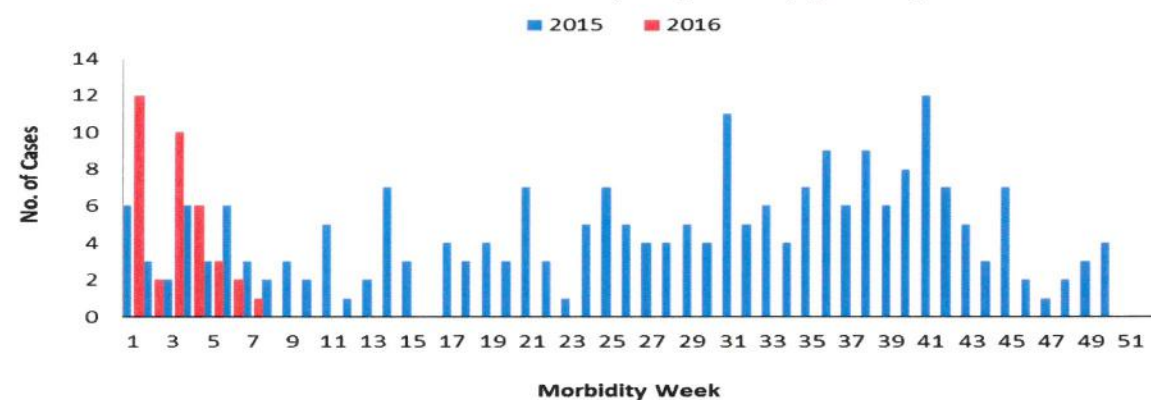

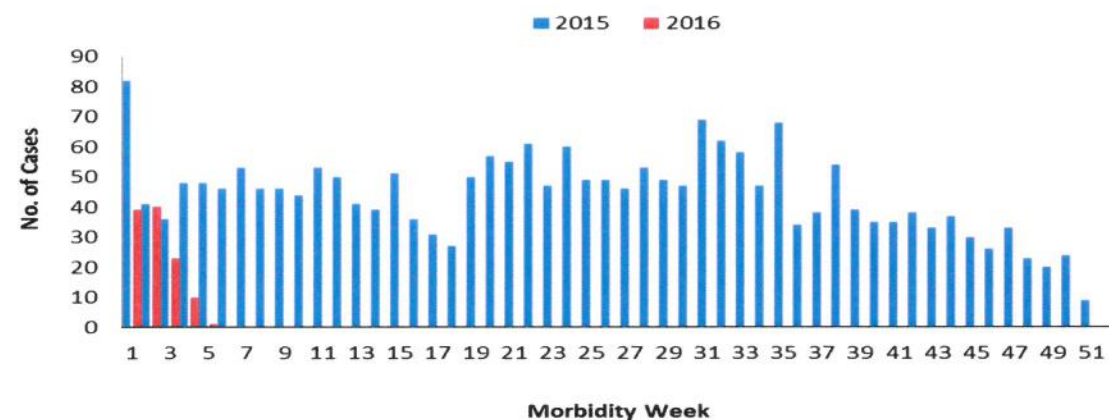

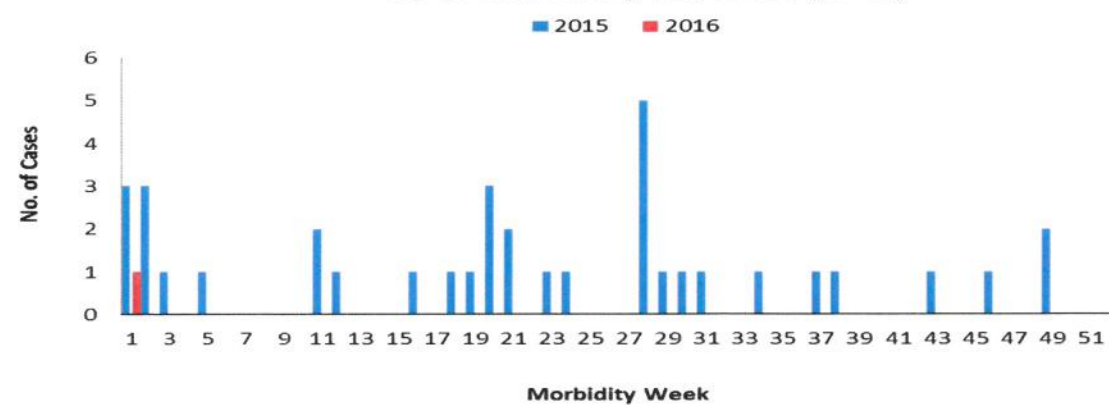
**Fig. 1 Suspect Acute Encephalitis Syndrome Cases

