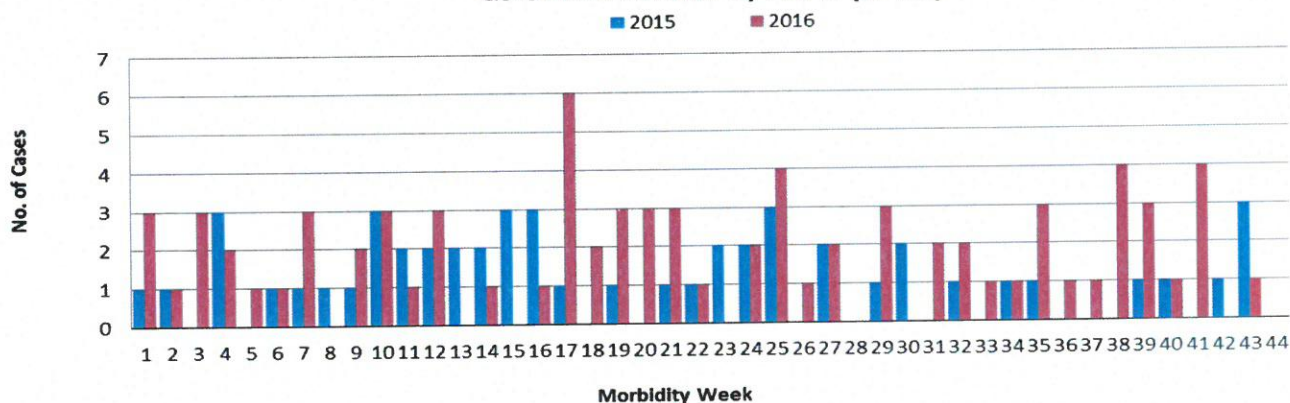

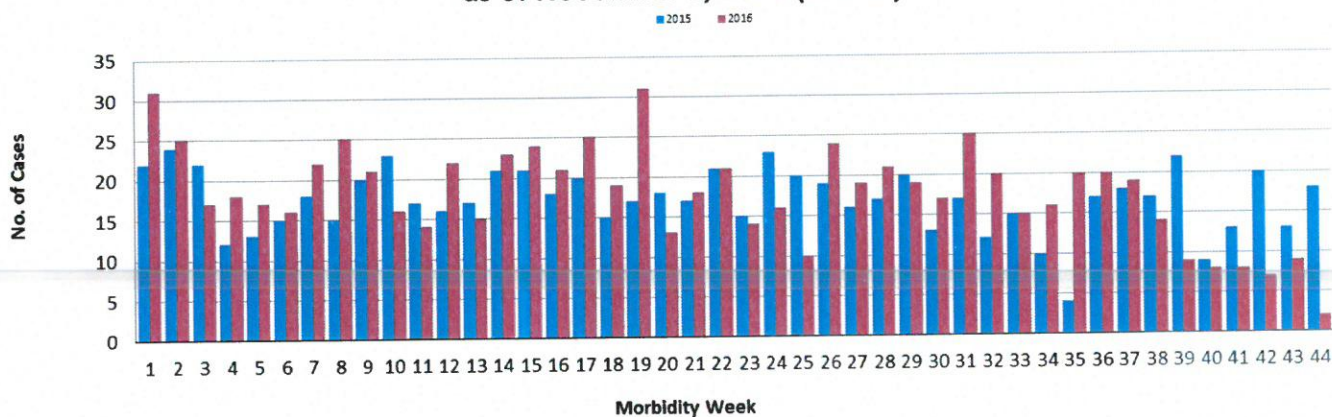
**Fig. 22 Confirmed Hepatitis B Cases

as of November 5, 2016 (N=786)**



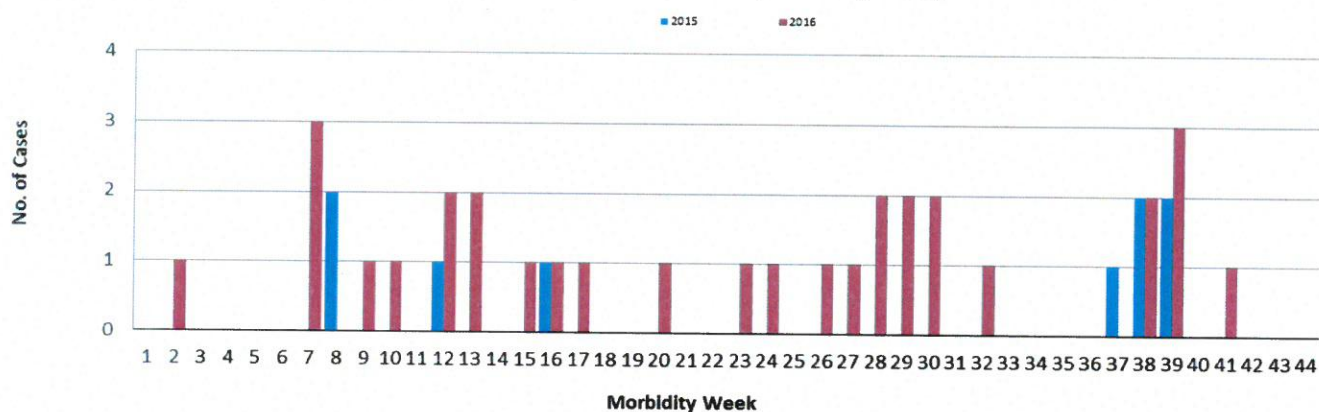

