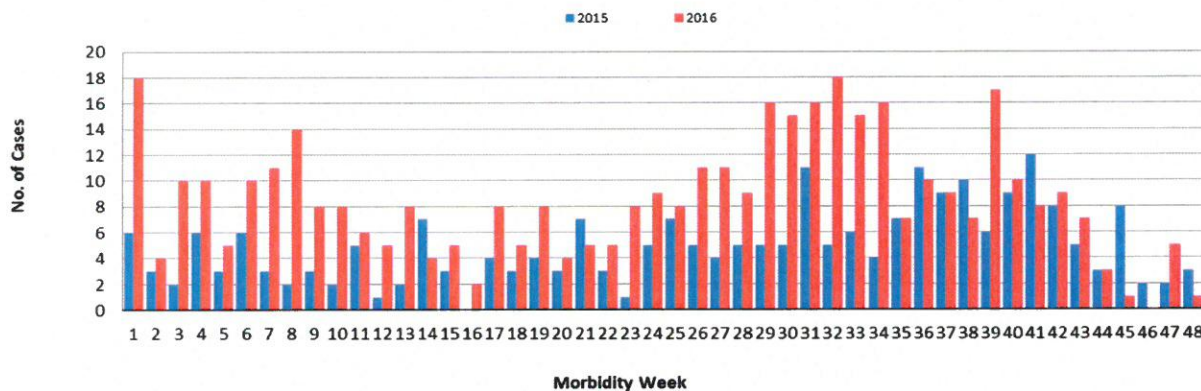


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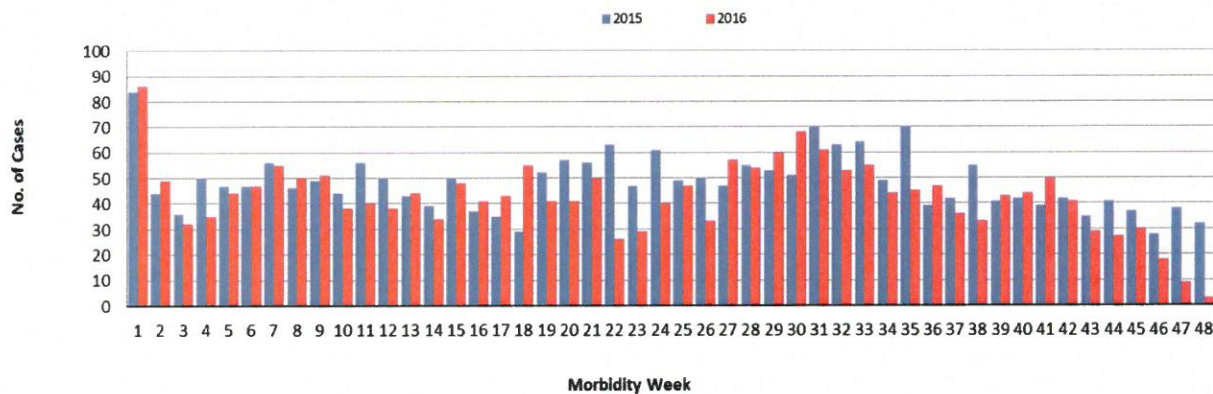

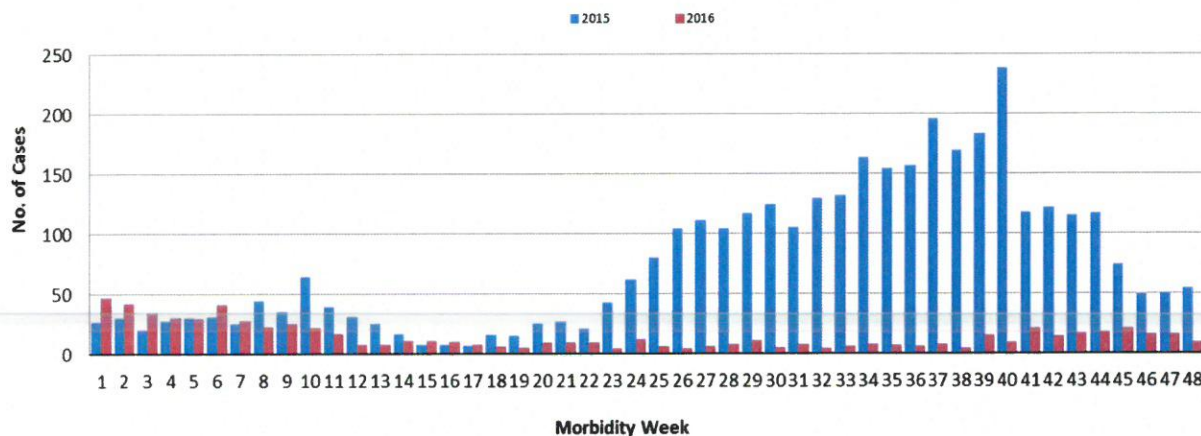
**Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases

