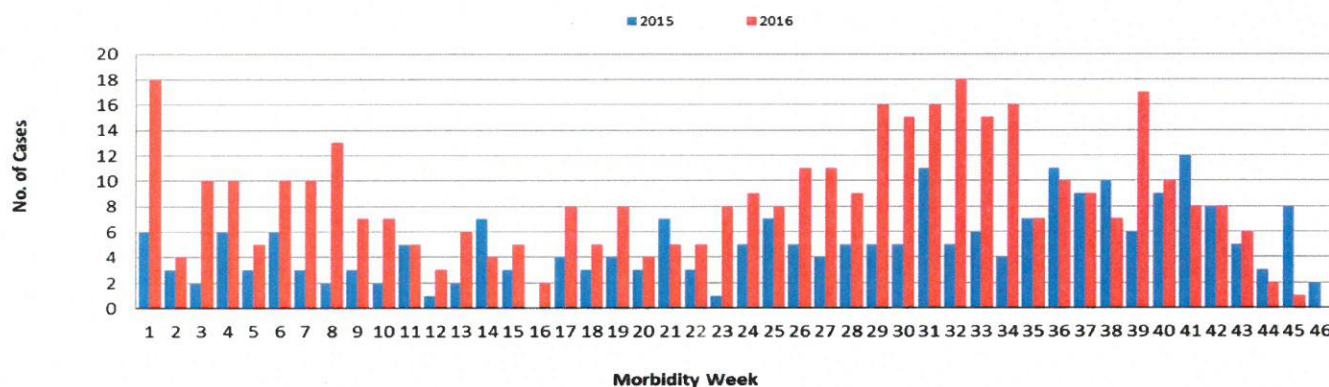

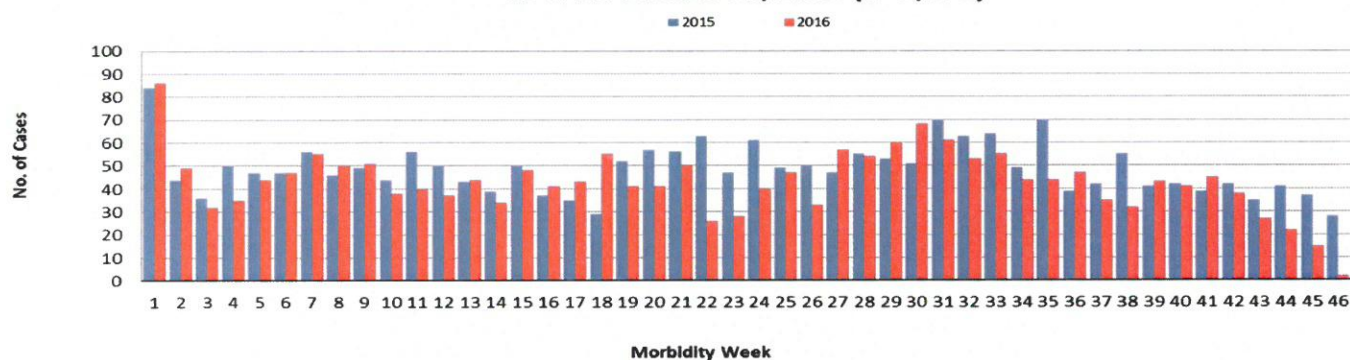

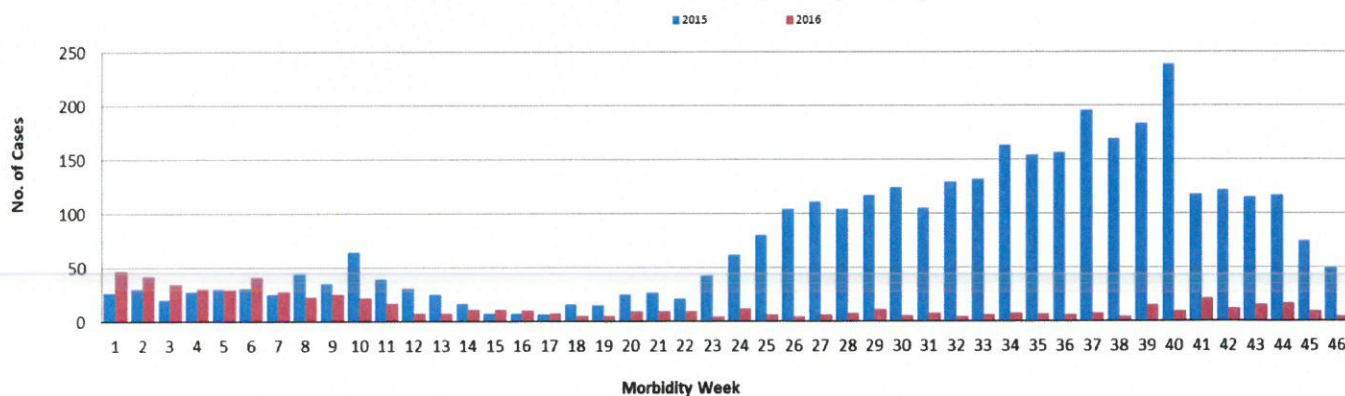
**Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases