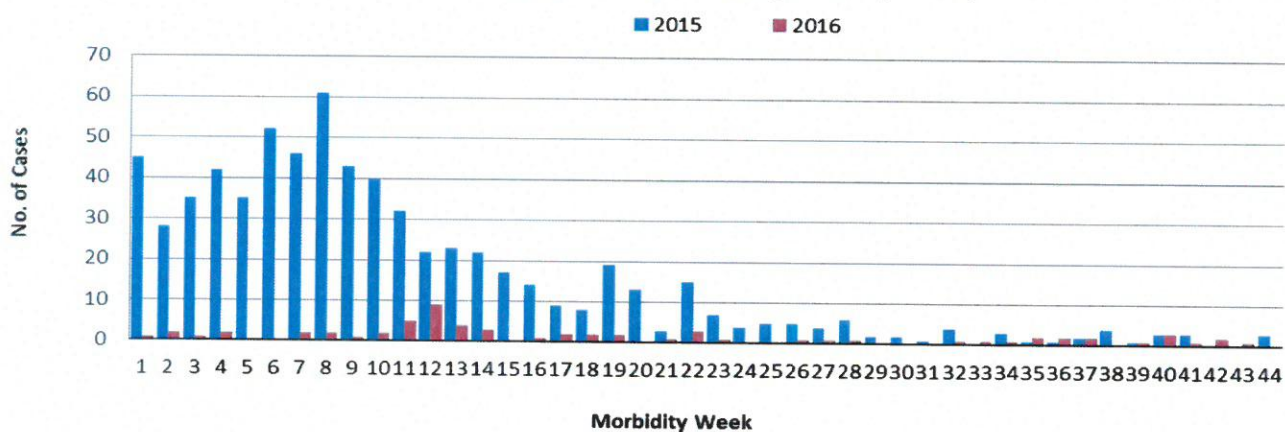

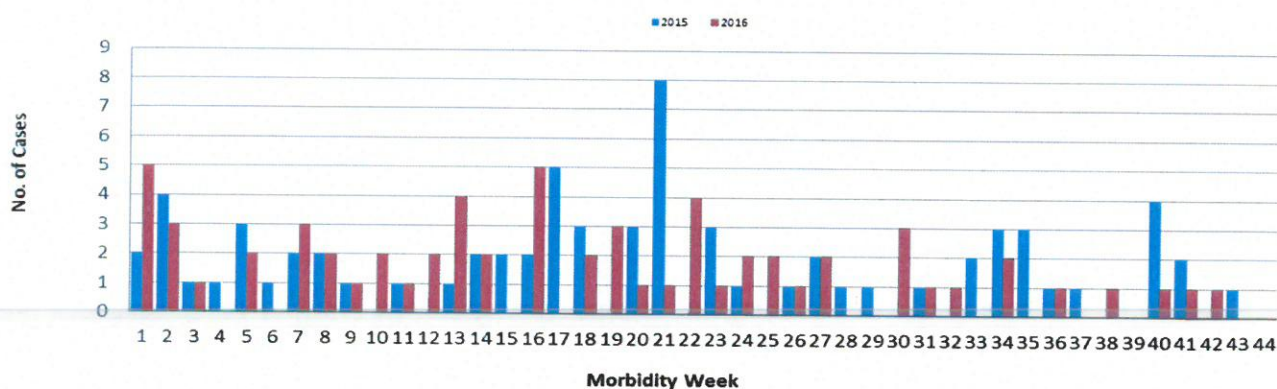
**Fig. 25 Confirmed Diphtheria Cases

as of November 5, 2016 (n=64)**

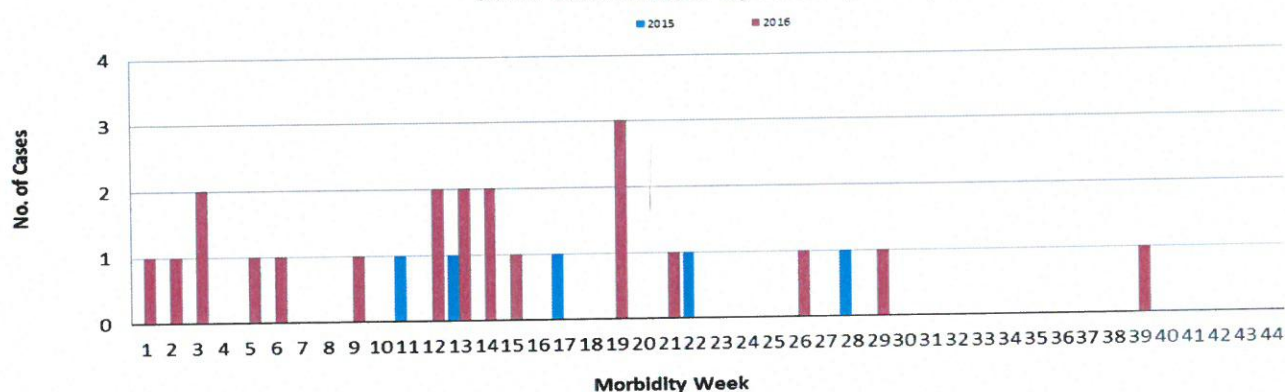