as of December 3, 2016 (N=695)**

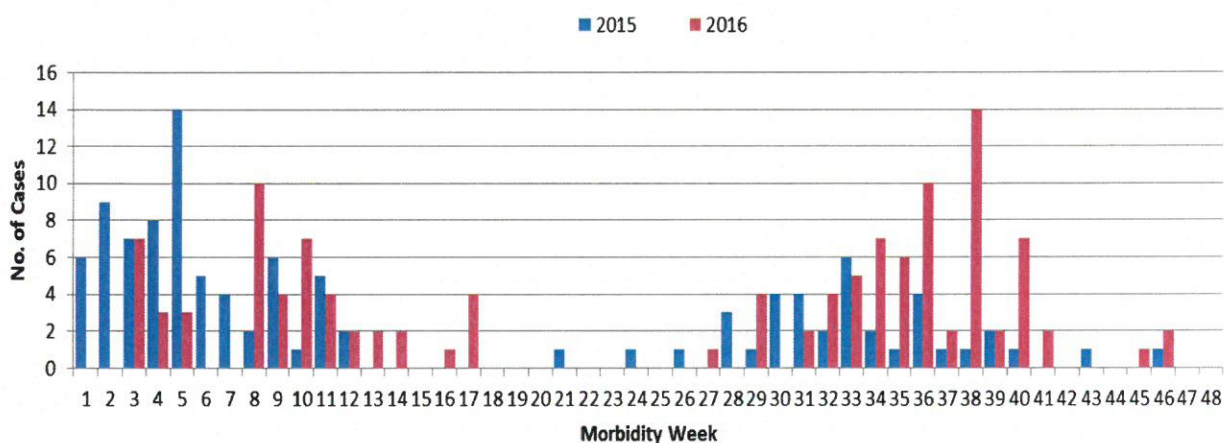




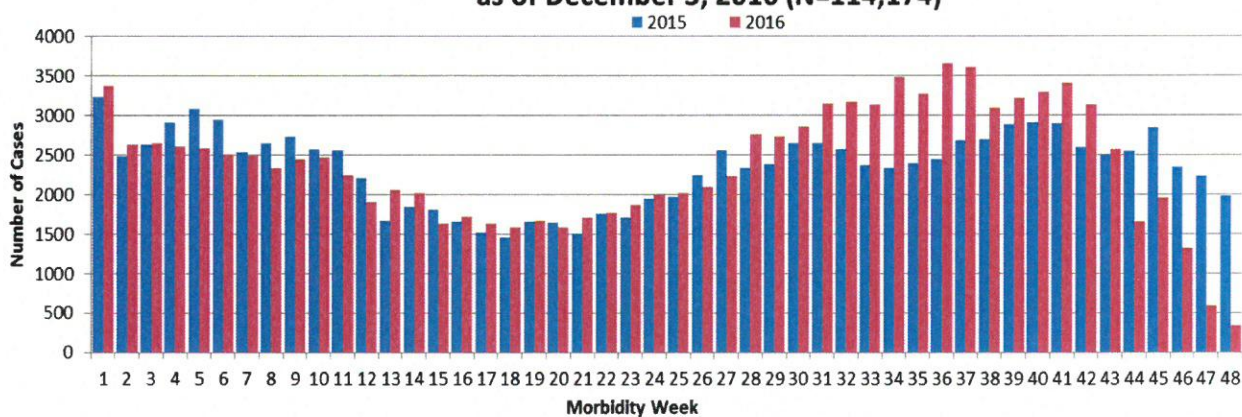
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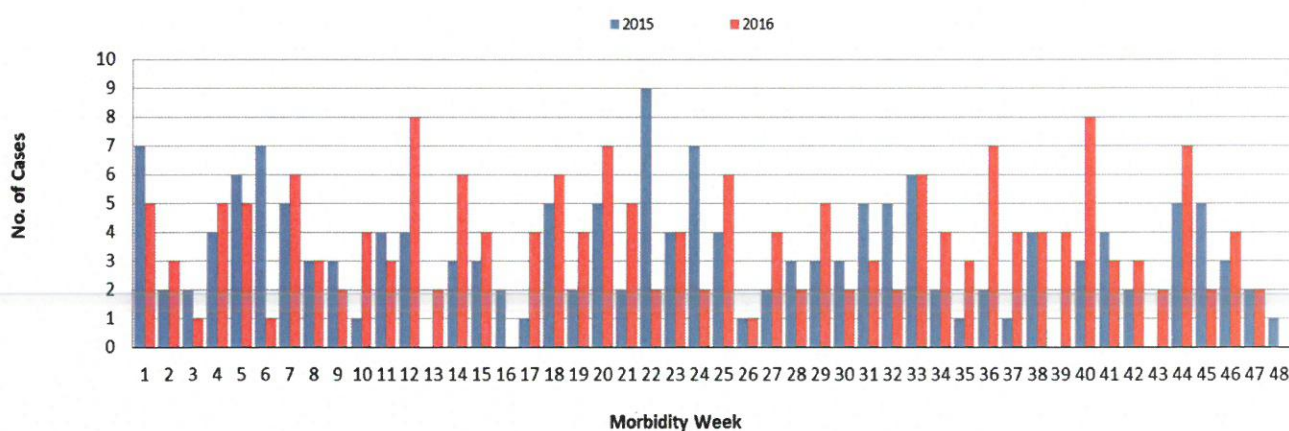
**Fig.4 Influenza Cases

as of December 3, 2016 (N=180)**



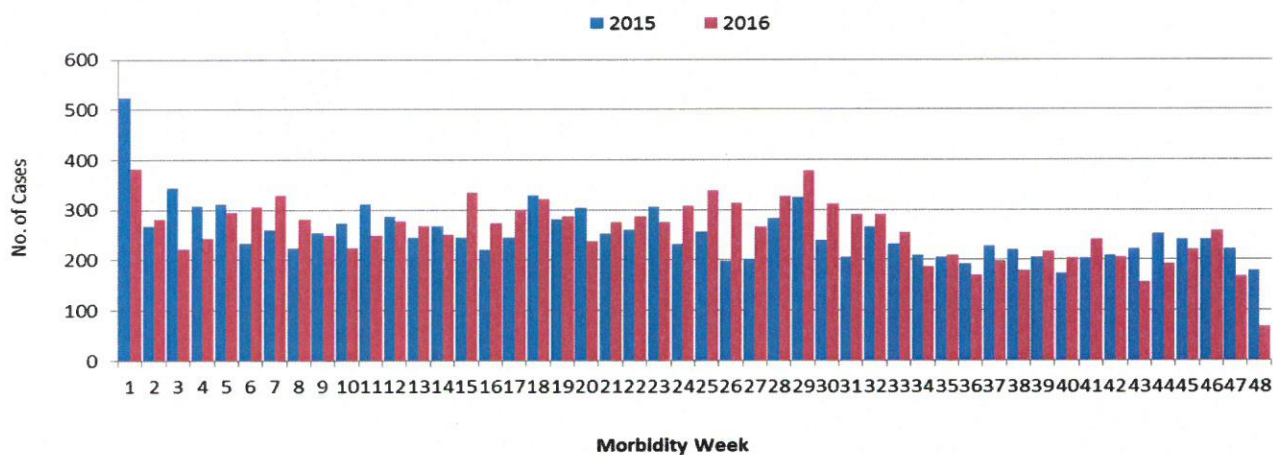


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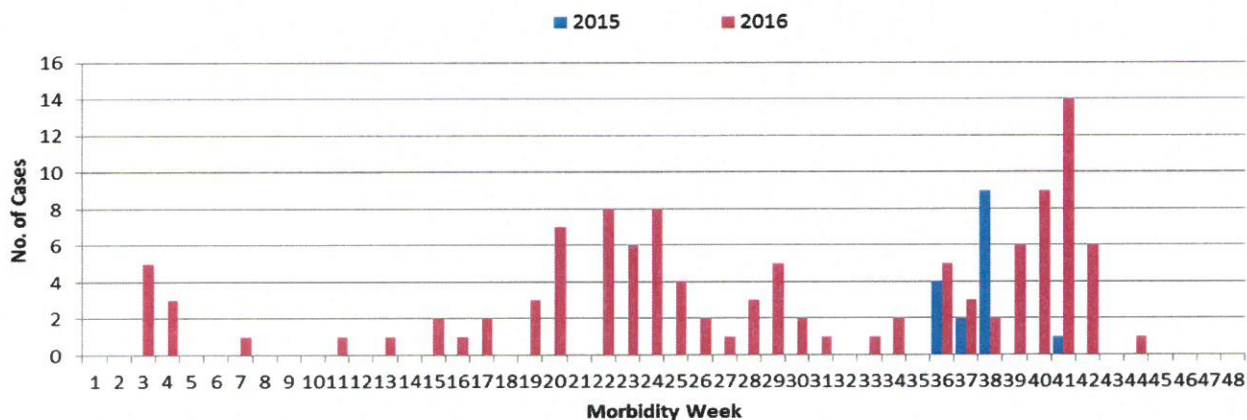