as of February 20, 2016 (N=1)**



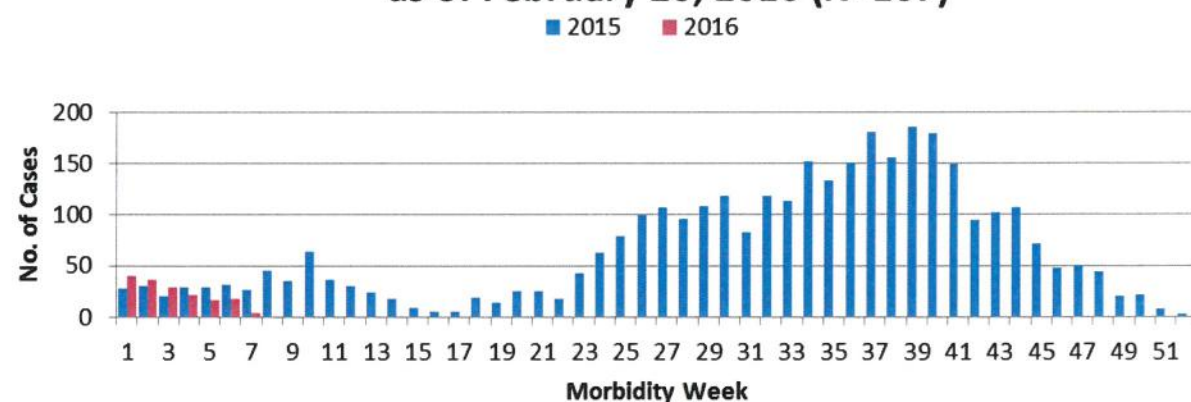




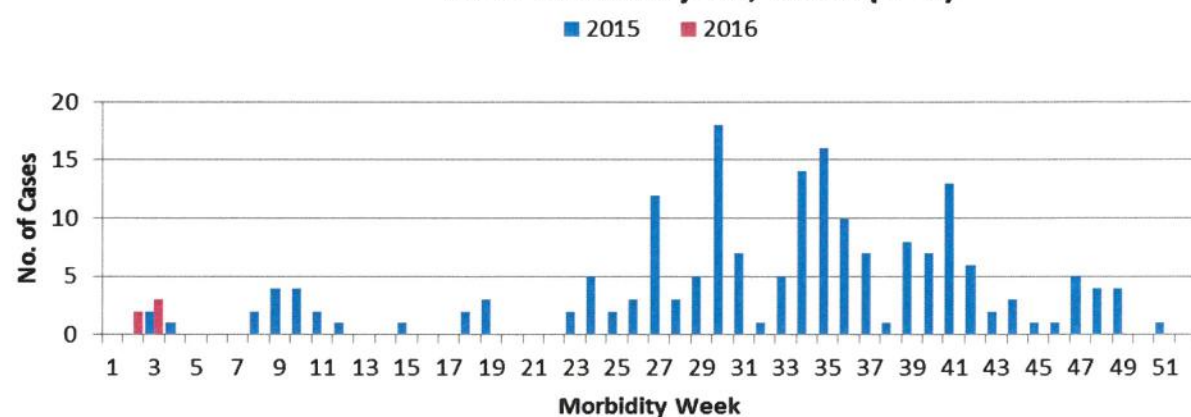
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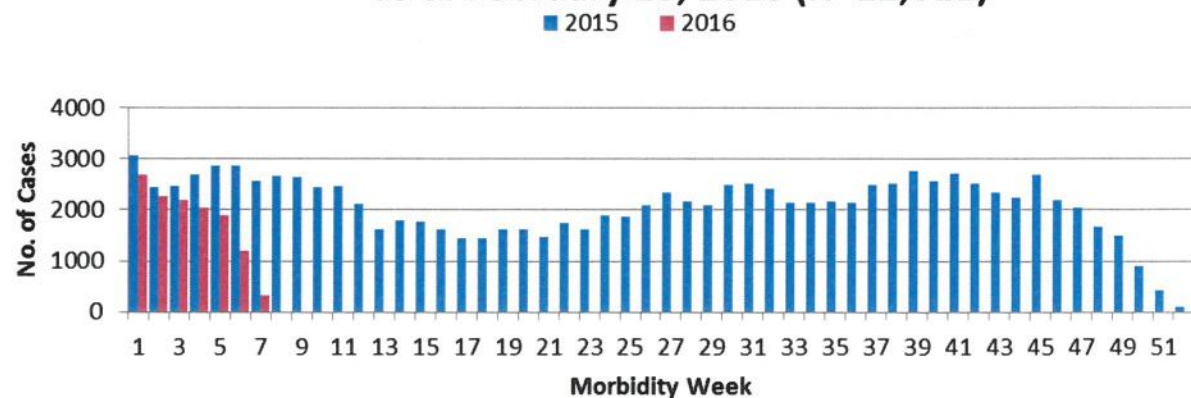
**Fig.4 Suspect Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease Cases