as of November 19, 2016 (N=640)**



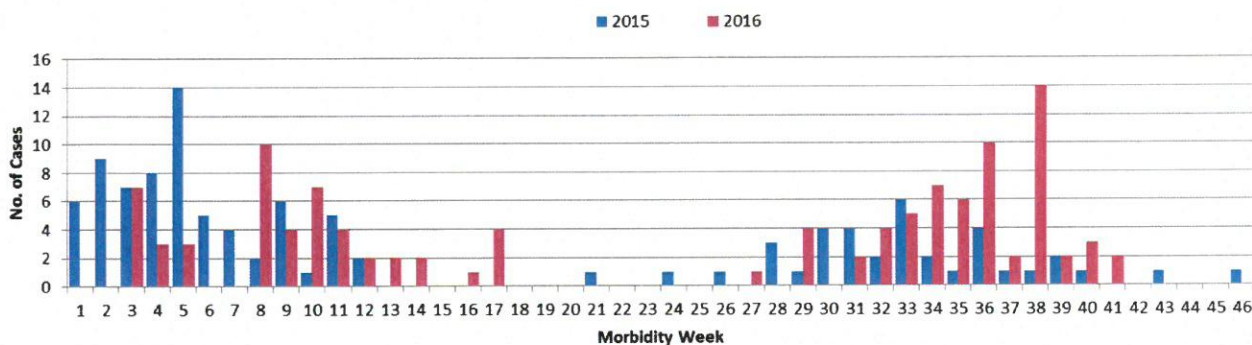

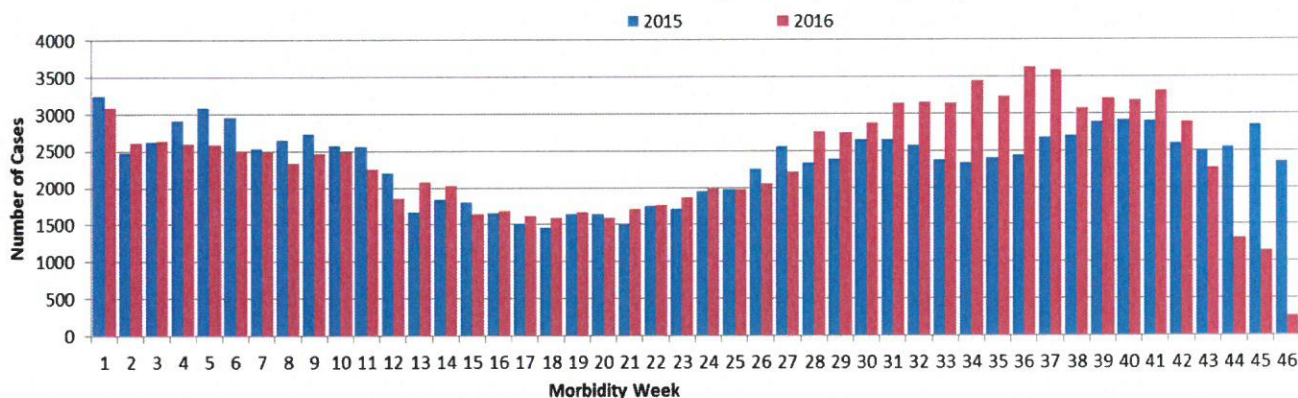

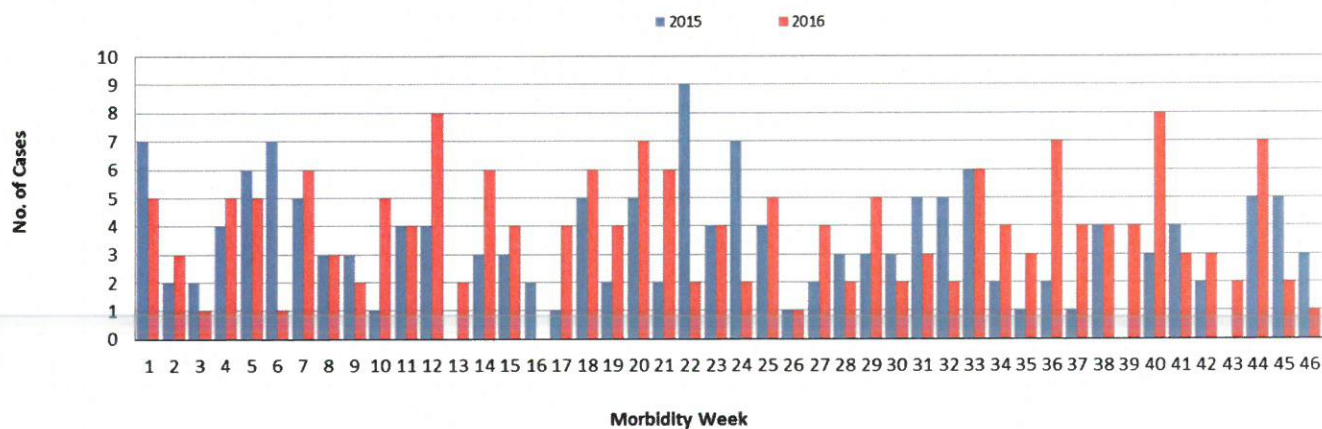
**Fig.4 Influenza Cases

as of November 19, 2016 (N=177)**





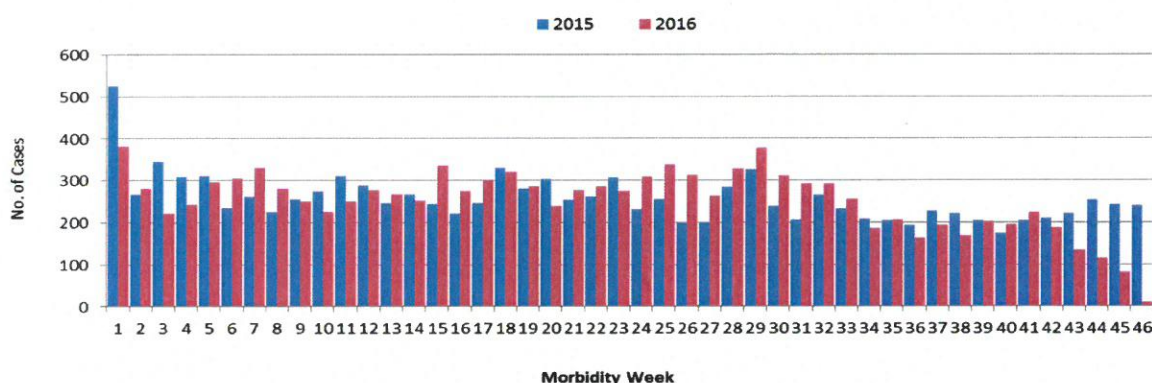