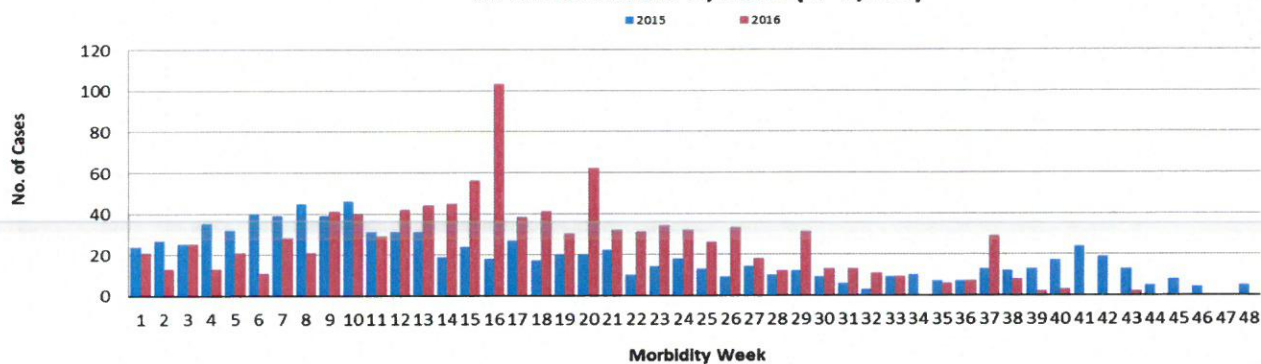
**Fig. 7 Acute Bloody Diarrhea Cases

as of December 3, 2016 (N=1,076)**

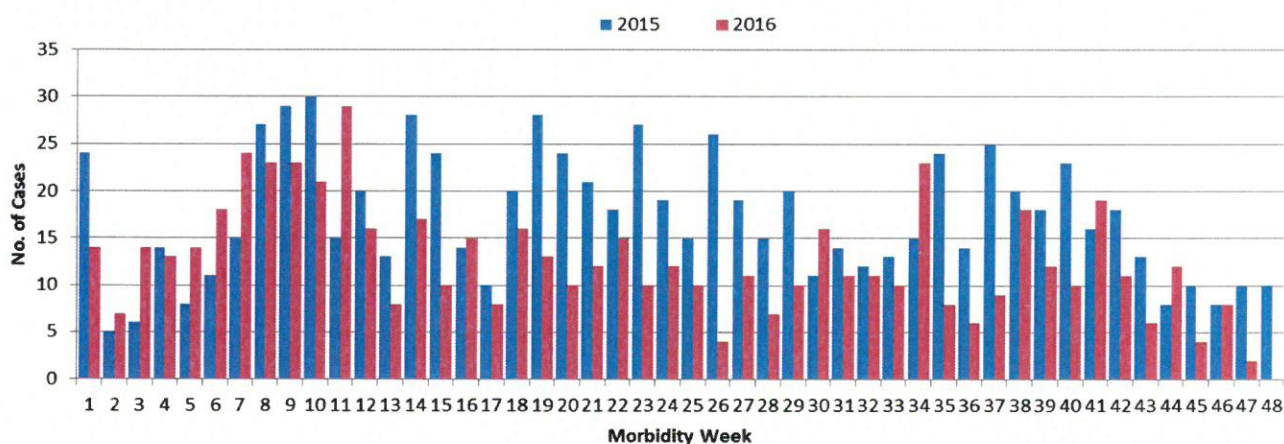




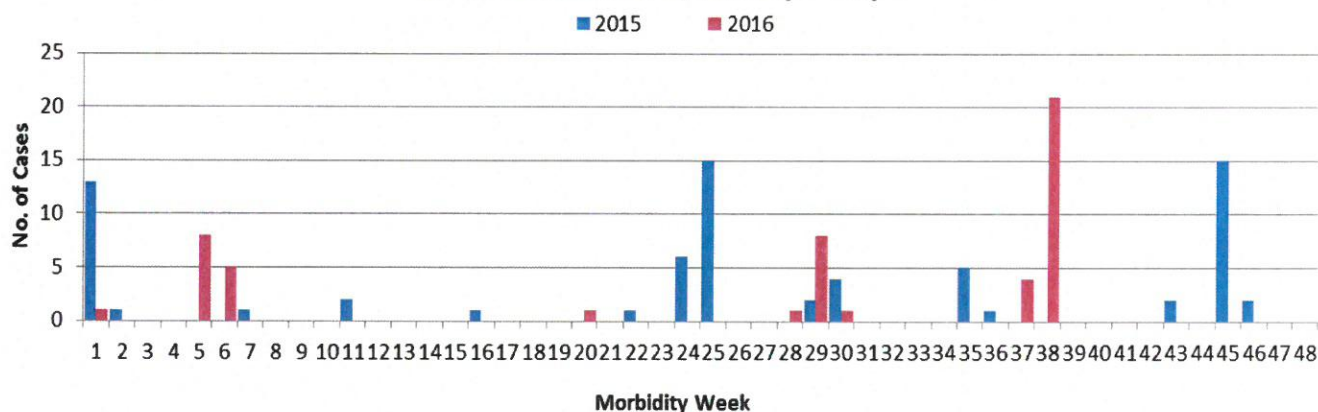
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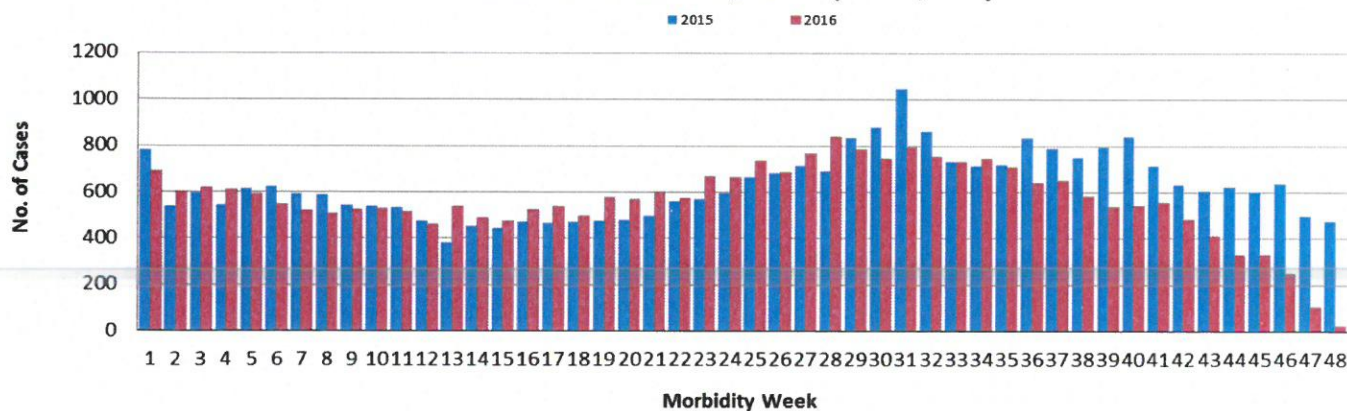
**Fig. 10 Hepatitis A Cases