as of February 20, 2016 (n=5)**



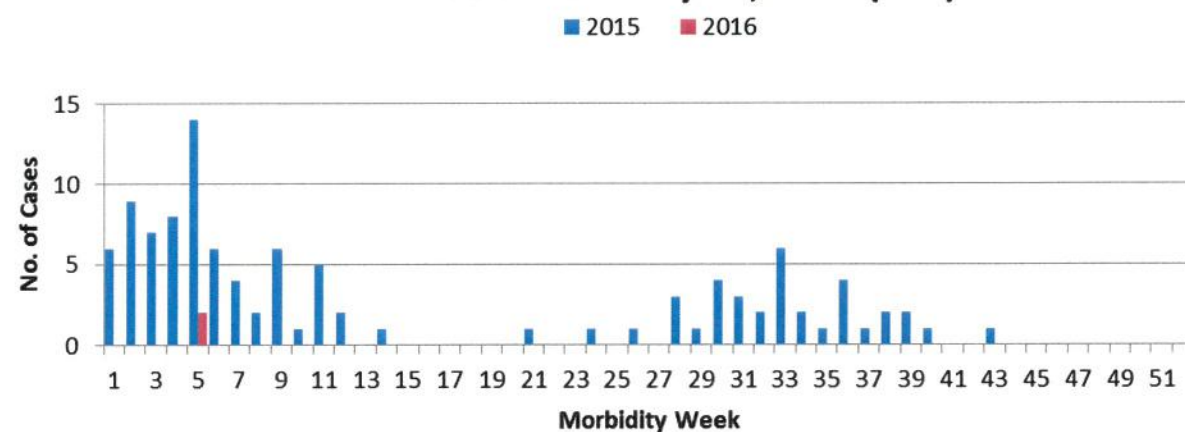
**Fig.6 Influenza-like Illness Cases  
as of February 20, 2016 (N=12,611)**



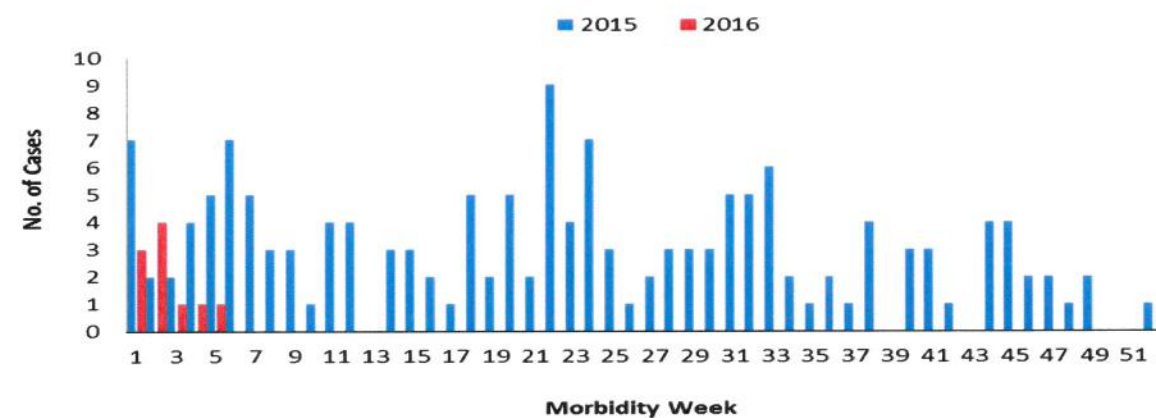
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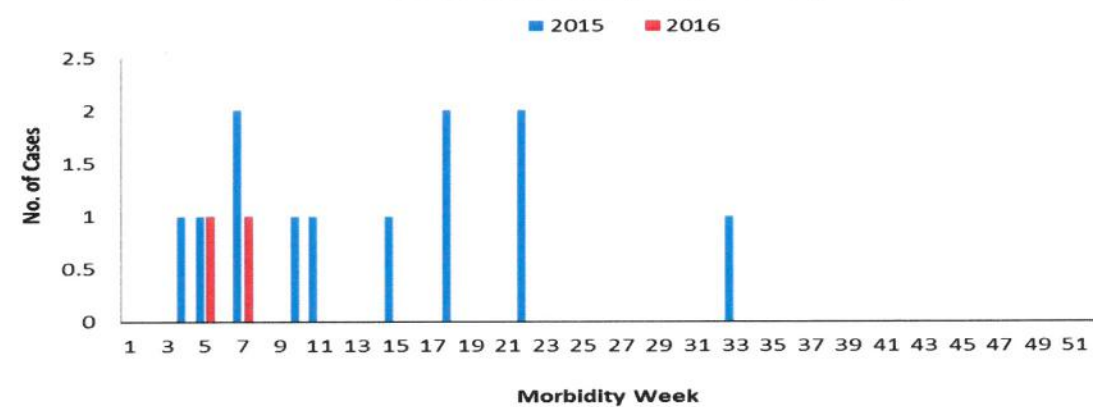
**Fig.7 Influenza Cases**