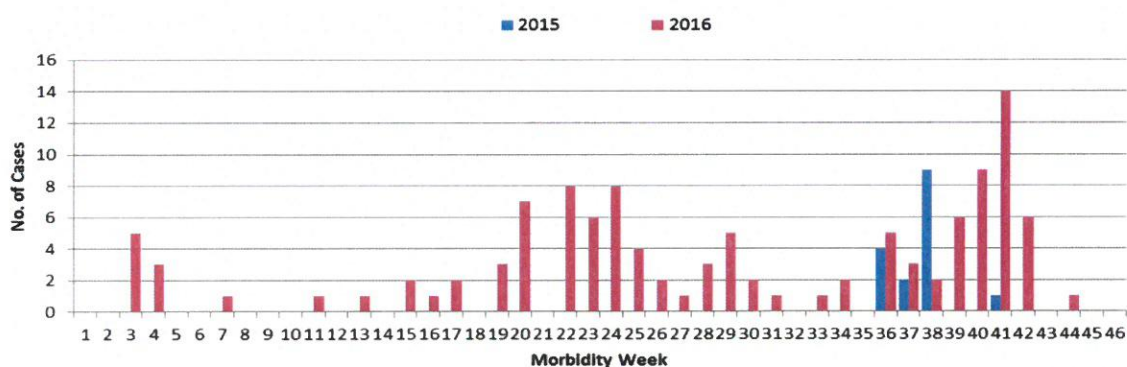

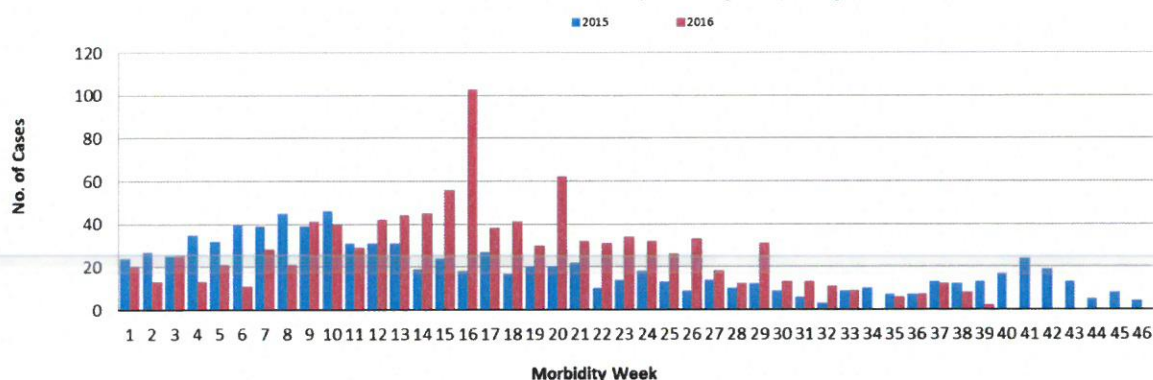
**Fig. 7 Acute Bloody Diarrhea Cases

as of November 19, 2016 (N=1,053)**



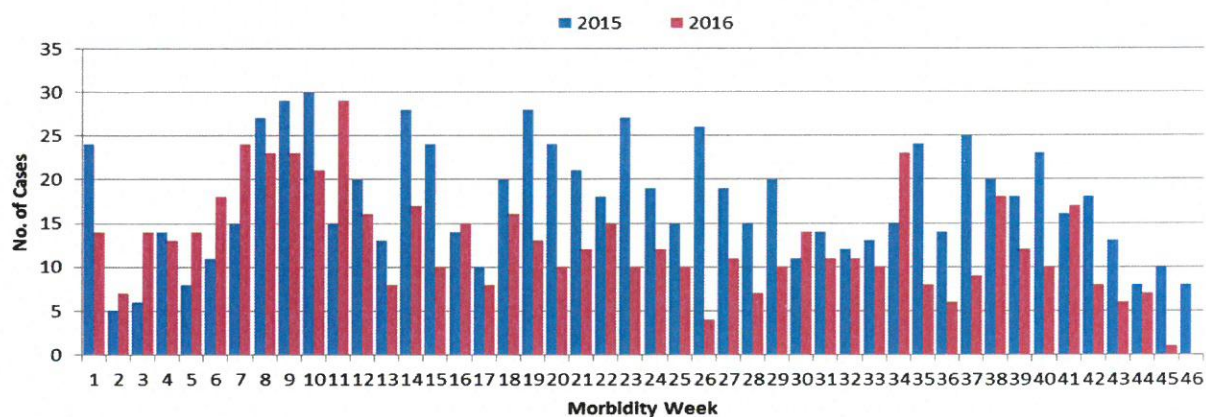

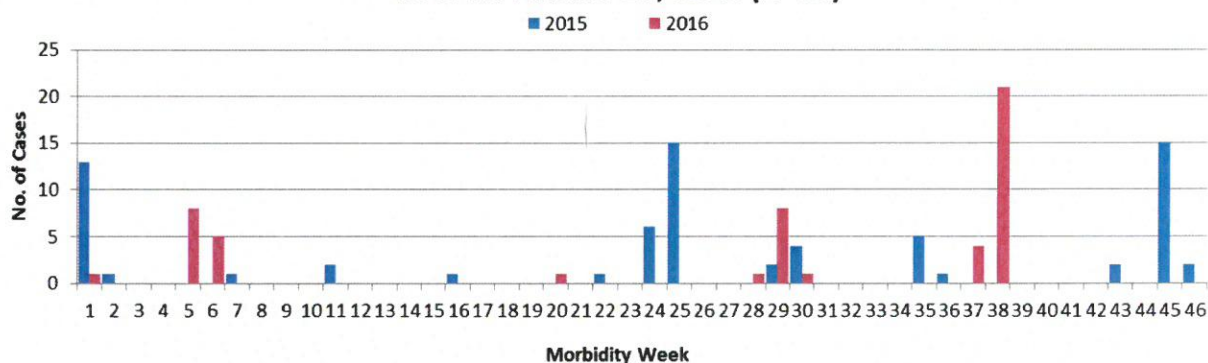