as of December 3, 2016 (N=27,106)**



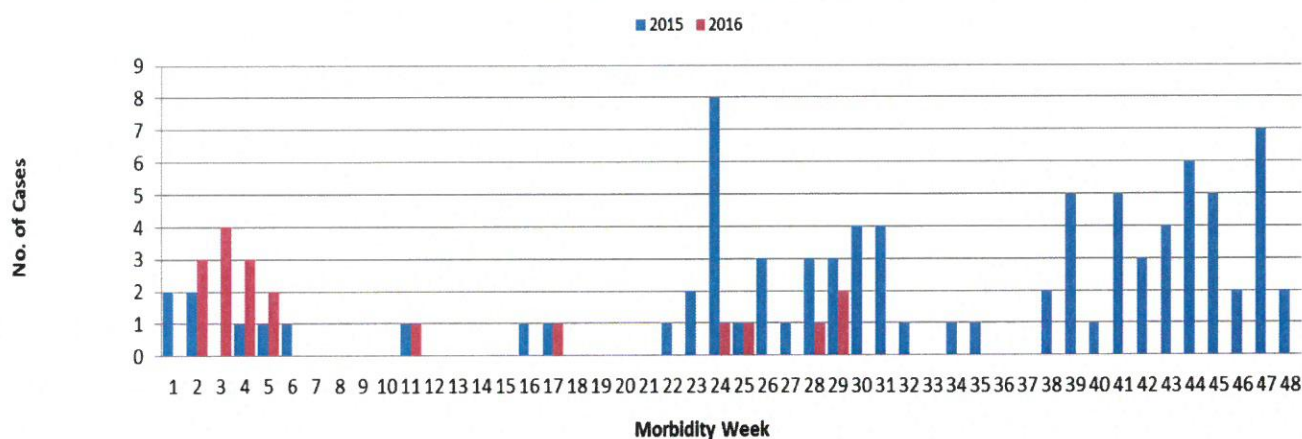


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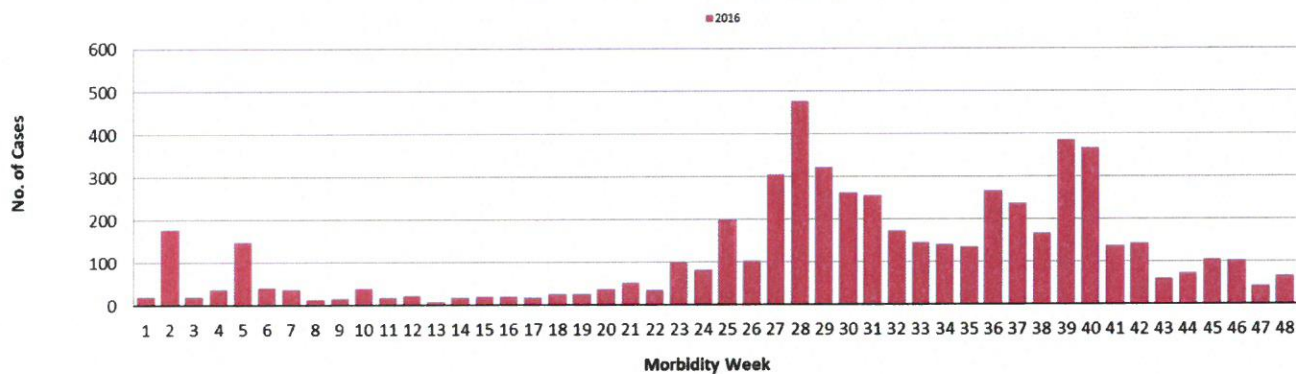

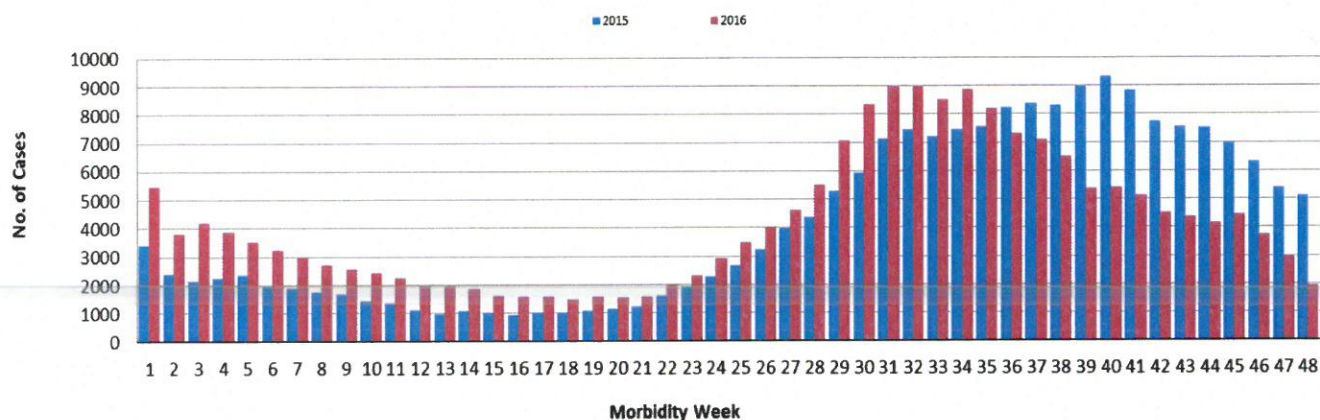
**Fig. 13 Suspect Acute Hemorrhagic Fever Cases