**as of February 20, 2016 (N=2)**







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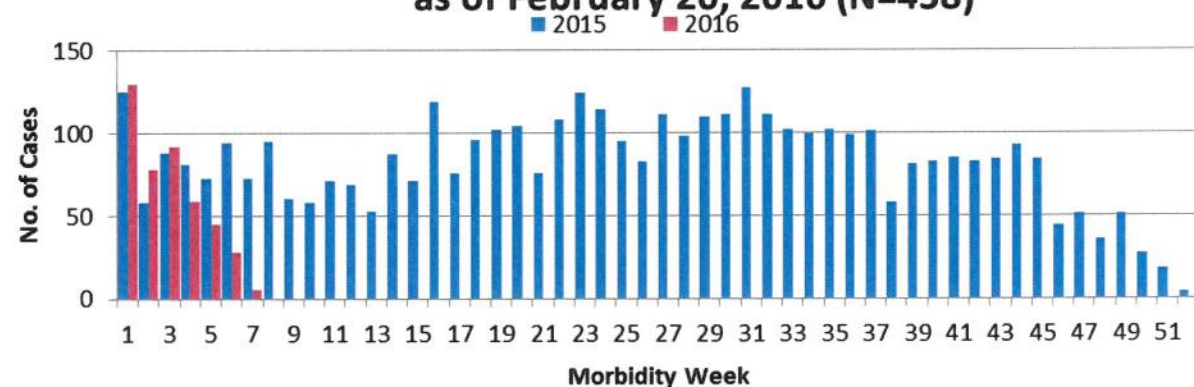