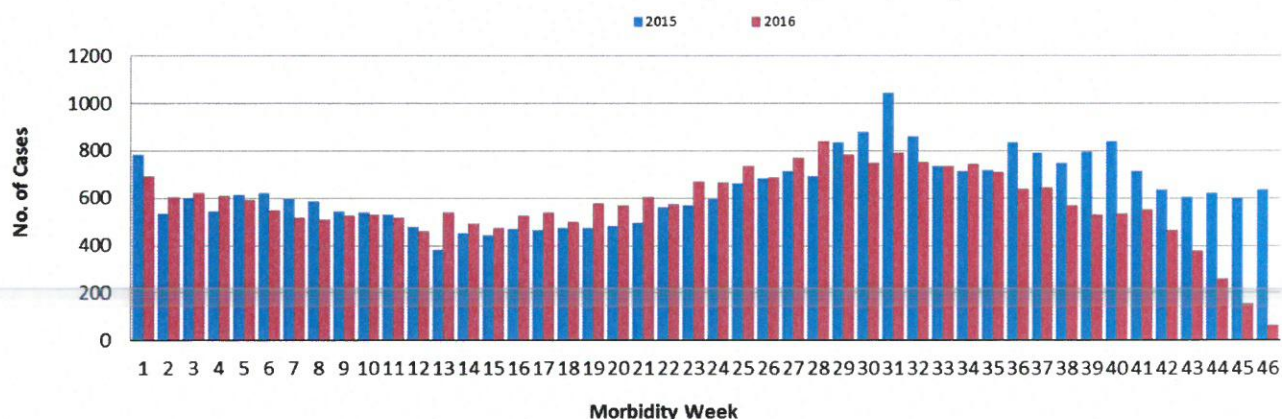
**Fig. 10 Hepatitis A Cases

as of November 19, 2016 (N=26,454)**





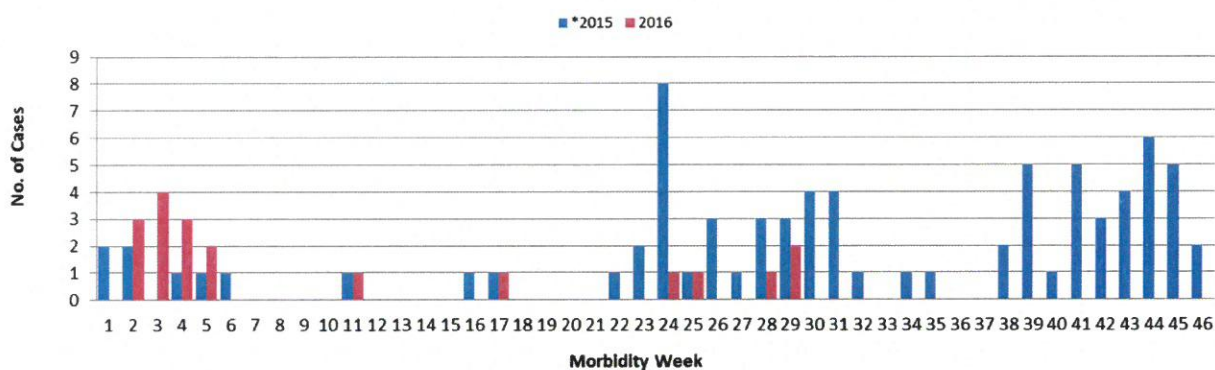

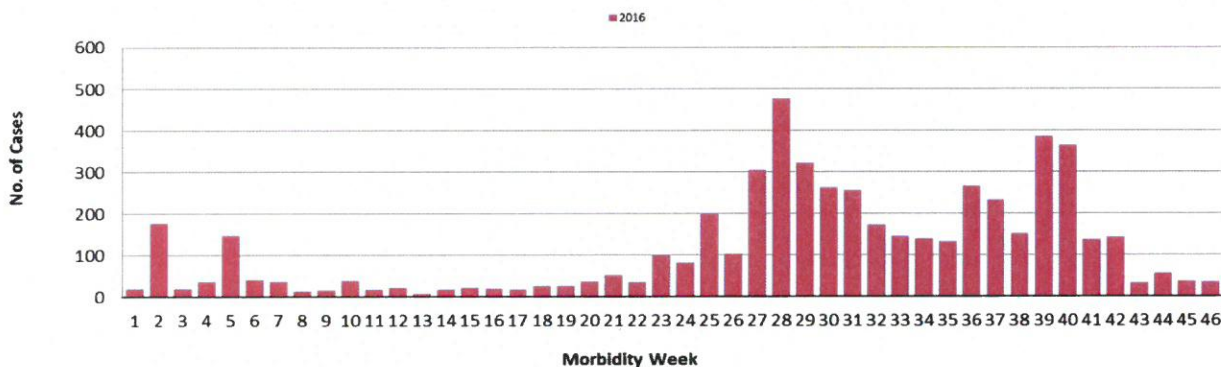

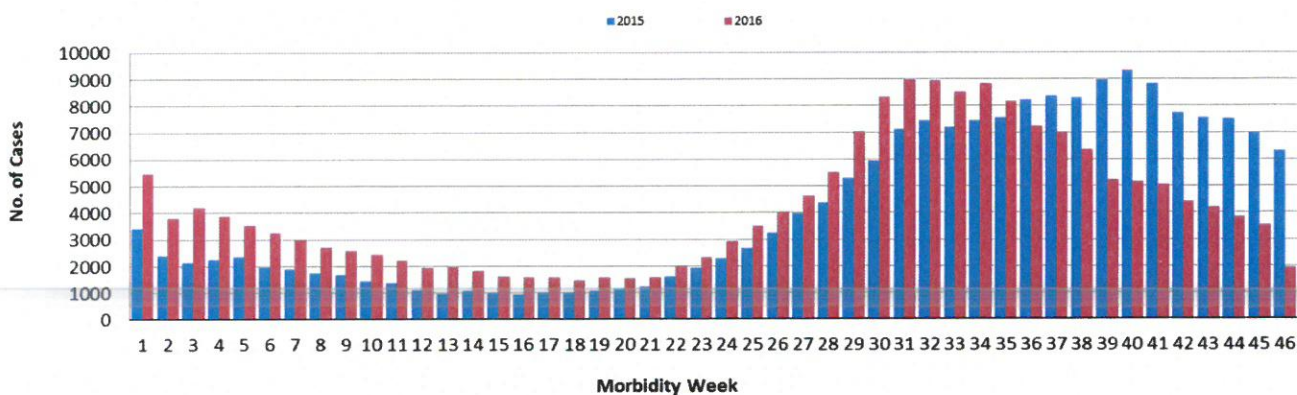
**Fig. 13 Suspect Acute Hemorrhagic Fever Cases