as of December 3, 2016 (N=200,152)**

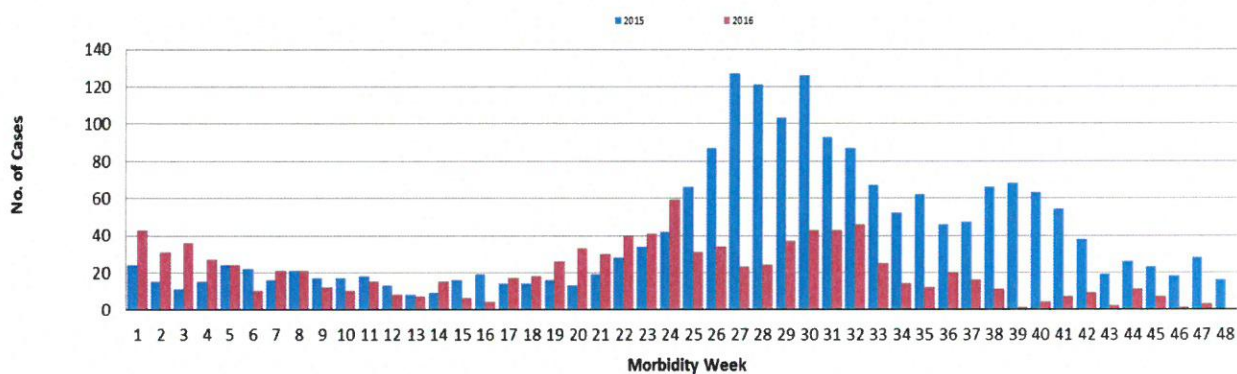




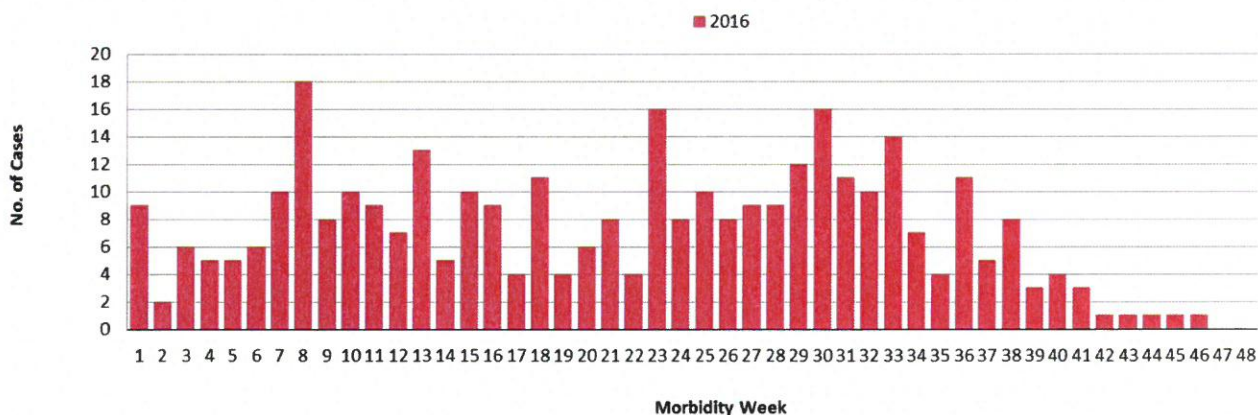
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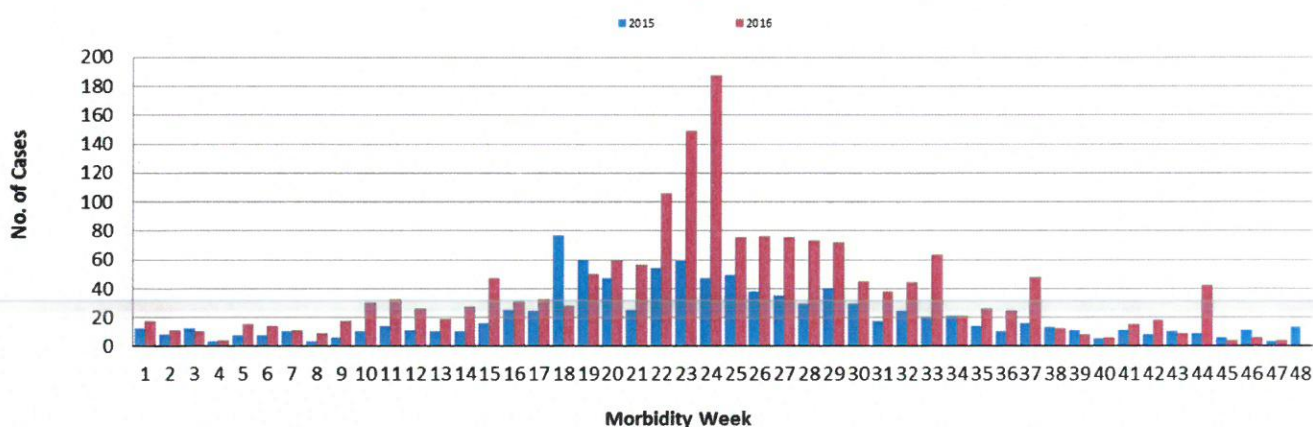
**Fig. 16 Confirmed Dengue Cases