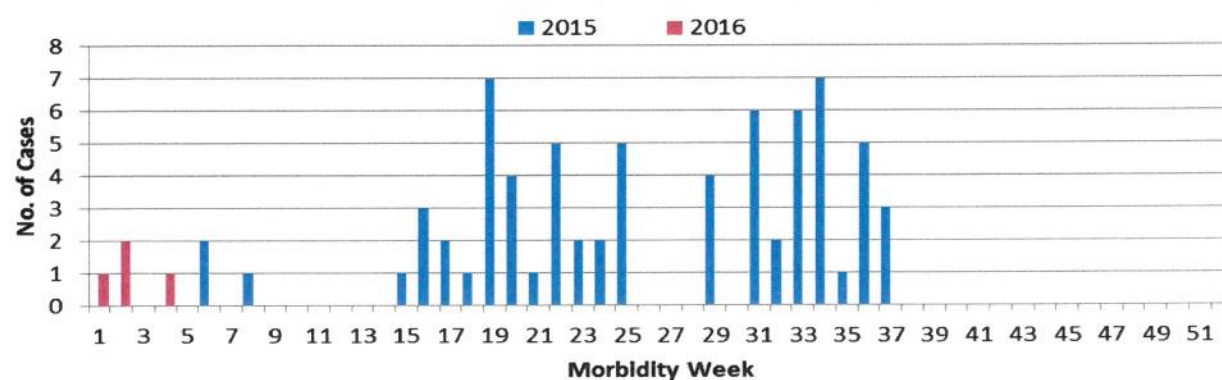
**Fig.10 Acute Bloody Diarrhea Cases

as of February 20, 2016 (n=4)**

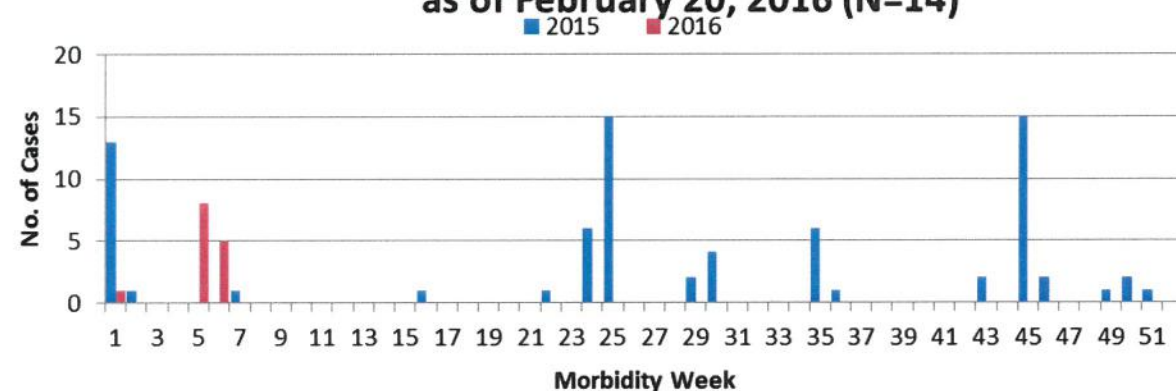




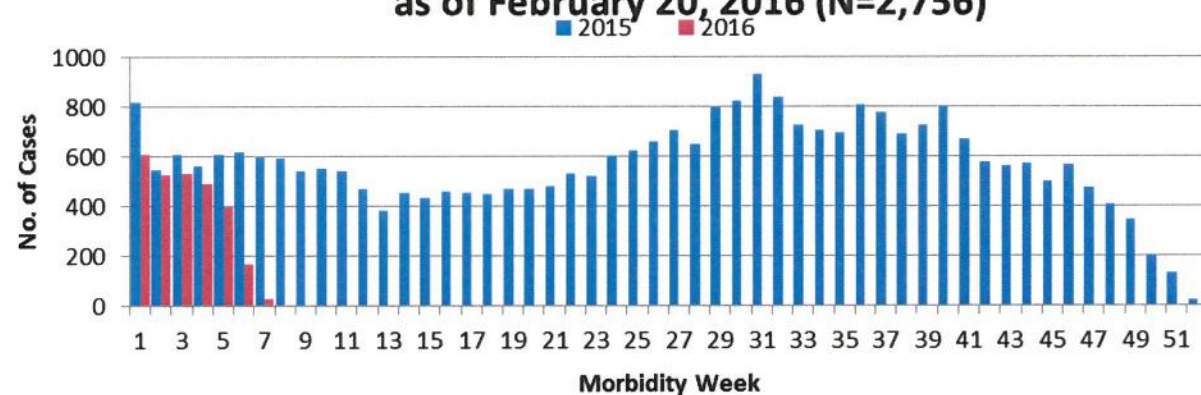
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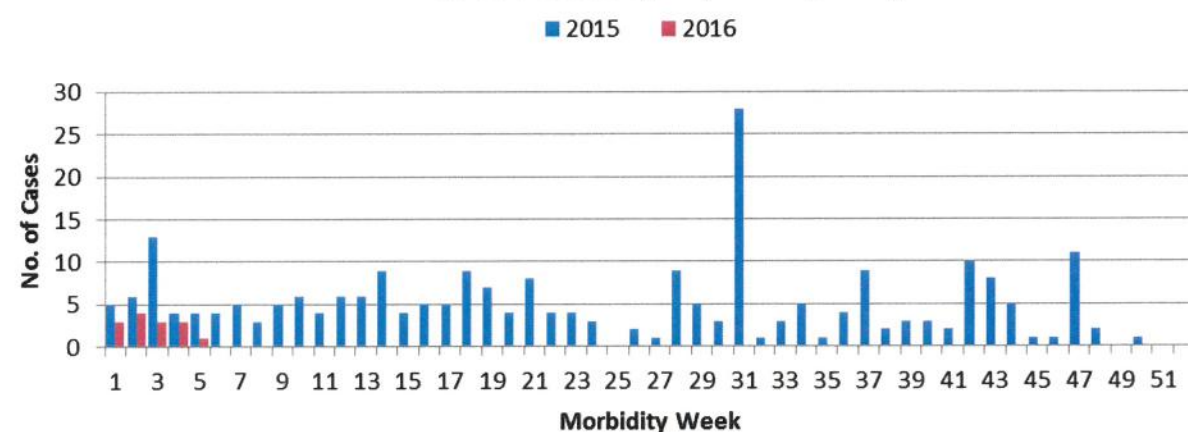
**Fig.13 Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning Cases**

**as of February 20, 2016 (n=14)**



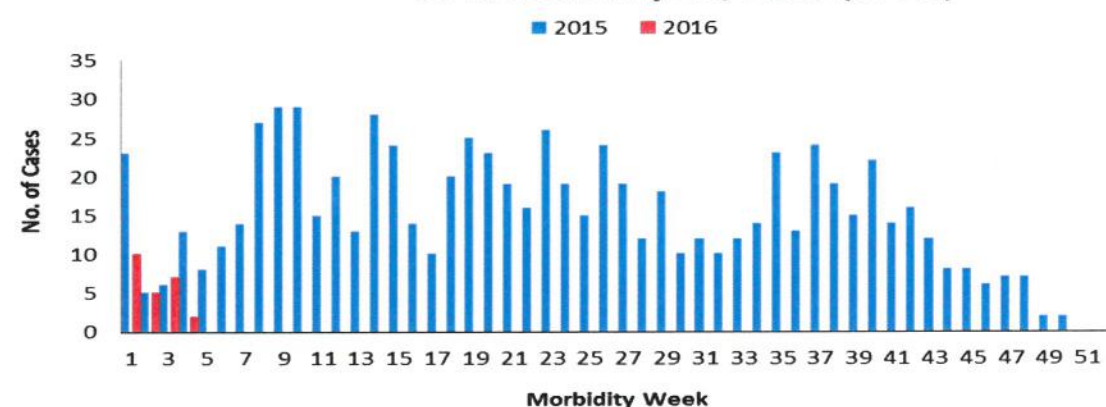




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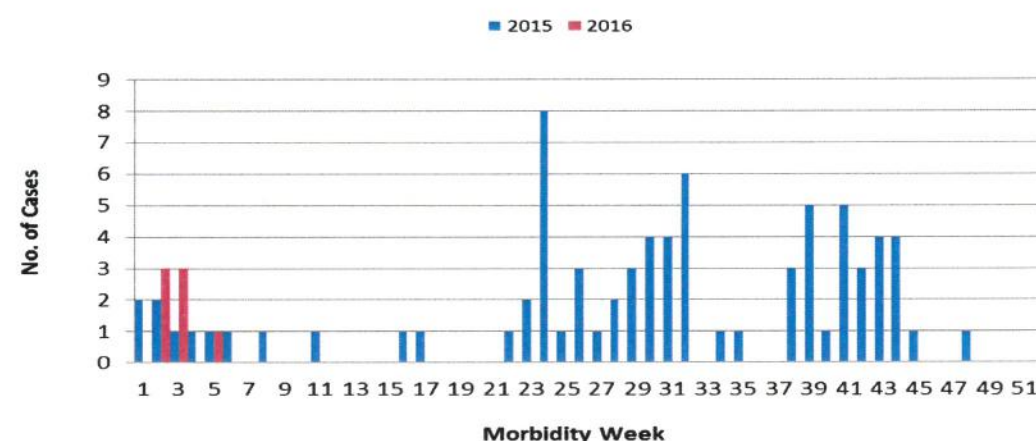
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**Fig. 16 Confirmed Hepatitis A Cases