as of November 19, 2016 (N=190,946)**



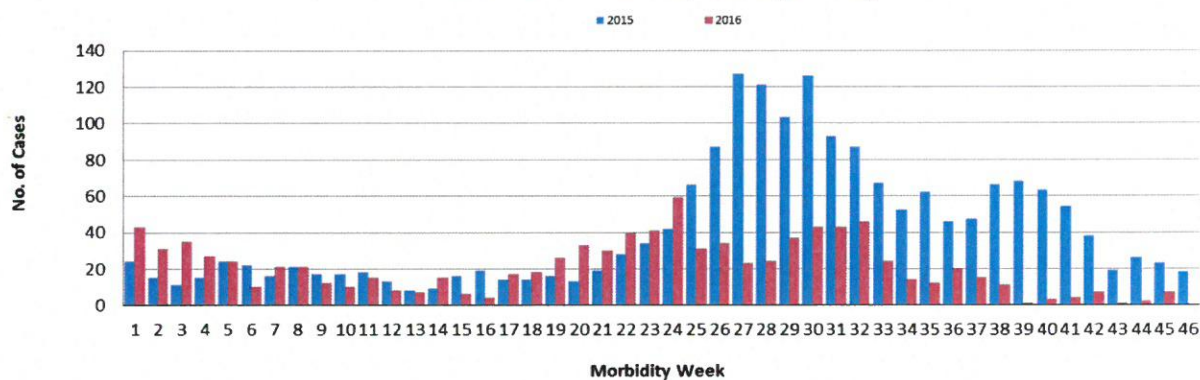

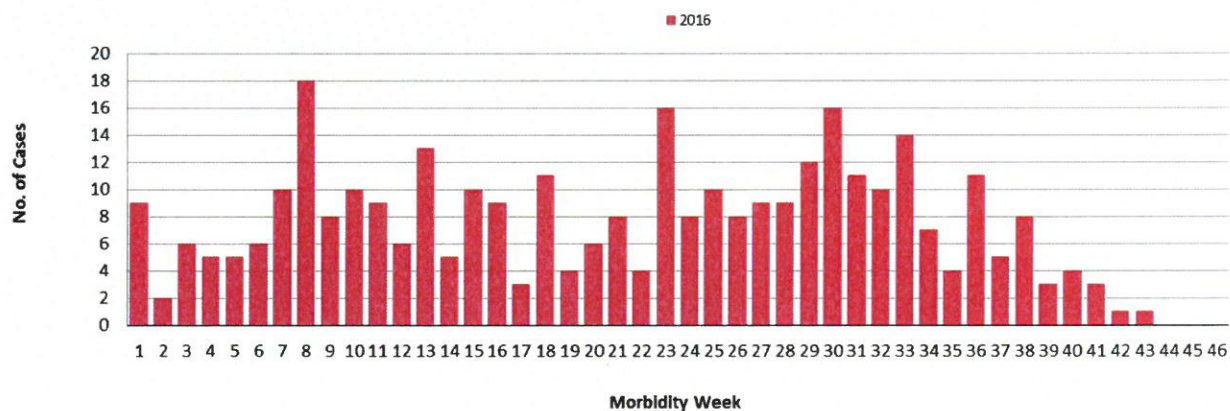

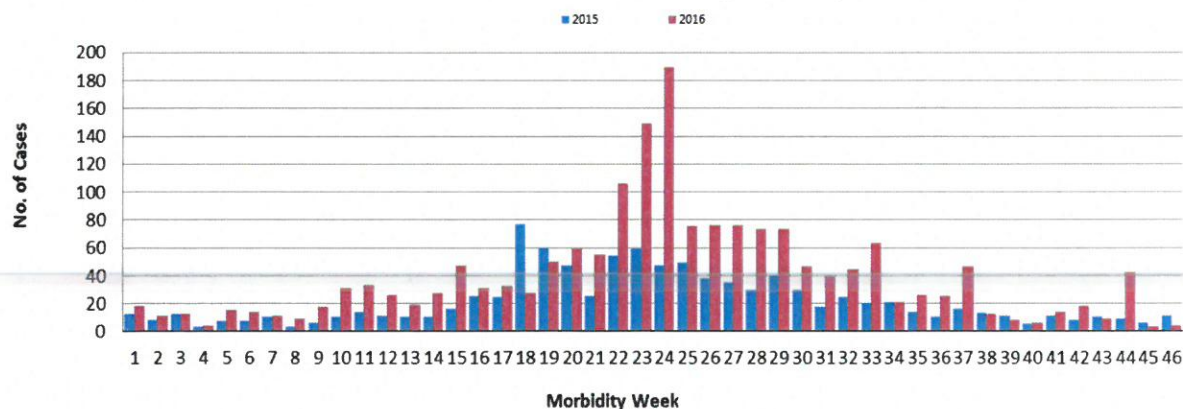
**Fig. 16 Confirmed Dengue Cases

as of November 19, 2016 (N=1,791)**