as of December 3, 2016 (N=1,792)**



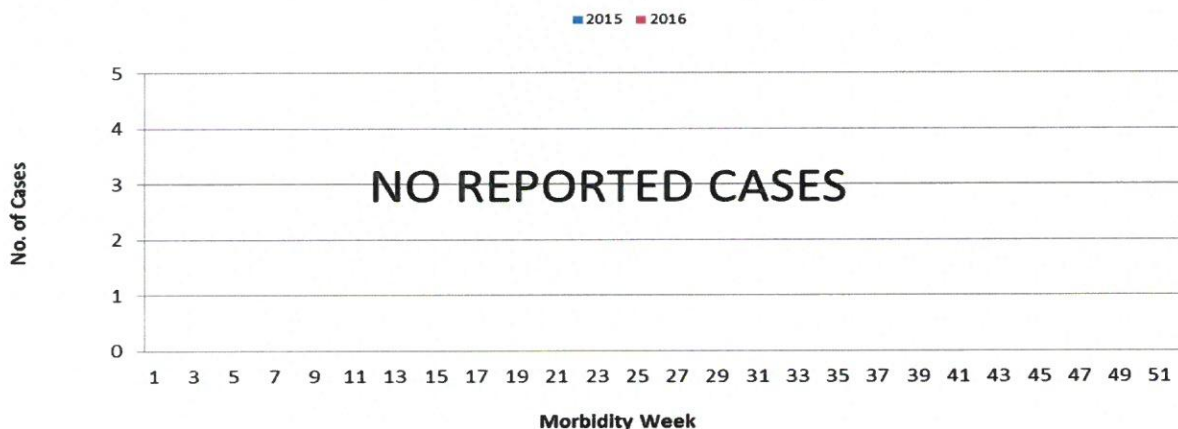


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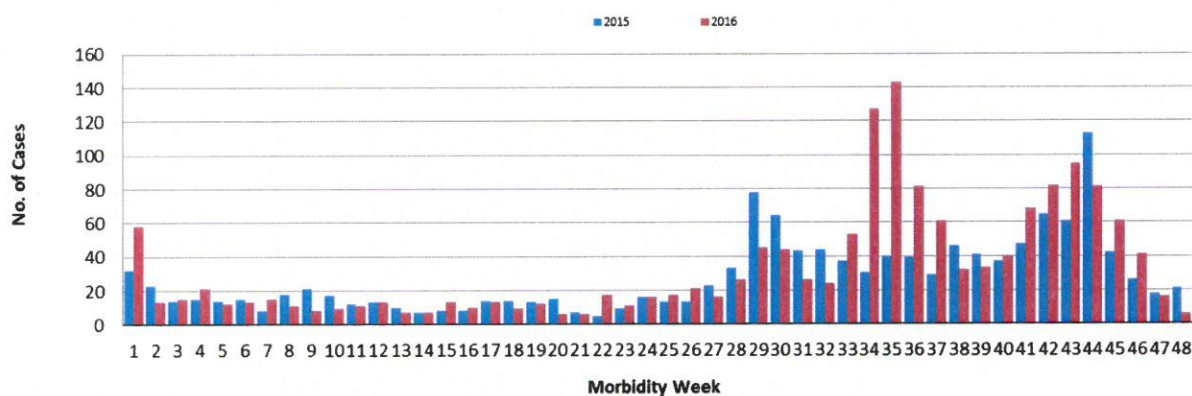

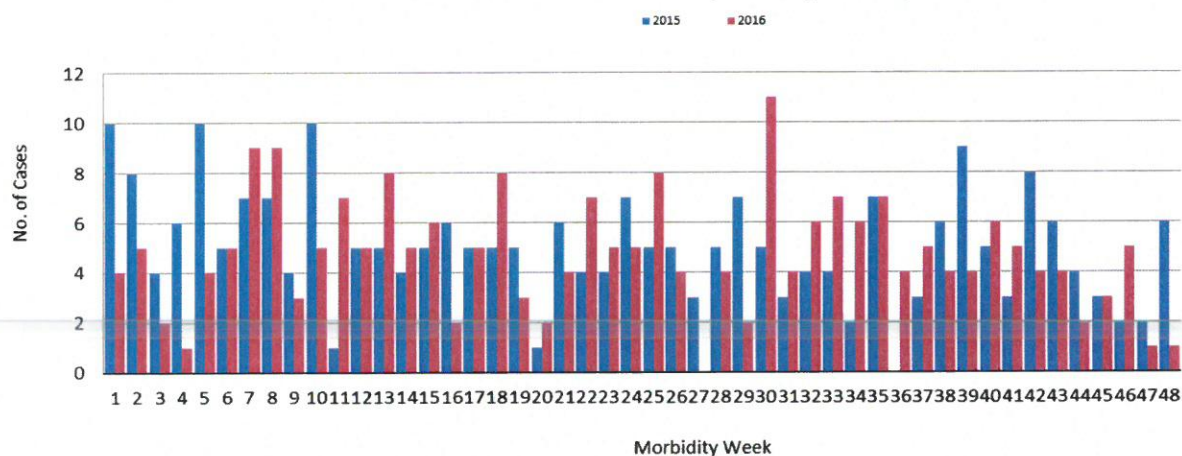
**Fig. 19 Suspect Anthrax Cases

as of December 3, 2016 (N=226)**



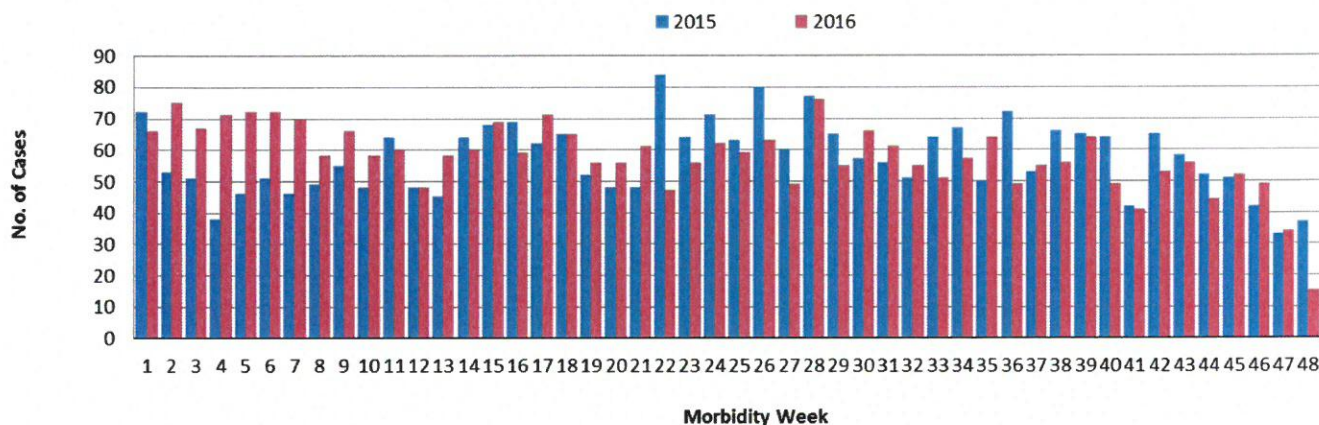


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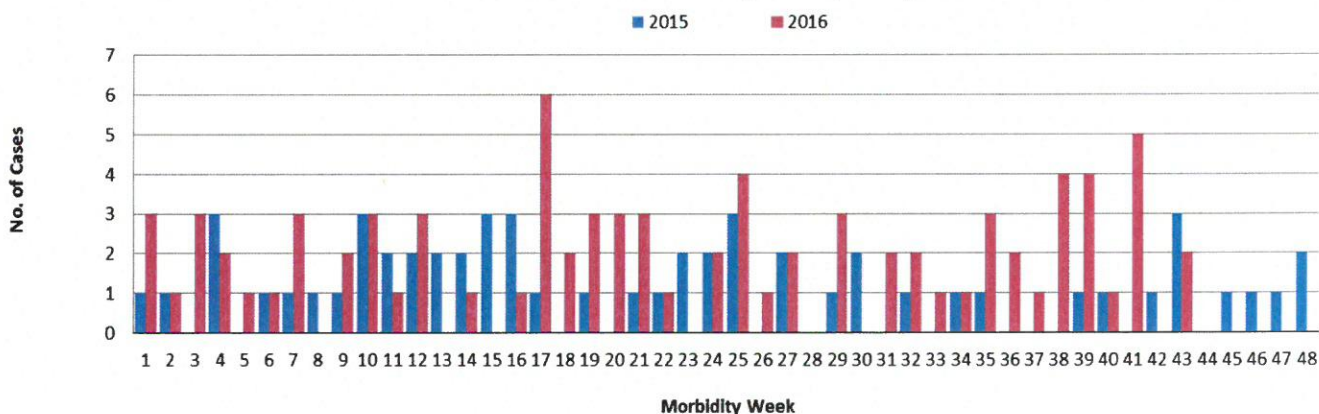