as of February 20, 2016 (N=7)**



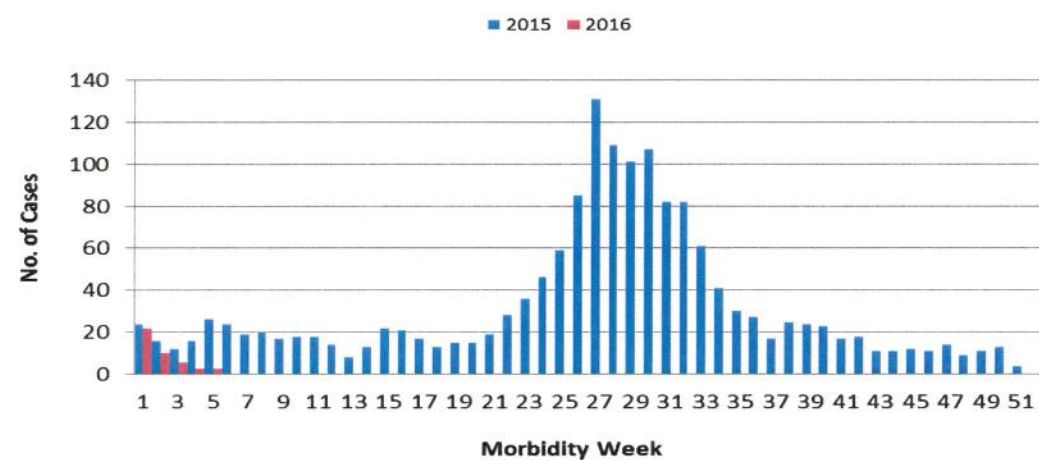
**Fig. 18 Suspect Dengue Cases  
as of February 20, 2016 (N=18,790)**



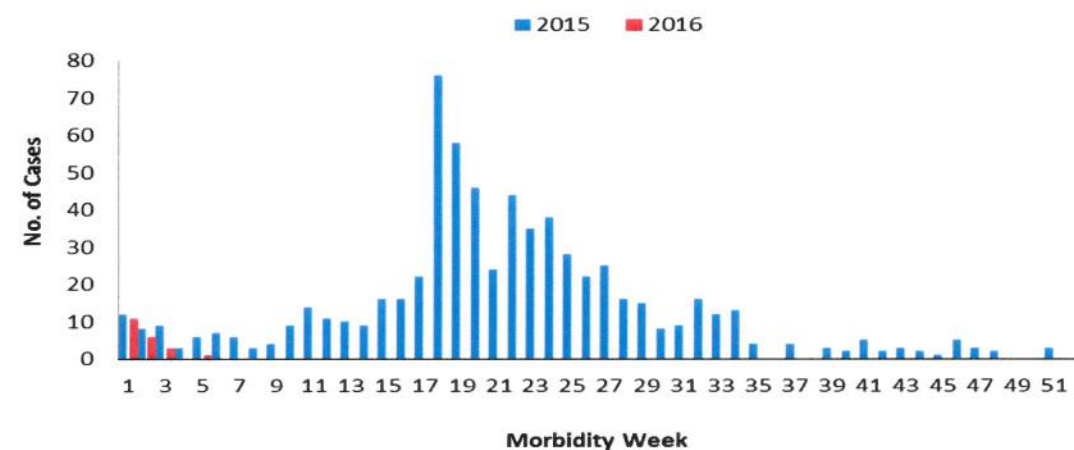
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**Fig. 19 Confirmed Dengue Cases  
 as of February 20, 2016 (n=44)**