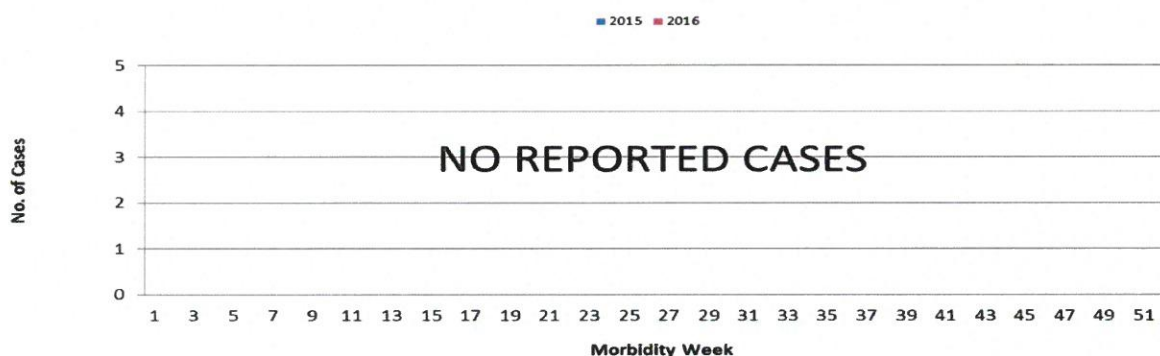

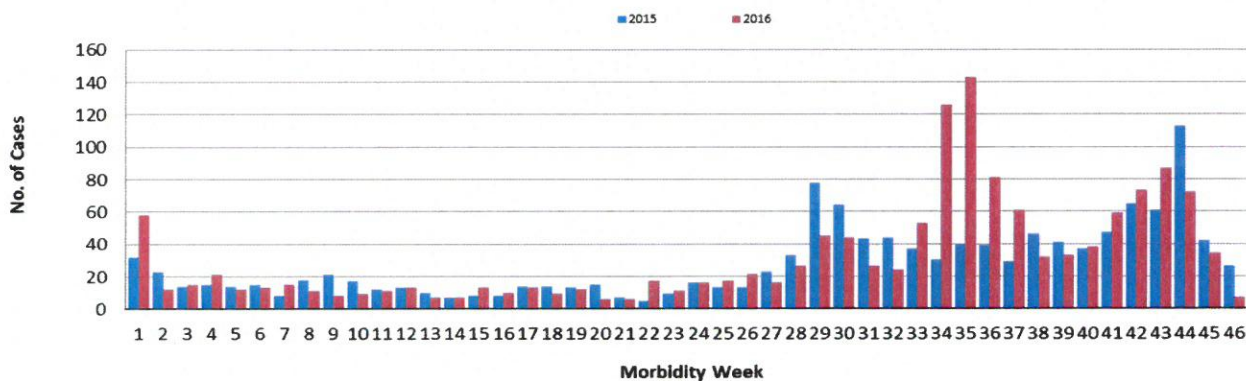

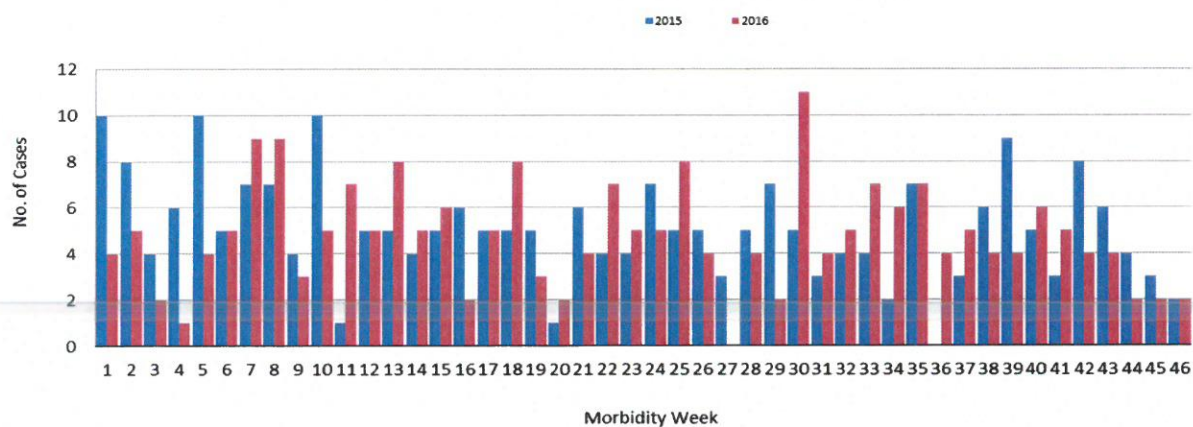
**Fig. 19 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of November 19, 2016 (N=219)**