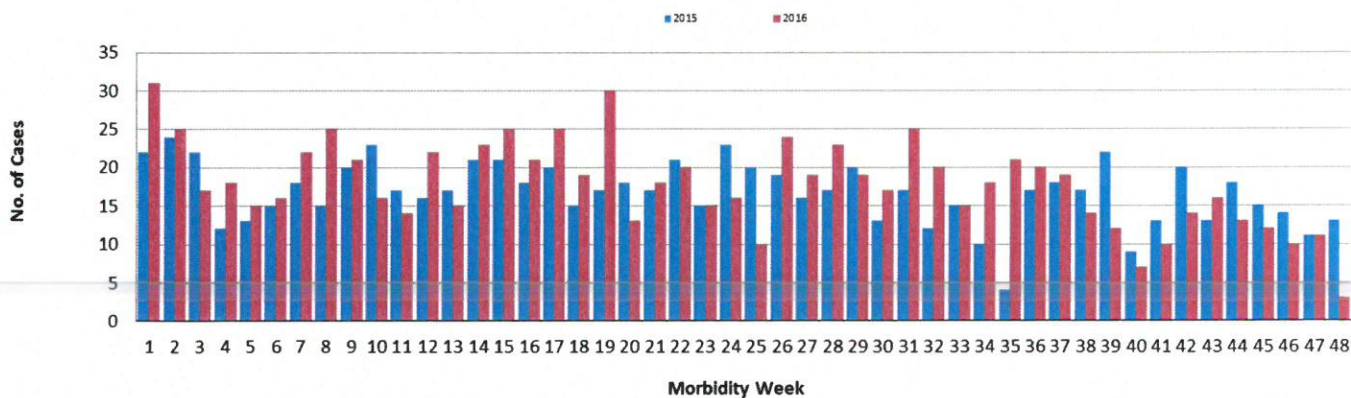
**Fig. 22 Confirmed Hepatitis B Cases

as of December 3, 2016 (N=854)**



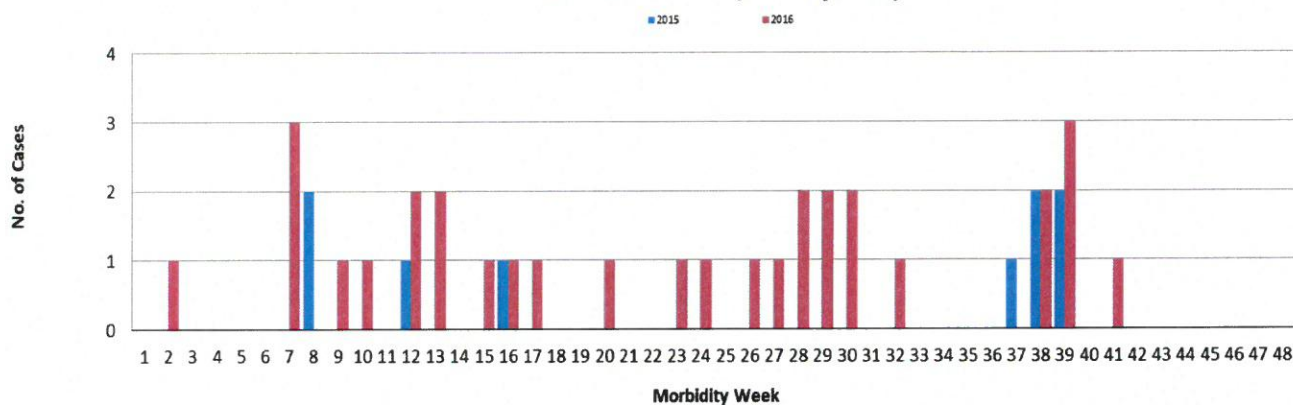


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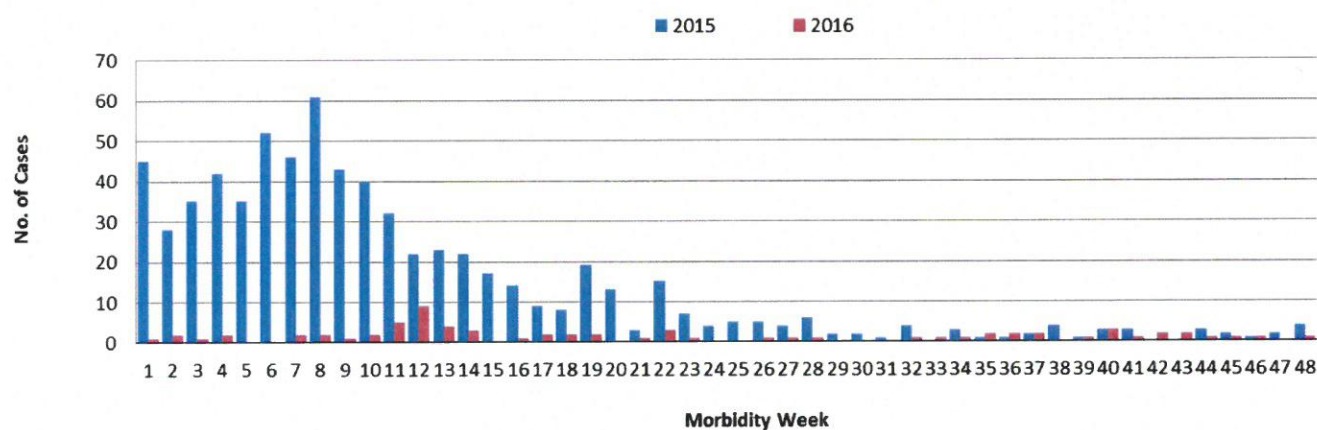