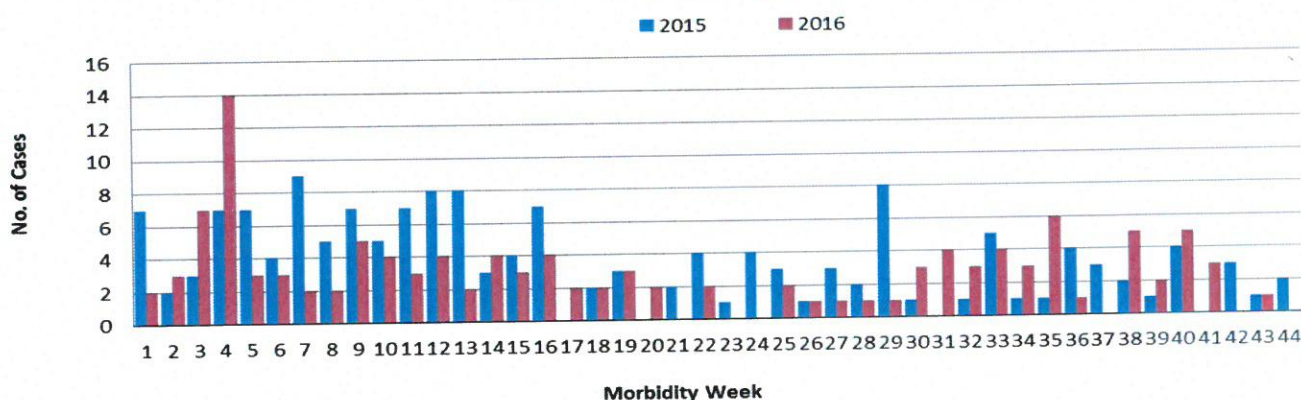

as of November 5, 2016 (n=21)**

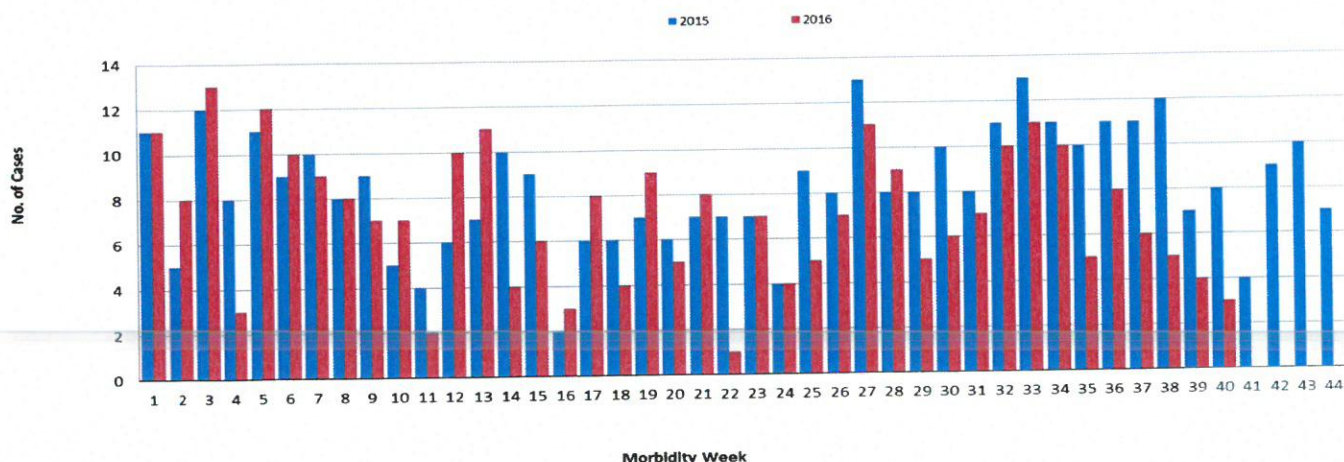


**Fig. 29 Confirmed Rubella Cases

as of November 5, 2016 (N=282)**