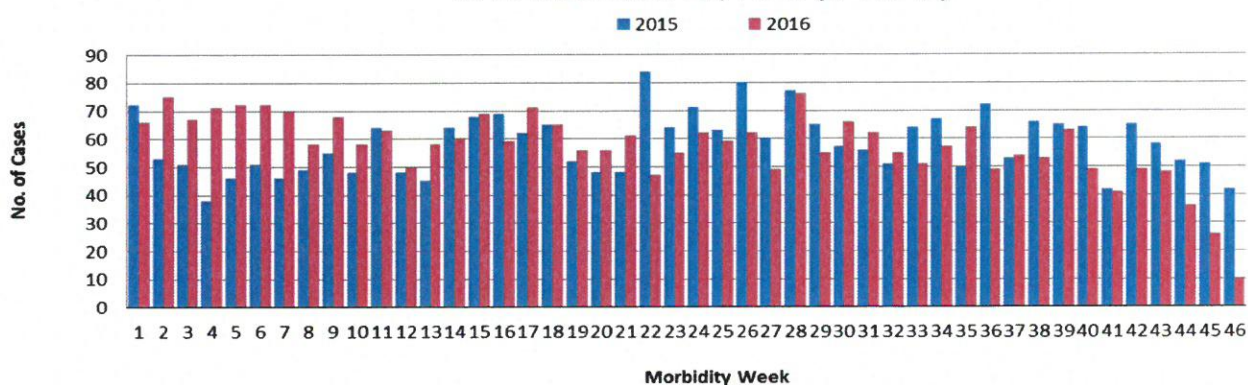

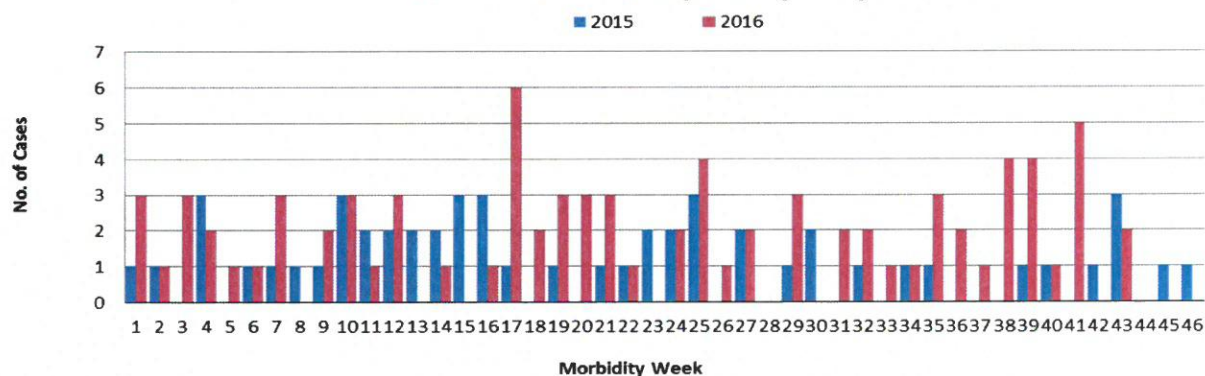

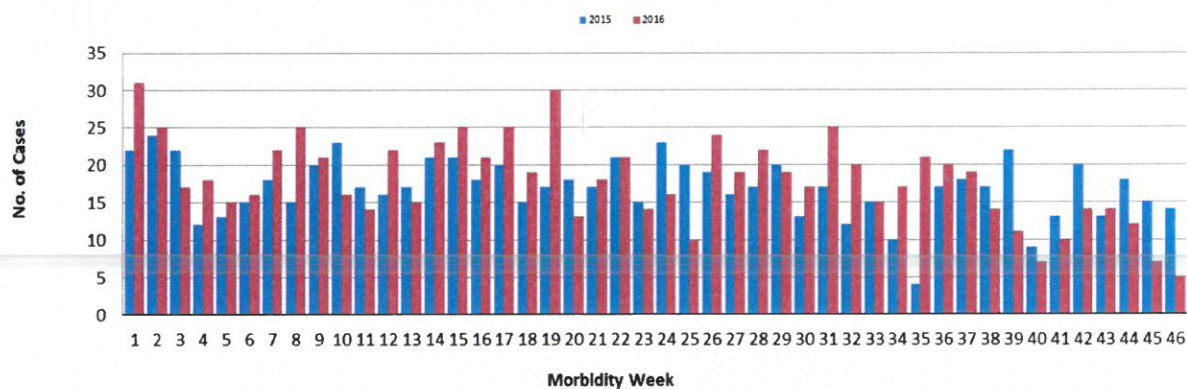
**Fig. 22 Confirmed Hepatitis B Cases

as of November 19, 2016 (N=824)**





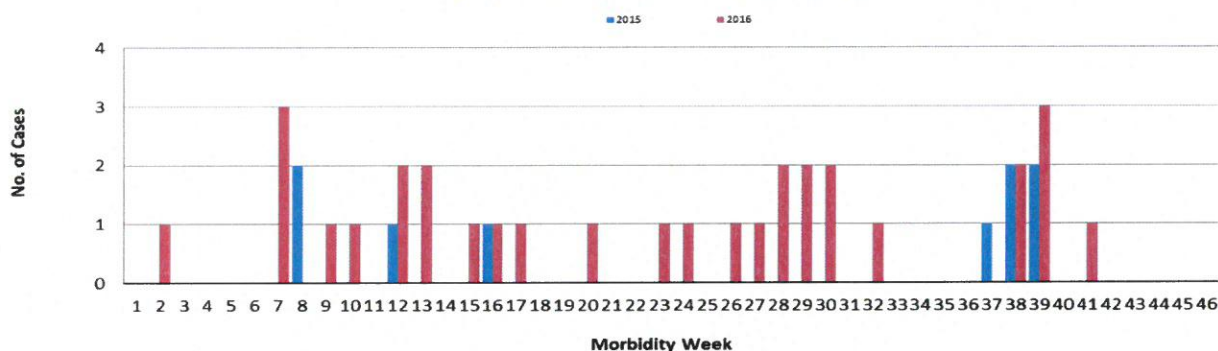

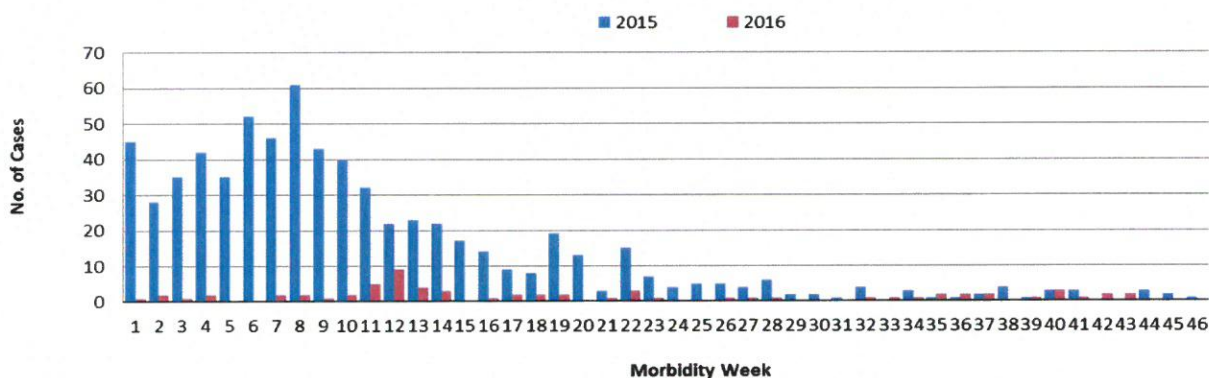