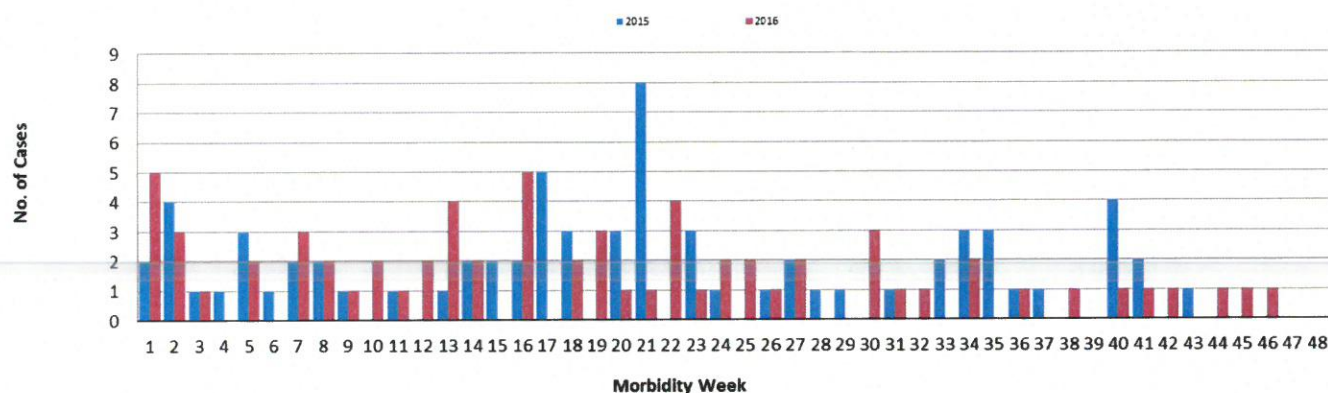
**Fig. 25 Confirmed Diphtheria Cases

as of December 3, 2016 (N=67)**

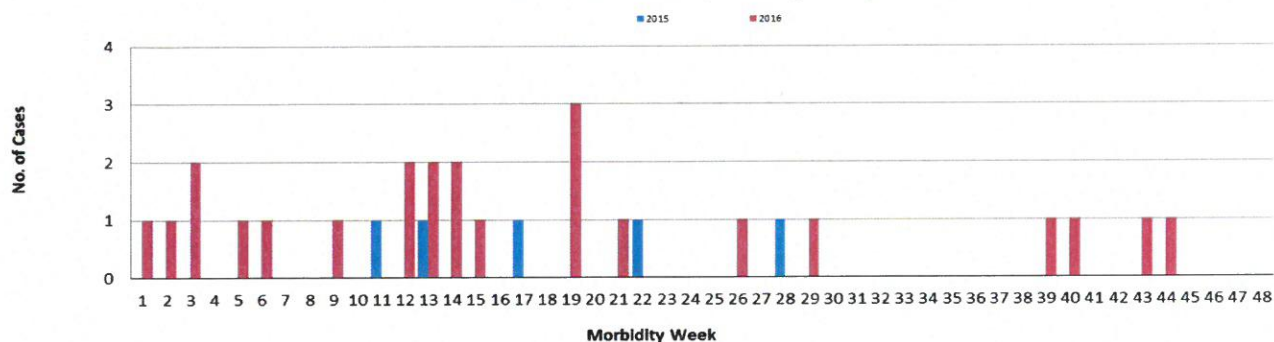




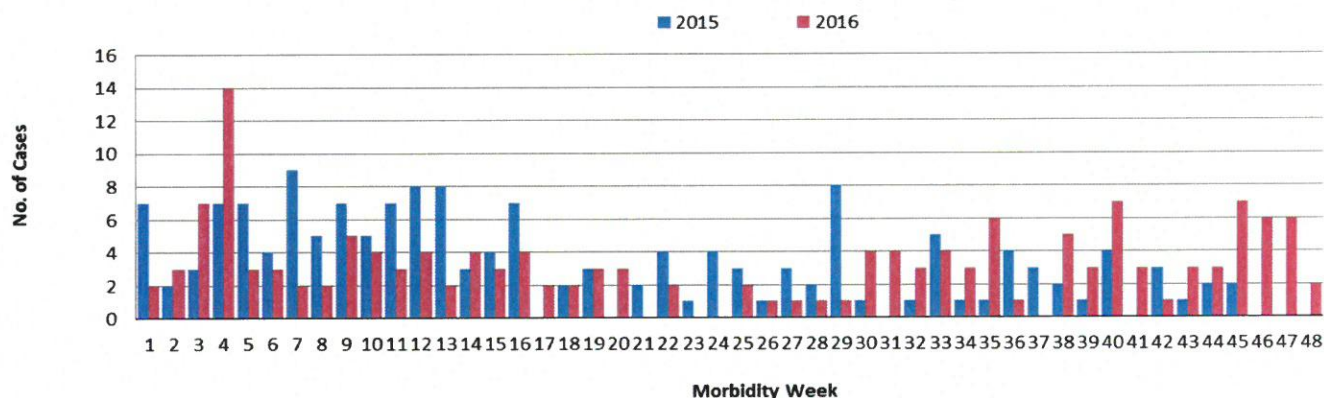
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**Fig. 28 Confirmed Pertussis Cases
as of December 3, 2016 (N=24)**

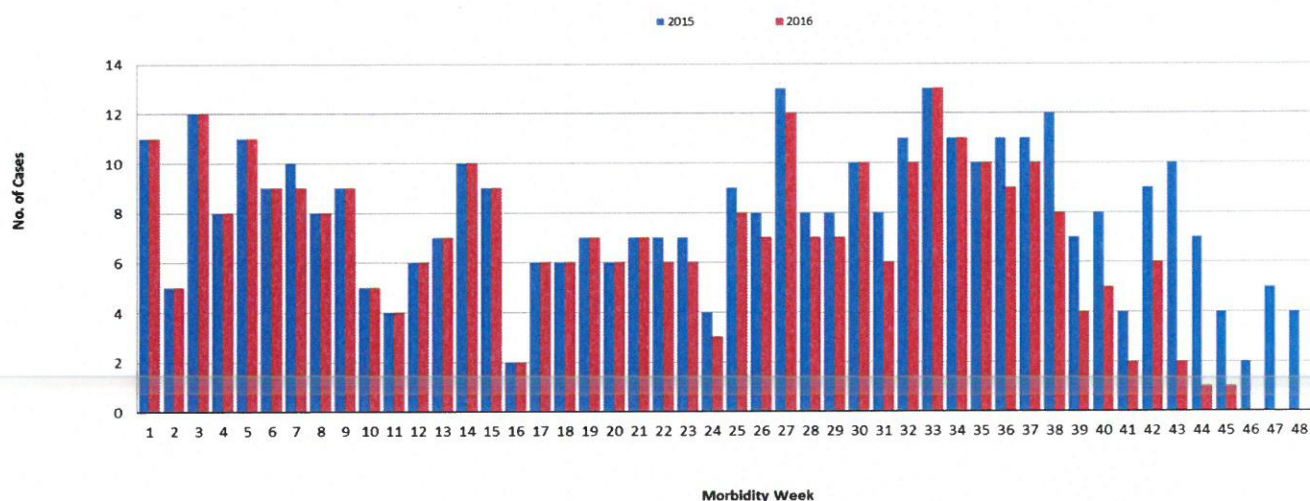


**Fig. 29 Confirmed Rubella Cases