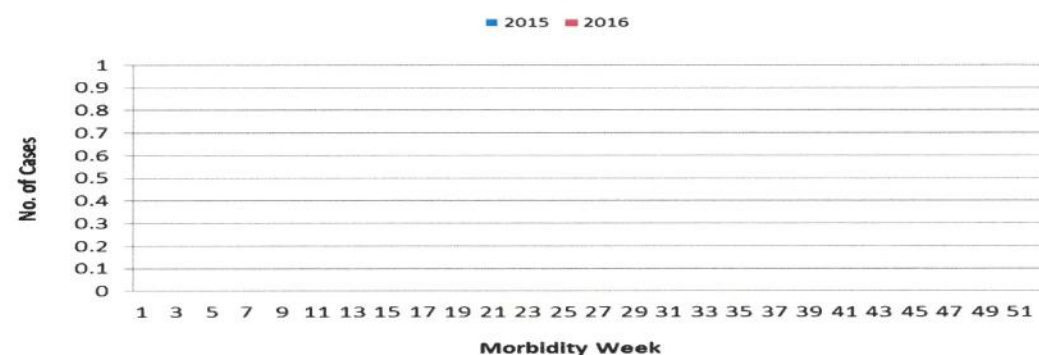


**Fig. 20 Suspect Malaria Cases

 as of February 20, 2016 (N=0)**



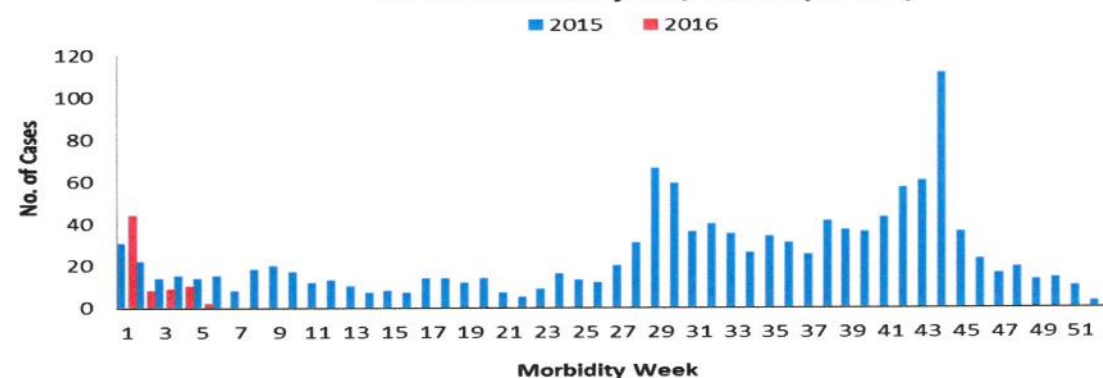




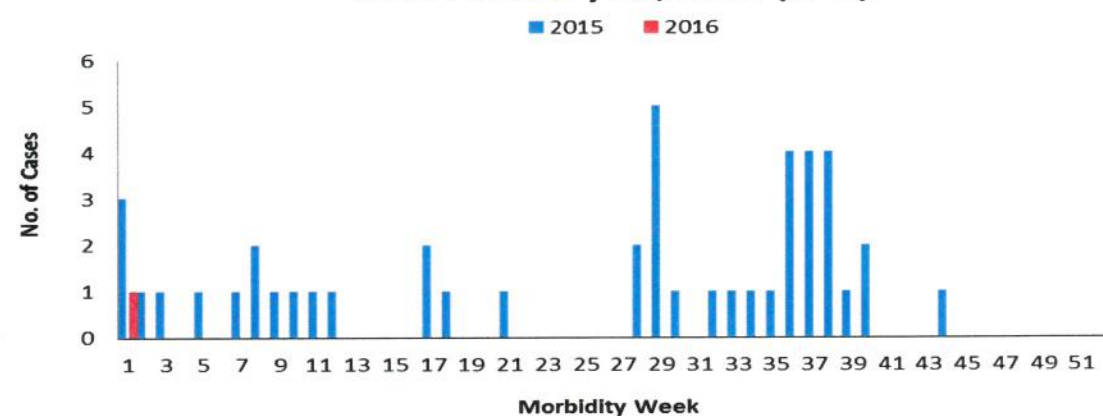
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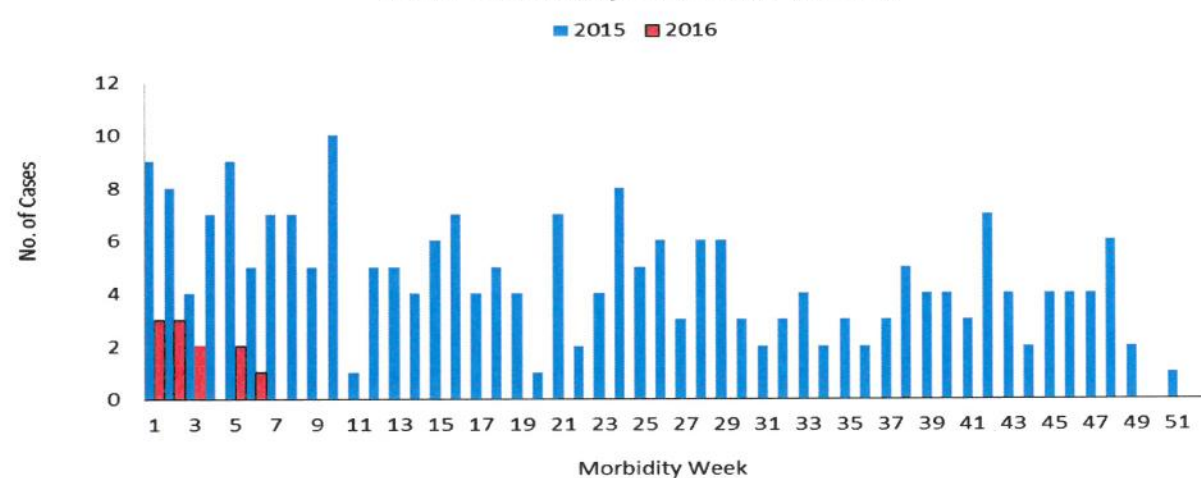
**Fig. 22 Suspect Leptospirosis Cases