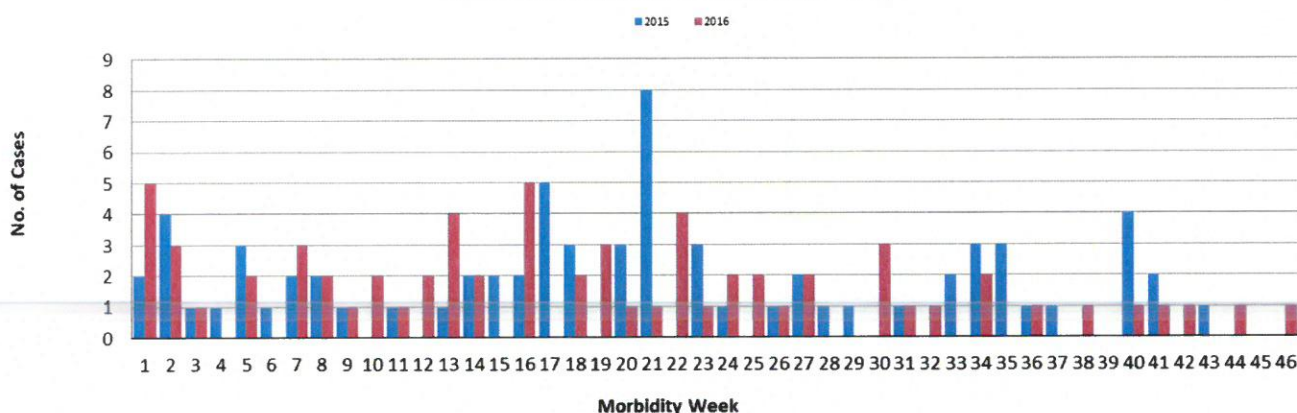
**Fig. 25 Confirmed Diphtheria Cases

as of November 19, 2016 (N=66)**



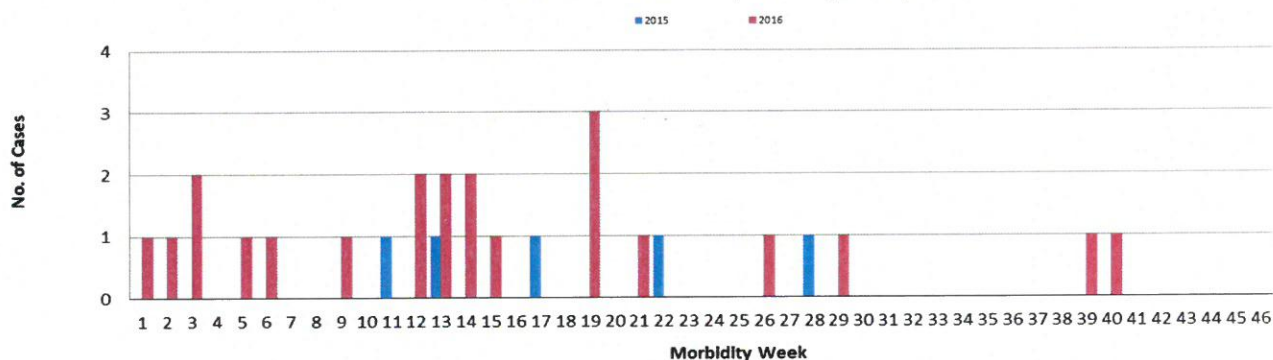

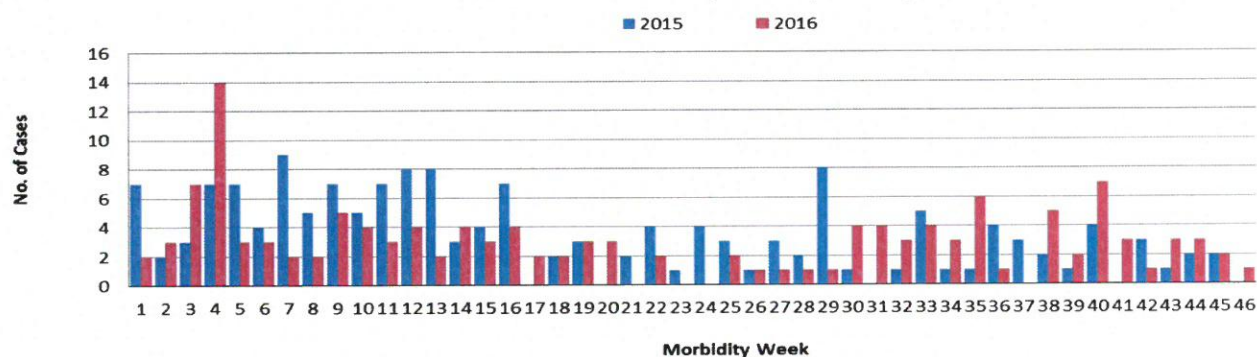

as of November 19, 2016 (N=22)**

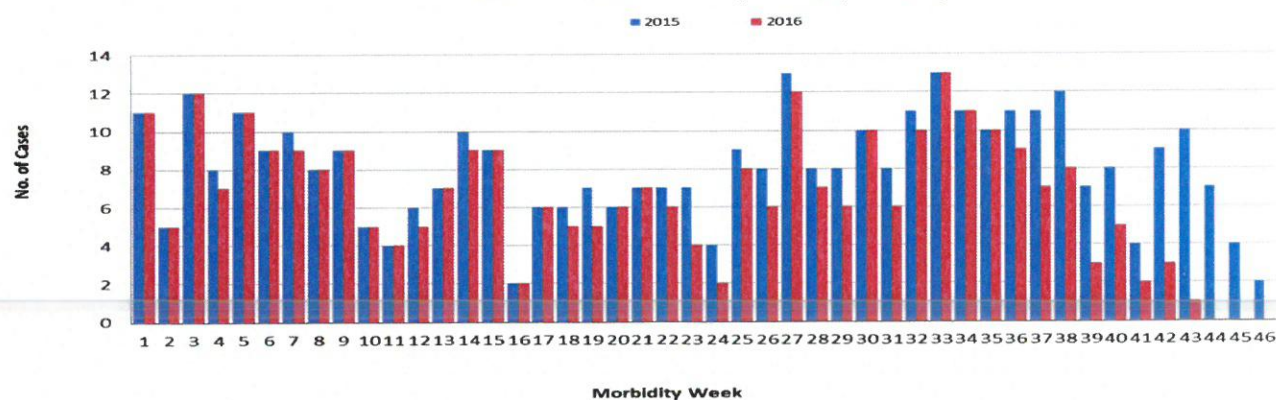


**Fig. 29 Confirmed Rubella Cases