as of February 20, 2016 (N=11)**





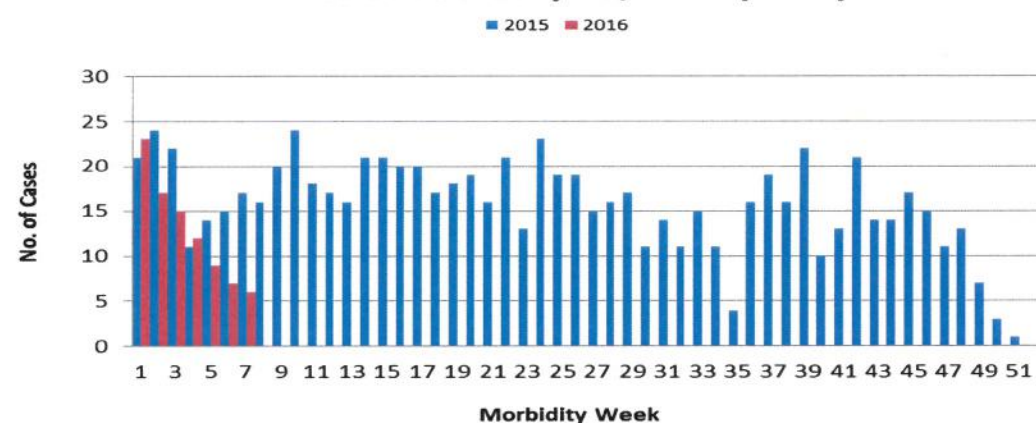


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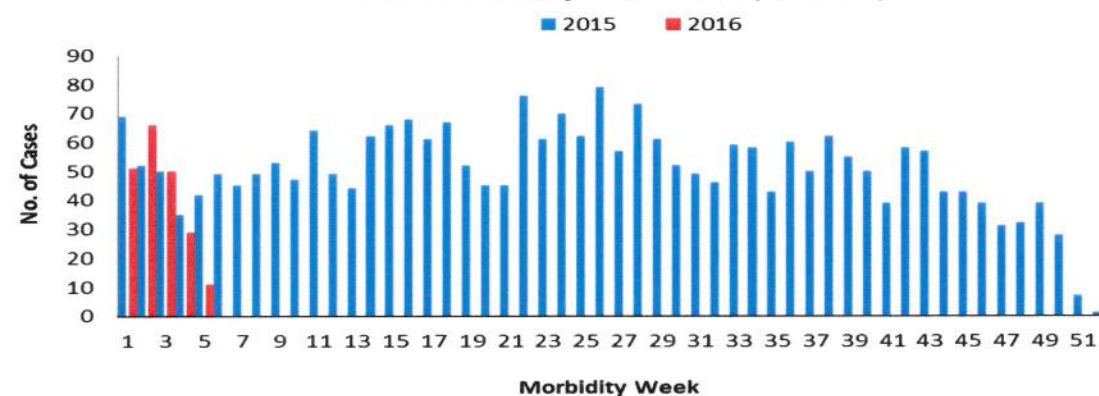

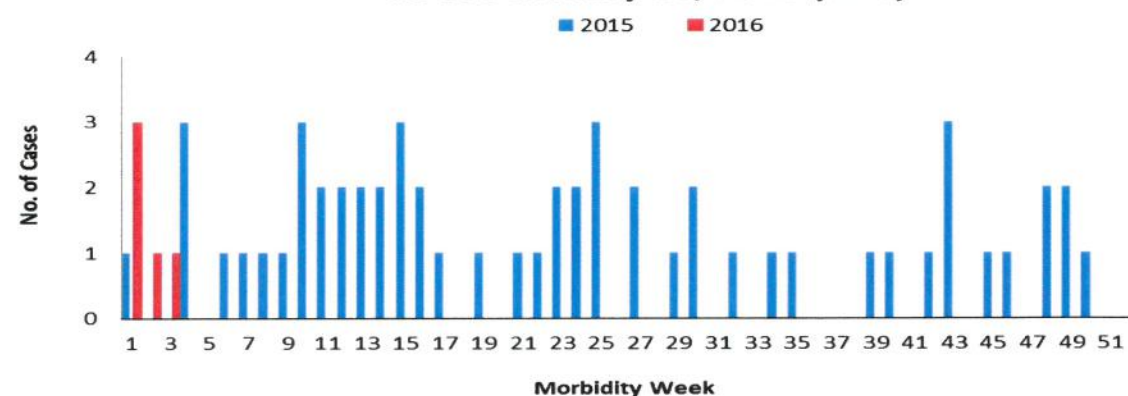
**Fig. 25 Confirmed Non-neonatal Tetanus Cases

as of February 20, 2016 (N=5)**








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
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
